Report

1925 marks the fourth decade of the Woman's Auxiliary to the Convocation of Chester and the continuation of its splendid work bearing out its original objective to create wider missionary interest. In 1886 \$210.37 was raised, and in 1925 \$2000 was given toward building a parish house at Collingdale. It was hoped that the Auxiliary could raise \$500 for the work at Moore, and this amount is in hand with the exception of \$25.00, which was pledged before the close of the fall meeting. The work we are to undertake in 1926 is the raising of \$2000 toward the mission building at Springfield, where there are exceptional possibilities for future work.

The spring meeting, held at the Church of the Good Shepherd, was addressed by Miss Ormsby, who spoke of her work at the Hebrew Christian Mission in Philadelphia. The fall meeting, held at St. John's, Lansdowne, was addressed by Bishop Garland, who spoke of the work of our church in Mexico. Dean Taitt told of mission work in Cuba and Mrs. Scott gave the message of the women at the General Convention.

In 1925 ten names were added to the memorial list, making a total of sixteen names. This fund has proven a very acceptable way of continuing the interest shown by a member of the Auxiliary and it is hoped that more churches will avail themselves of the privilege of perpetuating the name of a beloved member. As we go forward into 1926 let us take as our watch word the message of the women assembled at New Orleans: *"Realizing that only through personal dedication to Jesus Christ, our Lord, can we hope to bring to fruition our human endeavors, we rededicate ourselves to the service of our Lord Jesus Christ, to making the strength of our deeds the measure of our faith; to a sincere and simple effort in our daily living, to follow with humility the example of our Saviour."*
