SECRETARY'S REPORT, 1914.

With October first, nineteen fourteen (1914), comes the thirtieth birthday of the Woman's Auxiliary to the Convocation of Chester. The foundations laid by Dean Bolton were well laid as the building up of the structure has shown, and the continued growth in the interest and activity of the women of the Convocation in the great, and should be first interest of all Christians, the spreading of the gospel of Christ, testifies that this Society has accomplished in a large degree, what our first Dean, Rev. John Bolton, had in his own unbounded zeal for Missions (when that cause was not the popular one it is to-day) prayed and trusted the Auxiliary of the Convocation should become.

If we review our past, we, who have grown into middle life with the work, must all realize what strides we have taken from the very few women who had the first meeting in West Chester, with the first Treasurer's report of sixty dollars; to the large gathering which comes together twice a year, our largest meeting being that at Media on the occasion of the twenty-fifth anniversary, when 350 guests were entertained by that Parish, to the Treasurer report of this day with its hundreds of dollars. Our first condensed report showed three thousand dollars given in money and boxes, for the general Missions of the church, by the women of the Convocation, and today our Condensed Report soars far above any year, a fitting report for an anniversary day, \$12404.66. During these years the Woman's Auxiliary of the Convocation of Chester has contributed about sixteen thousand dollars to the Convocation work, and there is scarcely an old feeble Parish or a very young Mission in the Chester Convocation to which our Treasurer has not sent an appropriation; and in some places we are sure the help was given when it was much needed, to help over the hard places.

It will be of interest to us all to record, that in this period of thirty years, sixteen new places of worship of our Mother Church have been built and maintained in this Convocation, the majority of them now strong and vigorous Parishes, this beautiful building in which we meet to-day being one of the number.

The two meetings of the year have been well attended; the annual meeting at St. Paul's Church, Glen Loch where we had the pleasure in being entertained in the new Parish House, to which it had been our privileged to lend a helping hand. Here at the afternoon session we had

Rev. Edgar Sanford tell of the encouraging work at St. Mark's, Honeybrook, in which Parish we as a Society had our part, and which made the address of added interest. Dr. Brathenahl followed with a stirring call for renewed effort in all our Mission work, for the Convocation, the Diocese and the world at large.

Dr. Prevost was called upon again to tell of the Mission work which he was interested in the nearby neighborhood, so we could feel at this meeting the whole field had been gone over.

The Spring meeting was held at Ridley Park, with our usual business and busy session in the morning, and as has been our custom for some years, at the Spring meeting, we had a woman to make the address, Miss Ashhurst, of our own Diocese, who had spent a year as a volunteer worker in Cuba, and of this work in which she was so interested herself, interested her hearers. Bishop Garland was present and spoke on the Convocational work. 133 delegates attended these two meetings, representing 35 Parishes and Missions, with representatives from 7 Junior Societies.

The Lenten Missionary Meetings in the three sections of the Convocation were held in March, 1914, namely: at Paoli, Morton and Parkesburg. At Parkesburg the meeting was entertained at luncheon by the women from St. John's, Pequa, St. Mary's, Warwick, St. Mark's, Honeybrook, and the Parkesburg Parish; as these Parishes are all in country places, it would be impossible for the meeting to go to them, it was an opportunity for them all to have a Missionary meeting; to have a common interest, which is always desirable and helpful.

Here Dr. Glenton, of China, spoke in the morning, and in an unusually interesting manner told of the work for Christ to the women of that land. Mr. Long of the "In As Much Mission" of Philadelphia, reviewed the work done in the years of that Mission, which had led up to the building of the new house and to the opening of which he kindly invited his hearers. Rev. Mr. Huff spoke on the discouraging side of the Convocational work, in the old Parishes in which he had been conducting services.

The meeting in the Church of the Atonement, Morton, was in charge of Dean Taitt, who made the morning address on the subject of the Alaskan Mission, giving a description of a visit made to that field of work a short time before. Deaconess Adams spoke of the work in North Carolina, in which she had been engaged, and Miss Mary Canning gave some details of the work of the City Mission, and of the many calls that are made upon that Mission for help.

Mrs. Pillsbury, of Bala, on behalf of the China Mission, in which so many of the Study Classes had been interested during the winter, gave some interesting facts, and Rev. J. J. Hall, of the Gallilee Mission, closed the meeting with an account of the work done there to uplift fallen man.

At Paoli Dr. Glenton and other speakers filled in a most profitable day, and quoting from the report of one of the chairmen of these meetings: "Every woman returned to her Parish to do better work for the uplifting of her weaker sister."

To many women of the Convocation these meetings mean very much. They are the only meetings of the year in which they hear anything of the Mission work of the Church; it widens and broadens their vision for giving a more enlightened service.

As we bring this our report of the thirtieth year of our Auxiliary's work, can any one of us truly say from the heart: "She had done what she could."
