President's Address.

"Not by might nor by power but by my Spirit saith the Lord."

What an amount of comfort, encouragement and inspiration is contained in these words! As we once more gather up the record of a year's work in the Auxiliary, looking back on our mistakes, failures and discouragements, it is a joy to feel that while we are privileged to be instruments in God's hand to carry forward His work, its success does not depend on our feeble, imperfect efforts, but that if done in His name and for His honor and glory, our weakness and emptiness will be supplemented by His strength and fullness, our ignorance by His wisdom. The past year, like its predecessor, has been one of great financial depression, and yet we have been able by Divine aid and guidance, to make our Diocesan pledges over \$100 more than ever before.

When the call came from our Bishop last autumn, to meet the personal expenses of a son of one of our Diocesan Missionaries, during the school year at St. John's, Manlius, and I learned from Col. Verbeck that it would require \$150, I acknowledge that I shrank from asking the women of the Auxiliary, to add this to the sums already pledged amounting to \$1,000, but my lack of faith was rebuked, as it has so often been, by the readiness with which the added pledge was accepted at our semi-annual meeting in Binghamton, and although this unexpected demand made it necessary for me to ask for a larger assessment on each district than ever before, upon asking the District Officers if they could raise the additional sum, in almost every case the response was a hearty acceptance of the new pledge and the money was raised without serious trouble.

Through the generosity of one of our members, lately come among us, \$50 was added to the \$950 pledged at Auburn. Of this sum, with the consent of the donor, \$25 was sent to the Rev. Sydney Hooker, toward the support of Mrs. Morrow, who has done such excellent work in Sheridan, Montana, and \$25 toward the object already mentioned, the education of the son of a Diocesan Clergyman. Another generous member of the Auxiliary has given a pledge of \$200 a year for a scholar-

ship in St. Andrew's Divinity School. These are blessed evidences of the deep hold the work of the Auxiliary is taking on the hearts of those conscientiously engaged in it, for those who have made these special gifts, have also given their full share toward the sums pledged in the Diocese and have been active in every good work.

While we have good reason to rejoice that we have been able to increase our pledges and our special gifts, and should with renewed faith and courage take up whatever work our Master puts into our hands, there is still the cause of regret that always confronts us, that so few of the women of the church feel any responsibility to work with us. Now much more could have been accomplished if we could have secured the hearty sympathy and co-operation of all those women who by their baptism have become members of the great missionary society, the church. Year by year we express our regret at this apathy and indifference, but are we any nearer the solution of the problem, how to increase the active membership of the Auxiliary? Personal work alone can accomplish this, and how much such work are we doing? It is largely lack of knowledge, as has so often been said that causes lack of interest. How much are we doing to extend a knowledge of the Auxiliary and its work? Do we talk of it to our friends as we do of other objects in which we are interested? It seems easy to organize all manner of social and literary clubs, and these clubs are made so attractive that there is no trouble in arousing and holding the interest in them. Is it not possible to make meetings of the Auxiliary so interesting as to attract those who have not been interested in its work? In one city in the Diocese monthly meetings of the united parish have been held, at which different missions with their different departments of work have been taken up and discussed, and the interest has constantly increased until the attendance was fully doubled, and women who have never been interested in the work of the Auxiliary are often seen at these meetings. A programme has been prepared for another season, which, or one similar, I should be glad to have used in every Parish in the Diocese.

Through your kindness I had the privilege of attending the Missionary Council held in Cincinnati, at which the 25th Anniversary of the organization of the Auxiliary was commemorated. This Council and the women's meeting in con-

nection with it, will be long remembered I am sure for the atmosphere of spirituality that pervaded all its sessions. Especially in the meetings of the Auxiliary there was an intense feeling of thankfulness for the growth and success of the work undertaken in faith 25 years ago, with no provision of the wonderful things God had in store for the women of the Church. What are we that we should have been privileged to do this great work? In the 25 years of its existence, the Auxiliary has contributed in money and boxes, over \$5,000,000. It is giving yearly about \$350,000 or over \$1,000,000 triennially. This is a record of the material work, but who can compute the results that cannot be tabulated? The value of the united, earnest prayers of hundreds of Christian women, for the advancement of Christ's Kingdom and an outpouring of His Spirit? The blessing it has been to the Missionary Bishops and our poorly-paid, over-worked missionaries by the manifestation of sympathy and interest, through articles for their comfort and words of sympathy in letters? Eternity alone can reveal what the Auxiliary has accomplished through the spiritual part of its work.

