Sentence Upon Voluntary Submission to Discipline


On January 24, 2008, the Title IV Review Committee issued a Presentment against the Rt. Rev. Edward H. MacBurney, Bishop of Quincy, Resigned, alleging that he violated certain provisions of the Constitution and Canons of the Episcopal Church arising out of alleged episcopal acts by Bishop MacBurney in the Diocese of San Diego without the consent of the Bishop of that Diocese. Bishop MacBurney has now executed a written Waiver and Voluntary Submission to Discipline pursuant to Canons IV.2(9) and (10) which acknowledges that he understands the sentence to be imposed as a final resolution of the Presentment. The proposed sentence has been submitted to the Church Attorney and to the Bishop of San Diego for comment and to the Title IV Review Committee for its consent, which it has given.

Now, therefore, pursuant to Canons IV.2(9) and IV.12(1)(b), I hereby admonish

The Right Rev. Edward H. MacBurney
Bishop of Quincy, Resigned

not to repeat the actions which caused the Presentment to be brought against him and direct that he apologize in writing to the Bishop of San Diego for not respecting his authority as the Bishop of that Diocese.

By this action, the Inhibition of Bishop MacBurney under Canon IV.1(6) is removed.
