HELD AT UTICA, MAY 15, 1923

The Annual Meeting of the Central New York Branch of the Woman's Auxiliary to the National Council was held Tuesday, May 15, 1923, in Calvary Church, Utica, N. Y., and was preceded by the celebration of the Holy Communion at 9:30 a. m., the Right Rev. Charles Fiske, D. D., celebrating.

The business meeting was called to order by the President, Mrs. H. S. Thayer.

The minutes of the Diocesan and District Officers' Meeting which was held the previous afternoon, Monday, May 14th, were read and accepted.

The Treasurer's report from January 1, 1923, to May 14, 1923, inclusive, was accepted. Balance on hand \$557.30.

Mrs. Clift reported for the United Thank Offering \$1,653.62 received from January 1, 1923, to date.

Mrs. Thayer reported boxes sent by districts to the value of \$6,215.51 for same period.

Brief reports were given by the District Presidents.

Noon-day prayers were read by Mrs. Thayer.

A letter was read from Miss Lindley explaining the Prayer Partnership Plan.

The meeting adjourned to meet at 2:00 p. m.

The delegates were served a splendid luncheon by the ladies of Calvary Church in the Parish House at 1:00 p. m.

The afternoon session was opened with prayer by the Rev. E. H. Coley, D. D.

Mrs. G. G. Williams reported the educational work.

Two hundred eighty-five responded to roll call: 1st District 23; 2nd District, 174; 3rd District, 41; 4th District, 32; 5th District, 15.

Miss White of St. John's Church, Ithaca, invited the Woman's Auxiliary to hold the 1924 Annual Meeting in Ithaca at own convenience.

Father Hughson of the Order of the Holy Cross spoke on the work being done in Liberia by that order.



The great need and aim for the year 1924 will be the development of Normal Classes for trained leaders, with an educational secretary in every parish branch of the auxiliary and an interchange of leaders for discussion groups and more delegates to summer conferences.
