THE SECRETARY'S REPORT, 1903-1904

Again we come together for our annual meeting, and it is with great pleasure your Secretary presents to you the record of the meetings, held during the past year; they have been such hearty, wholesome meetings, full of the spirit of reaching out and doing more and more for the hastening of the Kingdom to Come.

The annual meeting held last year on October third, in the Church of the Redeemer, Bryn Mawr, brought together a large number of the women of the Convocation; the day was all that could be desired, and everything was done to make our meeting a successful one, that our entertainers could devise. At the afternoon session the Rev. W. R. Burbank gave a description of the old Parish of St. Andrews, West Vincent, its history dating back to the early part of the last century; where the Convocation is endeavoring to build up what has been allowed to fall away, and where there is now a large and flourishing Sunday School, with a steadily increasing congregation; the work is under the care of the Rector of St. Peter's Church, Phoenixville. Dr. Potts, of China, told of the workings of St. John's College, Shanghai, where young men are being educated and Christianized, carrying with them as they return to their several provinces, through the length and breadth of the Celestial Empire, the learning and religion of the civilized world, and asked aid in increasing the capacity and equipment of the college.

The Spring meeting, held in St. Stephen's Church, Clifton Heights, was one of the largest in point of numbers that the Auxiliary has ever known, taxing the capacity of the building to accommodate the Society.

The afternoon session convened at a conference in charge of Mrs. Scott, of Radnor; the subjects were well chosen, and called forth a full discussion, showing much latent power in many of our women, and promising for the future, more and better work than has been done in the years gone by. Papers on the subject of the united offering were read by Miss Margaret Morris, of Bryn Mawr, and Miss Baltz, of Whitford.

"What is the Women's Auxiliary to the Convocation?" by Mrs. W. W. Montgomery, of Radnor, "Missionary Boxes," by Mrs. Potts, of Media, and "How to Interest a Parish in Missions," by Mrs. F. C. Steinmetz, of Ridley Park, left many helpful suggestions in the minds of the hearers, to bear fruit in the year's work upon which we have just entered.

One hundred and thirty delegates from thirty parishes were present at these meetings and representation from six auxiliaries. The Church of the Advent, Kennett Square; St. Luke's, Chadds' Ford, and St. Peter's, Great Valley, with the Mission at Ithan, are without representation; would it not be possible for the delegates from the neighboring parishes to interest some one in the work of the Auxiliary in these localities? It is certainly desirable that this Society should be an Auxiliary comprising all the parishes within the limits of the Convocation of Chester.

The executive meeting held in the Church House in Philadelphia in May was well attended. The Lenten Missionary meetings increase in interest and attendance year by year.

The meeting for the Northern Section of the Convocation held in Downingtown, on March 9th, was in every particular a good meeting. The addresses at the morning session were made by the Rev. W. H. Burke, on the subject of the Valley Forge Memorial Chapel. Mr. Shimon spoke for mission work in Syria, and the Rev. Abel Arken enlisted the interest of all who heard him, for the poor and wayward who live in the northeastern part of Philadelphia, where St. George Chapel and Parish House endeavor to lift the fallen and relieve the needy. At the afternoon session, Rev. J. J. Pevry, representing the Bishop of Georgia, told of the mission field in that State. Mr. Hoar, who was in training for the work in Alaska, gave many interesting facts in regard to that work, which has indeed been called the most heroic missionary effort of the Mother Church.

The meeting for the Central Section was held in St. Martin's Church, on March 3rd, and was entertained by the Woman's Auxiliary of St. David's Church, Radnor. At the morning session Rt. Rev. Lucien Lee Kingsolving, of Brazil, told of the great need of educational facilities for the students, who are being trained to take up and carry on the work of the coming Brazilian Church. The Rev. A. P. Alston, of St. Michael's Training and Industrial School at Charlotte, North Carolina, a colored priest of the Church, gave a most interesting history of that institution, showing the meagre beginnings and leading up to the great work now carried on, in training the freedmen of the South to help themselves. Miss Thacher, a nurse from Manila, spoke, as did also Rev. W. H. Burke and Rev. A. J. Arken.

The meeting for the Southern Section was also held on March 3rd, in

Christ Church, Media. Here the Bishop Coadjutor of the Diocese spoke at both sessions. Archdeacon Batty, who labors among the colored people of Tennessee, endeavored to interest those present in that work. Rev. W. Taylor Douglass, in behalf of the red men, told most pathetically of the destitution and distress of the Hapa Indians, of California, where Bishop Moreland is putting forth every effort to minister to them. Mrs. Hughson, of North Carolina, was the last speaker of the afternoon. The Mountain Whites, her subject; and as her life is spent among these people, she could portray faithfully the sunshine and shadows of that particular field. These meetings were all well attended, and the condensed report with a total of \$9,511.12 shows how the women of the Church are being educated and enthused by these all-day missionary meetings to greater and still greater effort in the work of bringing the world to Christ.

May we indeed live in the spirit of the collect of the 17th Sunday after Trinity, and ask that "The Lord's grace may indeed always prevent and follow us, and make us continually to be given to all good works."
