## CONDENSED MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL MEETING HELD AT SYRACUSE, MAY, 18, 1921

The Annual Meeting of the Central New York Branch of the Woman's Auxiliary to the Presiding Bishop and Council was held in St. Paul's Church, Syracuse, Wednesday, May 18, 1921, at 10 a. m., beginning with a Celebration of the Holy Communion—Dr. Hadley celebrating.

The business meeting was called to order by the President, Mrs. E. S. Goodale.

The minutes of the Officers' Meeting the evening before were given by the Secretary. The Treasurer's report showed:

Mrs. Thayer's report as Box Secretary showed wonderful gains. Box work for January to May, 1921, amounting to \$13,445.61.

The Presidents of the Districts were called upon to give any interesting happenings.

As the reports now go from January to January there could not be a full report for the year.

Mrs. Thayer commended the Districts for the marvelous spirit in which they had taken up the big requisitions and carried them through so successfully. Gains have been made in each of the five Districts.

Miss Beauchamp's work in the Diocese showed gains—The Survey largely used as a text book—56 study classes—3 pageants—much literature dispursed.

Mrs. Goodale emphasized the usefulness of Mrs. Beauchamp's questions on the various phases of the Church, and asked Miss Beauchamp to prepare a new series on the U. W. C. and reorganization of Church Work.

Mrs. Williams told of the Educational Work in the Province, and the increase in the U. T. O., expressing a wish that funds could be provided to aid in the Educational Work of the Diocese.

The Noonday Prayer for Missions was said by Mrs. Goodale.

Mrs. Goodale spoke of the Emery Fund—for the U. T. O. workers on furlough.

At 12:30 a delicious luncheon was served, the meeting reassembling at 2 p. m.

Mrs. Goodale appealed for interest in the Kuling School for the Children of Missionaries—the only thing they have ever asked for themselves.

Miss Mayer supplemented the appeal. Motion was made and carried that we send \$100 for the Kuling School.

Mrs. Goodale asked a large attendance at the Geneva Conference. Last year the Diocese had 132 Representatives.

Motion was made and carried that the Annual Meeting be in May, reports of necessity going from January to January.

Regrets were expressed that Bishop Fiske could not be with us.

A rising vote of appreciation was given Mrs. Lyon, our Vice-President, who is leaving the Diocese for a time.

Arch-Deacon Foreman gave a very inspiring address, picturing the necessity of a broad vision in Church work, and emphasizing the need of Missionary work, and its need of vision and prayer. It was a gradual leading up to an appeal for St. Philip's, Syracuse, which has done so much for itself, and is in need of a church building. The Rev. Mr. McKay, rector of the Church, also presented his needs.

The Arch-Deacon proposed a Pilgrimage to St. Philip's and Onondaga in June.

The Nominating Committee, composed of the Presidents of the five Districts with Mrs. Goodale had prepared a slate and submitted it to Bishop Olmsted. He thereupon made the following appointments:

Mrs. Goodale expressed her appreciation of the women's co-operation, and the pleasantness of her relations with them. As Vice-President, Mrs. Goodale will still be in close touch with the work.

Mrs. Thayer and the new officers take up their work in January, 1922.

Mrs. Root moved a vote of thanks to the W. A. of Syracuse for their cordial entertainment.

Miss Terry asked that thanks be extended to Mrs. Goodale, Mrs. Lyon and Miss Lansing for their services as officers.
