## SECRETARY'S REPORT, 1910-1911

---

OCTOBER 5, 1911.

We come together again for our Annual Meeting; it is with great pleasure your Secretary presents to you the record of the meetings held during the past year. They have been hearty, wholesome meetings, full of the spirit of reaching out and endeavoring to do our utmost in the work we as a society were organized to do.

The Annual Meeting held in St. John's Church, Lansdowne, on Thursday, September 29th, brought together a large number of the women of the Convocation. The day was all that could be desired, and everything was done to make our meeting a successful one, that our entertainers could have possibly devised.

The Rev. Jules Prevost, for many years active in the Mission field of Alaska but now a rector of a parish in our own Convocation, gave a most interesting and instructive address on the work the Church is doing for the Indians in the western parts of our Country.

The Spring Meeting was held in St. Martin's Church, Radnor, in May, and was sufficiently large in numbers to tax the capacity of that church. The Spring Meeting was as has been our rule for some years, a Women's Meeting. The address at the Afternoon Session was made by Deaconess Stewart, of Hankow, China, a graduate of the Deaconess House of the Diocese, who gave a most interesting description of the opening of the Orient to the Gospel, and told of the great progress that has been made in the advancement of the women of China.

137 Delegates were present at the two meetings of the year, and Junior Delegates from eight Parishes representing 34 Parishes of the Convocation. Delegates are now sent to the Auxiliary Meetings from all the Parishes and Missions of the Convocation, with the exception of the old Missions of St. Peter's, Great Valley, and St. Andrew's, West Vincent, and the newest Mission at Wawa.

The two meetings of the Executive Committee were held in the Church House, Philadelphia, in April and September.

The Lenten Missionary Meetings were held in three sections of the Convocation. The meeting of the Northern Section, in the Church of the Ascension, Parkesburg. At the western end of this Diocese on Thursday, March 22nd, Bishop Thomas, of Wyoming, made the address at the Morning Service, asking for both men and money to enable him to carry forward a more aggressive work in the Mission field to which the Church has sent him.

Rev. Amos Goddard, of China, spoke for that land, and the Missions of the Church, in the far East.

The Rev. Jules Prevost gave a most interesting description of conditions in Alaska, contrasting the present uplift of those people with the conditions found in Alaska years ago.

The meeting of the Southern Section was held in St James' Mission, Prospect Park, one of the youngest of the Missions of this Convocation. The services were conducted by Dean Taitt. and the addresses were delivered by Bishop Thomas, of Wyoming and Rev. Amos Goddard, of China. Rev. P. E. Jones, a colored clergyman, of Haiti, gave the history of that Island. from the discovery of America to the present time, and the work the Church is doing among those people, describing the Out-of-door Services held, where in some places a large tree is the only protection for the congregation from sun and storm, and asking for assistance from his hearers to enable him to build a chapel for the people to whom he ministers.

The meeting of the Central Section was held in the Church of the Good Shepherd, Rosemont. Here Bishop Thomas and the Rev. Amos Goddard spoke, for the third time, and by so doing, all the women of the Convocation had an equal opportunity of hearing of these particular fields of Mission work. These meetings were all well attended, and the large total of our condensed report bear witness to how the women of the Church are being educated and enthused by these all day Missionary meetings, to greater and still greater effort in the work of bringing the knowledge of the love of God to the parts of the world that has not known Him.

May we not in a prayerful spirit, ask that our Lord and Master, will show us the work he will have us to do as a society and individual workers, and that he will give us His grace to do the same.