At the meeting of the Missionary Council, much was said by the Bishops and Clergy of the great need of women helpers in their work. Bishop Nelson of Georgia, urged the training of women for this purpose. He said that a woman with the natural ability and proper preparation for the work, could do invaluable services in his Diocese, and he was sure every Diocese had need of such assistance. I am sure we feel that much could be accomplished in our own Diocese by such a woman. It is to be hoped that at the next triennial meeting our united offering will be large enough to provide for the training and sending out of many earnest, consecrated women, and that it will be possible to place at least one such fully equipped helper in each Diocese. I earnestly hope that the District Officers are using all reasonable means to make the united offering from this Diocese a worthy one, not only in the amount raised, but as coming from a larger number of women than ever before, and given in a more intelligent and devout manner.

Owing to the continued "hard times" and the indifference of the churchmen of the Diocese the Bishop and Diocesan Board of Missions are still carrying a burden of anxiety with regard to the ways and means of carrying on the mission work of the Diocese. In all our local papers we find accounts of

splendid social functions given by church people, with descriptions of elegant toilettes and costly decorations that give no evidence of hard times. Why must retrenchment and economy begin in the giving for the service of God that which is really His own? Is there not something we can do to help to impress upon Christian people a sense of responsibility for the right use of the means God has entrusted to their care? Let me urge upon you the duty of endeavoring to increase the offerings for Diocesan Missions. It was suggested at our last annual meeting that in the smaller Parishes the collection of sums for this purpose should be the work of the Auxiliary as is already the case in some Parishes. Perhaps it would be well for District Officers to propose this to such Parish branches.

I want to express my gratitude not only to the officers but to individual members of the Auxiliary for their ready response to the many appeals I am obliged to make from time to time, for special gifts for special needs. During the last year the prompt and generous answers to such appeals have done much to strengthen my faith, and give me firmer trust in the readiness of God to aid those who commit their ways to Him and seek His guidance and direction. Through serious illness in my family my work has been hindered. To my great regret I was obliged for the first time since I had charge of the work in the Diocese, to remain away from two district meetings where I was expected. These meetings are a source of inspiration to myself, and I can accomplish more by personal interviews with the active workers in attendance at such meetings than by any number of letters. It is my purpose, God willing, to visit each District at least once a year and I hope to do some Parish visiting.

In closing let me urge you to more abounding faith, firmer trust, and deeper consecration to this most important work for the advancement of Christ's Kingdom on earth. Let us take from this time onward His Holy Spirit for our guide and inspiration, putting self and all selfish motives aside, thinking less of swelling the amount tabulated in our reports, than of working and giving and doing all to His honor and glory and for the Salvation of Souls for whom He was willing to die. Thus will the work be blessed to our own spiritual growth and be worthy of Him for whom it is done.

I have also received the promise that the Sixth District will increase their pledge the coming year, and that the Fifth District will assume part of the burden of money raising also.

The plan of sending union boxes at Christmas time, which was adopted at Miss Emery's request, proved an excellent one. Seven hundred and fifty gifts were sent to the Indians at the Missions about Pine Ridge Agency, and six hundred and fifty

gifts to the Colored Missions in charge of Archdeacon Russell, Lawrenceville, Va.

This seems such a satisfactory way of conducting Christmas work that I have written Miss Emery for suggestions about the boxes the coming year, and hope we will once more decide to adopt her plan.

Each District has been visited during the year. On August 20th I organized St. Margaret's Guild, Harpursville, on October 13th visited Junior Branches of Trinity Church, Elmira. October 14th visited St. Paul's, Waterloo, and found four Sunday school classes doing missionary work. They organized as four chapters of St. Paul's Branch. On October 15th met the young people of Trinity Church, Seneca Falls, and although they did not take up the work at that time, they organized during Lent and have sent in their first report. On Jan. 7th visited Grace Church, Cortland, and Jan. 9th attended a meeting of local branches at Grace Church, Syracuse. On Jan. 12th was present at the annual meeting of the First District at Trinity Church, Watertown, and Jan. 13th met the Juniors of the various branches in Utica at Trinity Church. I have also received notice of the organization of a branch at Willard's on March 13th, and one at St. John's on April 14th. This week I have learned of another at Grace Church, Elmira. Let us take courage from the new help thus offered and make greater efforts for the coming year.

More Juniors ought to be induced to take mite boxes for the United Offering of 1898. If they do not increase it materially, they themselves gain the greater benefit of acquiring the habit of systematic giving, which if once established, would enable us to increase our work an hundred fold and have it all accomplished by free will offerings. Directresses are urged to see that their branches observe a Quiet Hour at least on the Eve of Ascension, and ask the clergy to conduct the services if possible. Try every one to remember the brief prayer for missions at the noonday hour, and ask, without ceasing, for spiritual and material growth, for only thus can we obtain it, and do the work which is given us to do.

