## SECRETARY'S REPORT

---

The two regular meetings of the Woman's Auxiliary to the Convocation of Chester were held as usual, the Spring Meeting being at Holy Trinity Church, West Chester, and presided over by Mrs. J. D. Perkins, Vice-President, in the absence of Mrs. Wright. The Fall Meeting was at St. Asaph's, Bala, when our President was with us again. The weather on both occasions was delightful, so a large number of women were present. The average attendance for the past three years has been about 225.

The special speakers during the year were Mrs. George Wharton Pepper, on the program of the Church; Archdeacon Phillips, on the colored work in the Diocese; the Rev. T. B. Phillips, on the work of Woman's Auxiliaries; the Rev. Charles Spalding, on general mission subjects, and the Rev. J. W. Loaring-Clark, of the National Council, on the organization of the Church.

The promised \$1,500 was raised and given to the colored congregation in West Chester to procure a place in which to hold services. \$250 was also given to Kennett Square to add to their organ fund, and \$250 to Darby to help pay for a retaining wall.

The Auxiliary agreed to again try to raise \$2,000, which is to be given entirely to Kennett Square towards a much needed rectory.

The box lunch continues to take the place of the lunch formerly served by the ladies of the Parish acting as host, thereby allowing the meetings to proceed on schedule time, and also relieving the ladies of a great deal of labor and expense.

A plan for increasing the yearly receipts of the Auxiliary was suggested by the Rev. Jules Prevost, and was accepted with thanks. It was to establish an interest-bearing fund, consisting of amounts of \$25, and upwards, to be given by individuals, or Parishes, in memory of deceased members of the Woman's Auxiliary to the Convocation of Chester. Dr. Prévost offered the first \$25 in memory of his wife, Louise Anna Prevost, who died in 1919, and who had been a most earnest member and supporter of the Auxiliary.
