CONDENSED MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL MEETING

HELD AT ITHACA, MAY 28, 1924

The Annual Meeting of the Central New York Branch of the Woman's Auxiliary to the National Council was held Tuesday, May 28, 1924, in St. John's Church, Ithaca, N. Y.

The day's activities were started with a celebration of the Holy Communion at 9:30 a. m., the Rev. Dr. Edwin H. Coley, celebrant, assisted by Archdeacon Foreman and the Rev. H. P. Horton, rector of the Parish.

The President, Mrs. Thayer, opened the business meeting with prayer.

The minutes of the District and Diocesan Officers' Meeting held the previous evening were read and approved.

The Treasurer's reports showed receipts amounting to \$7,574.28 and disbursements totaling \$7,443.43 with a balance of \$130.00.

Mrs. Thayer, as Supply Secretary, reported that boxes valued at \$6,016 had been sent out since January. Reference was made to the boxes sent by the Girls' Friendly Societies and an expression of appreciation was given the leaders who were thus helping to create the Missionary Spirit in these young people of the Church.

The Secretary pro tem read an explanation and report of the Prayer and Partnership plan as presented by Miss Watson of Utica.

Mrs. Clift, reporting for the United Thank Offering, showed remarkable gains in each district during the past year; gains which totaled \$5,000.00 over the same period three years ago.

A telegram, expressing the love and good wishes of the Auxiliary, there assembled, was sent to Bishop Fiske.

The meeting was adjourned for luncheon and social hour, business being resumed at 2:00 p. m.

The Archdeacon gave a short report of progress shown in the Mission Field during the year.

Roll was called and 178 responded.

The churches of Elmira invited the Auxiliary to hold its annual meeting of 1924 in their city. Interesting summaries of the work done since January were given by the various presidents.

After the offering, which was \$95.00, was received, Dr. Sturgess of New York was given the remaining time to tell of the changing East.

Upon motion the meeting was adjourned.

OBJECTIVES IN WORK AND PRAYER

Woman's Auxiliary of the Second Province

1925

A. Objectives in Prayer.

Let us pray for

1. The deepening of our own spiritual life and that of the Woman's Auxiliary members in this Province.
2. The realization of the Forward Program of the Church.
3. The coming Triennial of the Woman's Auxiliary.
 - (a). For adequate plans and preparation.
 - (b). For a large offering of life and money.
 - (c). For significant results.
4. Our mission fields, especially for Porto Rico and the Virgin Islands and for leadership in Mexico.
5. The promotion of such a spirit of good will among the nations as will tend to bring peace upon earth.

NOTE — It is suggested that these topics of prayer be used at Diocesan Executive and Annual Meetings, at least one regular branch meeting, and by the members in their private devotions.

B. Objectives in Work.

Let us

1. Support the Synod in its plans that the Second Province provide the priorities for the Missionary District of Porto Rico, and in other ways support the work there.
2. Support the work in the Province of Miss Martha Bullitt with the students in women's colleges.
(By informing ourselves and our branches, and by co-operating in new plans and carrying out as best we can any suggestions she makes to us during the year).

3. Further the Forward Program of the Church.
(By keeping our branches informed about the Forward Program in the Province, in the Diocese, and what our particular parish is doing, or how it stands).
By the co-operation on the part of the Diocesan W. A. Boards with other Diocesan plans.
By the co-operation of each parish branch with parish plans.

Provincial Objectives.

4. Foster the spirit of Fellowship and good will in the Province.
By giving delegates to Synod a chance to speak of the Provincial meeting.
By Diocesan officers attending meetings in other Dioceses.
By knowing each other's work, through the Year books, correspondence, etc.
By attending Provincial summer schools.
By joining in our fellowship of prayer and work as outlined above.

REPORT OF EDUCATIONAL WORK

When the report of 1923-24 is compared with that of 1924-25, a small increase in classes is apparent. But behind that increase is a deep and newly awakened interest in the so-called Study Work of the Church. More parishes are convinced of the need and advantage of Discussion Groups. An informal drawing together to ask and answer questions and become better acquainted not only with the Church Program, but with each other. Then there is a better Diocesan understanding of the need for all parishes to follow the Study Books and Programs (sometimes simplified to suit individual needs) selected for us by our Educational Secretary at the Missions House.

The whole program of the Church depends upon us individually, as parishes to interpret, impart and help all to want to learn and love to discuss together the work, prayers and gifts included therein.

Isn't it a rare privilege to be one of those leaders who will help impart this knowledge? Let us all endeavor to develop the interest in that privilege.