CONSTITUTION

—OF THE—

Woman's Auxiliary of the Diocese of Central New York to the Board of Missions.

Amended and Adopted at Annual Meeting held in St.
Paul's Cathedral, Syracuse, May 24th, 1894.

ARTICLE I.

This Association shall be known as the Woman's Auxiliary
of the Diocese of Central New York to the Board of Missions.

ARTICLE II.

The object of the Association shall be to extend a knowledge
of the work of the Church among the Churchwomen of the
Diocese, to awaken greater interest and sympathy for her mis-
sions and missionaries, (such interest to be shown by earnest,
practical work for them,) and to endeavor to promote spiritual
life and activity among its members.

ARTICLE III.

This Association shall be composed of six Districts, corre-
sponding to the six Convocation Districts, each District elect-
ing its own officers and managing its own work, subject to the
approval of the Diocesan President.

ARTICLE IV.

SECTION 1. An Annual Meeting shall be held at some con-
venient date in May for the presenting of reports from District
Branches, and for the transaction of such other business as
may properly come before such meeting.

SECTION 2. A Semi-Annual Meeting may be held in the
Fall at the discretion of the President.

ARTICLE V.

The Officers shall be a President, Vice-President, Corre-
sponding Secretary, Recording Secretary and Treasurer, (ap-
pointed by the Bishop,) who with the several District Presi-
dents shall constitute an Executive Committee.

ARTICLE VI.

SECTION 1. The duty of the President shall be to preside at all meetings of the Association and have general charge of the work under the direction of the Bishop.

SECTION 2. The duty of the Vice-President shall be to preside in the absence of the President, and to co-operate with her in the general work of the Association.

SECTION 3. The duty of the Corresponding Secretary shall be to conduct the necessary correspondence of the Association under the direction of the President and to make an annual report.

SECTION 4. The duty of the Recording Secretary shall be to keep a record of the annual and semi-annual meetings, to call the roll at these meetings and to read such papers as may be ordered to be read.

SECTION 5. The duty of the Treasurer shall be to receive and hold all moneys sent to her by the District Treasurers, to disburse the same to the objects designated by the senders, viz: Diocesan or other Missions, Missionaries, Scholarships, etc., and to make an annual report.

ARTICLE VII.

This Constitution may be altered or amended at any Annual Meeting by a vote of two-thirds of the members present, subject to the approval of the Bishop.

BY-LAWS.

SECTION 1. Special meetings may be called by the President at such time and place as she may designate, for the purpose of stimulating interest in the work.

SECTION 2. The regular order of business at the annual and semi-annual meetings shall be:

1. Offices of Devotion.
2. Roll Call.
3. Reading of Minutes of Last Meeting.
4. Reports of Officers and Committees.
5. Unfinished Business.
6. Miscellaneous Business and Addresses.

SECTION 3. The By-Laws may be amended at any regular meeting by a vote of a majority present.

CONSTITUTION

—OF THE—

Central New York Junior Branch of the Woman's Auxiliary.

Adopted at Binghamton May 12th, 1893.

ARTICLE I.

This Organization shall be called the Central New York Junior Branch of the Woman's Auxiliary to the Board of Missions.

ARTICLE II.

The object of this Organization shall be to interest and instruct the youth and children of the Church in the mission work, and to impress upon them a sense of responsibility as baptized members of the same to assist in advancing the great object for which the Church was established.

ARTICLE III.

The Diocesan Branch shall consist of the District Branches corresponding to six Convocation Districts.

ARTICLE IV.

The officers shall be a Diocesan Superintendent, appointed by the Diocesan President of the Woman's Auxiliary, and a Board of Managers, consisting of the Diocesan Superintendent and a District Superintendent from each district, who shall be appointed by the Woman's Auxiliary from her district.

ARTICLE V.

It shall be the duty of the Diocesan Superintendent to have entire management of the Junior work in the Diocese, subject to the approval of the Diocesan President of the Woman's Auxiliary.

ARTICLE VI.

It shall be the duty of each District Superintendent to take charge of the work in her district, under the supervision of the Diocesan Superintendent.

ARTICLE VII.

General meetings of the Diocesan Branch shall be held at the discretion of the Diocesan Superintendent, with the approval of the Diocesan President of the Woman's Auxiliary.

ARTICLE VIII.

This Constitution may be changed or amended by the Board of Managers at their discretion.
