ANNUAL REPORT OF SECRETARY.

1902.

It is always a pleasure, when a report is to be presented, that one can truly say there has been a year of work which shows indeed true progress.

The meetings of the Woman's Auxiliary to the Convocation of Chester have been held as heretofore.

The Annual Meeting in October, 1901, at St. Paul's Church, Chester, was well attended, and addresses were made on the subject of the Foreign and Domestic work of the Church, by the Rev. J. Thompson Cole, and Rev. Robert Forsythe, of our own Diocese.

At the Spring Meeting, held in the Ascension Mission, Parkesburg, Deaconess Sanford, of the Philadelphia Deaconess' House, spoke on the subject of the Deaconess' work, the objects, aims, and results. And a Conference was held on the subject of the Mission Study Class.

Herein the history of this Auxiliary: A new Chapter was commenced, and one, which we hope, will never close. Mrs. Scott, of Radnor, opened the Conference with an able paper, many of the delegates taking an active part in the discussion which followed.

The meetings have been well attended, and year by year be-

come more interesting to all, as the individual member takes more and more part in the work.

One hundred and sixteen delegates, representing 30 parishes, with representatives from 6 Junior Auxiliaries, are recorded.

The Lenten Missionary Meetings held in February in the several sections of the Convocation were both pleasant and profitable to those who attended them.

The meeting of the Southern Section was held in St. Stephen's Church, Clifton Heights, where Dr. Perry and the Rev. Mr. Hunter made the morning addresses, followed in the afternoon session by Bishop Kingsolving, of Brazil, and Miss Bull, of China, with a paper prepared by the Rev. J. M. Kœhler, of Philadelphia, who ministers to the Deaf Mutes—he likewise suffering from the same infirmity.

The Central Section, met in St. Mary's Church, Ardmore: Archdeacon Spurr and Rev. Herman Duhring told of the work carried on in the particular field in which they were interested; Paul Shimon, Mr. Green and Mr. Gardner on the mission work of Assyria, Japan and the work in the Diocese of Pennsylvania among the Jews.

The meeting of the Northern Section, held in Holy Trinity Church, West Chester, was fortunate in securing a trio of Bishops: Bishop Kingsolving, of Brazil; Bishop Brown, of Arkansas, and Bishop Talbot, followed by Mr. Shimon and Archdeacon Spurr.

Judging, as we are taught, by the fruits, these meetings produced quite a harvest for missions.

The reports brought in at the Spring Meeting, show how the Woman's Auxiliary Societies in the Convocation had responded to the various needs which had been placed before them at these

Lenten meetings. Not one of the missionaries had gone away empty handed. Constantly has there been evidence of a spirit that

“God loveth a cheerful giver.”

Another sign of progress has been the gladness to take up new work. In one Section of the Convocation a scholarship has been undertaken to assist a girl in Assyria to an industrial education which will enable her to help in the uplifting of her own people. This scholarship bears the name of “The Convocation of Chester.”

It has been our sorrowful duty to record the death of the Rev. George Kelier, Second Dean of the Convocation of Chester. His earnest zeal, his devoted love for the work of Christ and His Church, and his unfailing courtesy, can never be forgotten by the Woman’s Auxiliary, who found in him always a ready helper in the cause of missions.

It has, indeed, been truly said “That God could convert the world if he choose to do so without us,” but no woman for her own sake can afford to lose the privilege to help.
