CONDENSED MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL MEETING HELD AT WATERTOWN, MAY 25, 1922

The Annual Meeting of the Central New York Branch of the Woman's Auxiliary to the National Council was held Thursday, May 25, 1922, in the Parish House of Trinity Church, Watertown, and was preceded by the Celebration of the Holy Communion at 10 a. m., in the church, Rev. Francis W. Eason, celebrating.

The business meeting was called to order by the President, Mrs. H. S. Thayer.

The minutes of the Diocesan and District Officers' Meeting, which was held the previous evening, were read.

The Treasurer's report showed:

Miss Beauchamp reported the educational work done from January 1, 1922, to date.

Mrs. Thayer read the number of boxes and places where boxes were sent for the full year, January 1, 1921-January 1, 1922. The box work for January 1, 1922, to May, 1922, amounted to \$6,482.76.

The Presidents of the Districts gave reports.

The Noon-day Prayer for Missions was said by Dr. Eason.

Mrs. Thayer brought to the attention of the meeting the Diocesan paper, "The Gospel Messenger." Two ladies were appointed to take subscriptions for same and reported about thirty.

Miss Moser spoke of the Church School Service League. The number of branches doubled in the last year. Money and boxes given by the members amounted to \$6,414.08, Little Helpers \$422.79, about \$1,477.97 was given but was not sent to officers.

Archdeacon Foreman spoke concerning some of his Diocesan problems emphasizing the needs of the Chenango County Mission and the Italian Work.

The meeting adjourned to meet at 2 p. m.

At 1 p. m. a delicious luncheon was served the delegates by the Watertown ladies.

The afternoon session was opened with prayer by the Rev. H. S. Wood.

One hundred and thirty responded to roll call, all districts being represented.

Mrs. Clift spoke for the United Thank Offering, making appeal that goal set, for the amount to be presented at Portland, be reached.

Miss Mayer moved that a rising vote of thanks be given to the ladies of Watertown for their kind hospitality and to Mrs. Taylor for use of her home for officers meeting.

Mrs. Thayer read a letter from the office of the Governor General of the Philippines endorsing Deaconess Hargreave's work.

Deaconess Hargreaves gave a most interesting talk on her mission, St. James' School, Besao, the Philippines, and the people which it serves, ending her talk with a number of fine stereopticon pictures.

The Rev. W. V. D. Voorhees, Chadwicks, gave an outline of the classes to be held at the Geneva Conference.
