CONSTITUTION

I. NAME

This organization of the Woman's Auxiliary to the Board of Missions shall be known as the Albany Diocesan Branch.

II. OBJECT

The object of this Branch shall be, by united and systematic effort, to organize the women of the diocese in support of the missionary work of the church. In furtherance of this there shall be maintained:

- (a) A storage house as an emporium for the sale of goods at cost prices to accredited missionaries, and to parish branches for such purposes as come under the Board of Missions, this method insuring lowest rates on materials and goods of all kinds in the interest of missionary work.
- (b) A diocesan lending library to provide books on missions and mission fields, as well as those on subjects conducive to intellectual growth along spiritual lines, which may be used by the clergy and women of the church.
- (c) A department in the periodical newspaper of the diocese, which shall be devoted to the interests of the Woman's Auxiliary.
- (d) A branch of the church periodical club for the distribution of religious and secular literature to missionaries.

III. MEMBERSHIP

Any woman may become a member by paying an annual fee of \$1.00 to the diocesan treasurer. Any person may become a sustaining member by paying \$5.00 annually, and a life member by a single payment of \$25.00.

All members of parish branches shall be invited to the general meetings, but only regularly elected delegates and diocesan members shall be entitled to vote.

Any parish society shall be recorded as a member of this Diocesan Branch when its written application has been approved by the president, and the annual membership fee of from \$1.00 to \$10.00 has been paid to the diocesan treasurer. The officers of parish branches shall correspond with the diocesan officers, and shall send to the treasurer all membership fees, pledges and money given for other than parish or local purposes, and shall report to the corresponding secretary before May 1, each year, all work done, with value of boxes and money given.

Every parish branch shall be entitled to send delegates and to have one vote as a branch in the diocesan meetings.

IV. OFFICERS

The officers of this Diocesan Branch shall be a President, two Vice-Presidents, a Recording Secretary, a Corresponding Secretary and a Treasurer, all to be appointed by the Bishop at each annual meeting, to serve one year, or until their successors are appointed. These officers, with two managers from each archdeaconry, chosen by the archdeacon and approved by the Bishop, together with the chairman of standing committee, shall constitute the executive committee.

1. The president, or in her absence the vice-president, shall call and preside over all meetings.
2. The recording secretary shall keep a correct copy of the corresponding secretary's list of diocesan addresses, shall keep minutes of all branch meetings and of the executive committee.
3. The corresponding secretary shall keep a correct list with addresses of all diocesan officers, members, parish secretaries and clergymen in the diocese; shall send out all notices of meetings; shall conduct the correspondence of the Diocesan Branch; shall make an annual report, and shall be responsible for issuing the annual report of the branch.
4. The treasurer shall have the custody of all moneys received by the Diocesan Branch, and shall collect, by correspondence if necessary, all sums payable to the same; shall keep a full and accurate record of all receipts and disbursements, with date, purpose and amount, and shall make a full report of the same at each regular meeting; she shall pay out money only as directed by the Diocesan Branch, or executive committee, except moneys

received for a definite purpose, said moneys to be disposed without formal directions. All money received for purposes outside the diocese shall be forwarded through the general secretary of the Woman's Auxiliary.

The Bishop shall annually appoint an auditor who shall examine the accounts of the treasurer before they are presented at the annual meeting.

V. MANAGERS

Managers shall call and preside over meetings in their own archdeaconries; shall stimulate the formation of new parish branches; shall strive to infuse greater missionary spirit into all the branches, and shall seek to increase intelligent interest in the missionary work of the church.

To this end each parish branch should be visited by its manager, and at least one general meeting be held during the year in each archdeaconry.

Each manager shall present a written report of her work for the year at the annual meeting of the Diocesan Branch.

VI. MEETINGS

There shall be semi-annual diocesan meetings the second Wednesday in May and in October, at a place fixed by the executive committee, who may also, for sufficient cause, change the time. The May meeting shall be the annual meeting for appointment of officers and receipt of annual report.

Special meetings shall be called by the president on the request of five of the executive committee. Notice of all meetings shall be sent to every officer and parish branch to be read in church the Sunday before each meeting. A quorum for the transaction of business shall consist of the members present at any meeting regularly called.

VII. AMENDMENTS

This constitution may be amended by a two-thirds vote at any regular meeting, provided that notice of the proposed amendment has been given with the call for this meeting.

Constitutions recommended for parish branches and Junior Auxiliaries can be had on application to the corresponding and Junior Auxiliary secretaries.

REPORT OF THE WOMAN'S AUXILIARY DEPARTMENT IN
"THE DIOCESE OF ALBANY"

The report of this department is naturally a brief one, the monthly numbers giving the best record of its work. The editor hopes that it fulfills, to some extent, the purpose for which it is designed in serving as a medium of communication between the Diocesan and parish branches. It does not include in its scope the general missionary news which can be found in our large church papers. There is one point which needs to be set before the members of the Auxiliary with special distinctness, and that is the plan upon which we contribute towards the expenses of the paper, receiving in return one copy for each member of the Diocesan Branch. We pay at a certain rate for all the matter in the departments of the Woman's Auxiliary and the Lending Library. The *literary work* of the department of the Lending Library is controlled altogether by the chairman of that committee, but the printing is charged to the Diocesan Branch. The postage is an additional item, though not a large one. These expenses have reached the sum of \$94.27 during the past year—from May 1st, 1897, to May 1st, 1898—being an average of \$7.85 for each month. As in all purely administrative matters, this money comes from the dues of the sustaining and annual members of the Diocesan Branch.

It only remains to repeat what was said in the last report, that any persons who are entitled to *The Diocese of Albany*, and who fail to receive it regularly, are asked to send word to the editor of the Auxiliary department, who will endeavor to set the matter right.
