SECRETARY'S REPORT

The regular meetings were held during 1924. The Spring Meeting was at the Church of the Good Samaritan, Paoli, where a record-breaking gathering filled the Parish House to overflowing; the Fall Meeting, at Christ Church, Ridley Park, had a very fair attendance.

At Paoli the special speaker was Mrs. Crawford, who is Field Secretary of the Diocese. At Ridley Park Dr. William Hamilton Jeffries, of the City Mission, made the address of the day.

The Memorial Membership Fund, proposed by the Rev. Jules L. Prevost, has been started with a list of six names.

The \$2,000 pledged to Kennett Square, to help in building a Rectory, was paid in full and has been of great encouragement to Mr. Spalding in his work there. Also the final payments were made to Darby and to Kennett Square for the retaining wall and the organ as promised last year.

It was decided to raise \$2,000 this next year for a Parish House at Collingdale, and, if possible, \$500 more to be given to help with a Rectory at Prospect Park.

A new Mission has been added to the Convocation—that of The Redeemer, at Springfield, with the Rev. William Kilpatrick in enthusiastic charge.

During the year there occurred the death of Mrs. C. J. Moller, of Prospect Park. She had been a faithful attendant of the Auxiliary Meetings for a number of years.
