Condensed Minutes of the Annual Meeting held in Utica May 21, 1919

The Annual Meeting of the Central New York Branch of the Woman's Auxiliary to the Board of Missions, was held in Grace Church, Utica, Wednesday, May 21, 1919.

A meeting of the Diocesan and District Officers was held Tuesday evening, May 21, at which time 27 responded to roll call.

Holy Communion was celebrated Wednesday morning at 7:30 at St. George's Church by the Rev. Jesse Higgins.

At 9:30 The Litany and Holy Communion at Grace Church, the Rev. Octavius Applegate celebrating, assisted by the Rev. William Cook.

Immediately after the service the delegates assembled in Grace Church Parish House for the opening business meeting. Bishop Olmsted welcomed the delegates most cordially, and gave some interesting personal reminiscences of the early days of the Woman's Auxiliary.

The Bishop emphasized the large opportunity for personal work in the Woman's Auxiliary and United Offering.

Reports were read and accepted from the Secretary, the Treasurer, the District Presidents, Junior Superintendent and the Secretary of Little Helpers.

Miss Beauchamp's report of Educational Work was most enthusiastically given and received. It showed awakening interest in Mission Study Classes.

In Miss Fitch's absence her report of C. P. C. work was read by the Secretary.

Noon-Day Prayer for Missions was said by the Rev. Dr. Applegate.

Luncheon was served at the New Century Club at 12:30 by the Women of Grace Church.

The Afternoon Session was opened with prayer by the Rev. William Cook.

Report of the Church Periodical Club for the Diocese of Central New York

From April 1, 1918, to January 1, 1919

MISS LUCY FITCH

Correspondent of Church Periodical Club, Skaneateles

As the Church Periodical Club, like other Church societies, now closes its reports with the end of the fiscal year, the work covered here extends only from April 1, 1918, to the first of the present year.

On January 1, 1919, the following report was sent to the Central Office of the Club, in New York:

These figures, with one exception, are smaller than those of last year, due in part to the fact that the time covered is only nine months instead of a full year; but also, unfortunately, because it was unusually difficult to secure librarians' reports, and therefore some work is not counted.

We have now thirty-three active branches in the diocese. St. Peter's and St. John's, Auburn, and Trinity, Fayetteville, are without librarians and have given up the C. P. C. work, at least temporarily. The librarian of St. John's, Ithaca, Miss Josephine Grant, died during the year, and her place has not been filled. St. Paul's, Syracuse, reported last year as without a librarian, now has two working together as associates, a plan which it is hoped will prove of value for the larger parishes.

The third annual meeting of the librarians was held in Watertown, May 23, 1918, in connection with the annual meeting of the Woman's Auxiliary. The opening service was at St. Paul's Church at 7:30, a Corporate Communion with the Junior Auxiliary, Rev. Ernest C. Tuthill, rector, celebrating. The business meeting was held during the morning at Trinity Parish House, at which the most important action was the adoption of an apportionment plan, whereby each active parish branch should contribute to the support of the general Club, and of the diocesan branch. As a result of this plan, Miss Sabine, diocesan treasurer, received from the branches, up to January 1, 1919, \$50; \$35.50 for the general work and \$14.50 for the diocesan expenses. While these are not large amounts, they mean that we have put the C. P. C. on a business basis, a plan capable of expansion as the need increases, and that the parishes are much more generally represented than ever before in our contribution to the support of the general Club.

At the afternoon session, Miss Thomas, executive secretary, spoke before the Auxiliary and the C. P. C. explaining the aims and methods of the

Club, and giving special emphasis to the need of the Army and Navy chaplains for books, magazines, games, and all sorts of recreation material for their men.

As a result of this address, and of various appeals to the parishes through the librarians, about seventy-five current magazines have been sent regularly by individuals to thirty-six chaplains, and our report shows seventy-five boxes of odd magazines, most of which went to the soldiers. Quite a quantity of games, records, and joke books have also been supplied. One parish deserves special mention, as the librarian collected current magazines from the entire community and mailed from fifty to one hundred every month to Chaplain Jaynes of the 108th Infantry. The sending began while the men were at Spartansburg, followed them regularly while they were in France, and did not stop until they returned to America. The letters from Chaplain Jaynes shows how much such help was appreciated.

The war work done by the Church Periodical Club as a whole, inadequate as it has been, has been warmly commended by the War Commission of the Church, and the Club is one of the organizations which is to share in the financial aid resulting from the Nation-Wide Campaign about to be undertaken by the Church. This will mean that our work will be better known throughout the Church, and that we will have greater opportunities and much greater responsibilities, which we hope that the parishes of Central New York will be ready to share.

In closing this report we wish to express our great appreciation of the cordial spirit shown to us by the Auxiliary at the meeting in 1918, and our deep regret that it was impossible to arrange for our annual meeting with the Auxiliary again this year.
