

## CONDENSED MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL MEETING

HELD AT WATERTOWN, MAY 25, 1927

The Annual Meeting of the Central New York Branch of the Woman's Auxiliary to the National Council was held in Watertown, May 25, 1927.

Holy Communion was celebrated at Trinity Church at 10:00 A. M. by the Rt. Rev. Charles Fiske, D.D.

The business meeting was called to order in the parish house by the president, Mrs. Thayer, immediately after the closing of the service.

Bishop Fiske expressed to the women his appreciation of the work done by the organization.

The minutes of the Diocesan and District Officers' Meeting, held the previous evening, accepted as read.

The treasurer reported a balance on hand of \$1,253.78, divided as follows:

In the absence of Mrs. Kingman, chairman of the Prayer Partnership Plan, her report was read by Mrs. Thayer. Ten missionaries are sharing in the plan.

There was no report from the educational secretary. The work for fall and winter is in the line of a follow-up of the Bishop's Crusade. The text-book, "A Church Awake," by Dr. Sturgis. As a more or less preparation for the study of the book, folders entitled "Knowing the Living Christ and Making Him Known" were distributed.

Noon-day prayers were read by Bishop Coley.

The reports of the district presidents for the period January 1 to May 15 (inclusive) were next in order. All reported the work most encouraging and steadily progressing.

Mrs. Thayer spoke of the great privilege in having with us our former archdeacon, the Rev. H. W. Forman, and asked him to take a few minutes to speak to us.

Mr. Forman spoke of the splendid response of the Woman's Auxiliary in Central New York, and said that in speaking to groups of the Woman's Auxiliary in a number of states, he found the same spirit existed throughout the length and breadth of the organization.

Meeting adjourned for luncheon.

A delightful luncheon was served by the ladies of Trinity Parish, assisted by the ladies from the other city parishes.

The afternoon session was opened at 2:00 P. M. with prayer by Archdeacon Jaynes.

Mrs. Thayer spoke of the pleasure of having Bishop Carson as guest and introduced him to the meeting. He spoke of the work at Port-au-Prince, drawing a picture of the conditions as he found them and as they are today. He made plain the possibilities of the future and the great need of completing the Corporate Gift as soon as possible. The Holy Trinity Cathedral at Port-au-Prince, of whose progress he told, is to stand as a symbol of love and sympathy of the Church in the United States. The offering was taken for the third object of the Corporate Gift. It amounted to \$105.00.

Mrs. Davidson, in the name of the branches of the Second District, extended an invitation to the Auxiliary to hold the Annual Meeting of 1928 in Utica. She read a letter from the Rev. Harold Sawyer, rector of Grace Church, Utica, in which he invited the Woman's Auxiliary to meet in Grace Church at the same time as the Diocesan Convention in the spring of 1928.

A rising vote of thanks was given to the women of Watertown and to Trinity Parish for their delightful hospitality.

#### REPORT OF EDUCATIONAL WORK

The figures in the accompanying table are compiled from the reports of the District Secretaries. In almost every item there is a falling off from the report rendered two years ago. Last year's report was incomplete, owing to the office of Educational Secretary being vacant. The individual parish statements show misunderstanding of

the terms used. That there are several interpretations of "discussion classes," "program meetings" and "study classes" is evident to anyone going over the blanks. Educational work does not show up well in figures, nor lend itself to statistics, but in order to avoid unintentional misrepresentation of facts we must have recognized and accepted definitions for the several terms. It is not enough, however, for our District Secretaries to understand these terms, since they must transpose the reports sent them from the parishes. Can we not have an Educational Secretary in each and every branch of the Auxiliary? She may very properly hold some other office, but some one will then be responsible for our educational records, and all necessary instructions can be sent to one individual in each branch.

Our goal should be educational work of some sort in every parish and mission of the Diocese. With united effort I feel sure we can accomplish this within the coming year in a large majority of the parishes, and eventually in all. The character and extent of the work must be planned to fit the local needs, and in most cases the beginnings will be small. So it was with the United Thank Offering and with the Children's Lenten Offering.

None of us would feel satisfied to have only one-half or two-thirds of the branches make their pledges, or contribute to the United Thank Offering, or do their share of the box work. Let us not be content with this low percentage in the educational work, which should lead, wherever it is organized, to increased zeal in all other fields of endeavour.
