## SECRETARY'S REPORT.

---

**I**N presenting the Fifth Annual Report of the Chicago Branch of the Woman's Auxiliary, the Secretary desires first of all to speak of the two general meetings held by the Branch during the year, as it is at these meetings that the various parts unite and the Woman's Auxiliary of this Diocese becomes a visible presence. The steady, quiet work of the six-month intervals takes voice and we recognize ourselves, not as parochial societies, but as diocesan, and not as diocesan merely, but as members of an organization whose work recognizes only the bounds of the Church Itself, "all the world."

The fourth semi-annual meeting was held in the ever-hospitable Church of the Epiphany on Thursday Oct. 4, 1888. Morning prayer was said and there was a celebration of the Holy Communion. The sermon, "Woman as a Citizen," was preached by Dr. Locke, and was listened to with deep interest and pleasure by those present. At the close of the service, the Bishop gave a short address, speaking of his visit to the Lambeth Conference and also of his desire that some of the women of the Diocese might be led to give themselves to the work of the Church as sisters.

After luncheon, served by the ladies of the Epiphany, the business meeting was held, Mrs Locke presiding. An address was made by Archdeacon Bishop on the needs of the Diocese, a special appeal being made for the Church at Grand Crossing.

Thirty-one parishes responded to the roll call. Mrs. Locke then read a short address, speaking of the work undertaken in May, 1888—the building of a chapel in memory of Mrs. Vibbert.

The Treasurer, Mrs. Raymond, read her report, which showed that the money needed for the building of the chapel had already been received. The Secretary then read letters of appeal sent by Miss Emery, and various branches made pledges for their winter's work. Mrs. Brower, chairman of the Library Committee, read her report. Miss Grosbeck, of the committee, resigned her position. Miss Anna W. Lee was appointed Librarian in her stead. Short addresses on the



work of the Correspondence Committee, by Miss Stahl, and on the Church Periodical Club, by Miss Drummond, closed the meeting, which adjourned after prayers read by the President.

The fifth annual meeting was held in the chapel of Trinity Church, Chicago, Tuesday, May 28, 1889. A short service was held which was followed by the calling of the roll, thirty-eight Branches responding, about 350 women being present. The Reports of Treasurer and Secretary gave a result of over \$12,000, an increase of about \$200 over last year's reports. Of this, some \$4000 went for work in this Diocese. Miss Stahl made a most interesting address on the work of the Correspondence Committee, which was followed by a clear and well-written paper by Mrs. Henry Starbuck of the Church Periodical Club on the work of the Club. After a discussion on the needs of the various fields, a resolution, offered by Mrs. Burroughs of S. James, was passed that if any united work should be undertaken by the Diocesan Branch in the fall it should be for the Foreign field.

Mrs. Hibbard, of Grace Church, brought up the question of the work at Grand Crossing, and Mrs. Locke spoke of the response to the appeal made at the semi-annual meeting, but of the still-existing need of help. On motion of Mrs. Lull of St. James, a collection, amounting to \$60, was taken for a Missionary in California, stricken with paralysis. The meeting then closed with prayers and the singing of a hymn. After the meeting a bountiful tea was served by the ladies of Trinity Church in the pleasant parlors of Plymouth Church.

The evening meeting was held in Trinity Church and presided over, in the absence of the Bishop, by the Rector, the Rev. Mr. Osborne. The reports were read by Rev. Dr. Vibbert of S. James and addresses made by Rev. Mr. Morrison of the Epiphany on the Diocesan Library, and by Rev. Arthur H. Locke, of Hankow, China, on the work of the Church in that country.

During the year, covered by this report, the Auxiliary was made the richer by the addition of five new branches—Trinity, Aurora; S. John's, Lockport; Grace, Sterling; S. George, Grand Crossing; and Grace, Hinsdale—being now numbered with us; all being most cordially welcomed. This brings our nominal membership up to sixty-one. Of these sixty-one branches, fifty-five contributed to the work of the Auxiliary during the year. S. Mark's, Geneva, and S. Ann's, Morrison, whose names are not on our roll as separate organizations, also contributed to the work. Our special work for the year was the building and furnishing of S.



Julia's Chapel for Indians, in Pine-Ridge Agency, S. Dakota. This work, undertaken in the loving memory of our first President, Mrs. Julia Newbold Vibbert, was accomplished with an ease and quickness which gave strong proof of her hold upon our hearts. The gifts in money, amounting to over \$1200, came from nearly every branch in the Diocese, while the gifts for the furnishing of the Chapel, amounting to over \$800, came almost entirely from S. James, Chicago, S. Andrews, Chicago, giving the organ. Of this Chapel, we hear many pleasant things, and it will always hold a warm place in the interest and affections of the Chicago Branch.

Several hundred dollars have been contributed during the year to the work at Grand Crossing, but there is need of further help there and it is hoped the Auxiliary will not forget the work of the band of women who have struggled so nobly for their Church. Various other points in the Diocese call to us for special help and to these we owe our first duty, but we must not "hold our hand" there but try and remember that while we use the terms "Foreign and Domestic," for convenience, in the highest Christian sense, all missions are "Home Missions" for "God has made of one blood all nations of men." Wherever there is need, there lies some one's duty, who shall say it is not ours?

## CONSTITUTION.

---

### ARTICLE I.

This Association shall be called THE CHICAGO-BRANCH OF THE WOMAN'S AUXILIARY TO THE BOARD OF MISSIONS.

### ARTICLE II.

The object of this Association shall be to unite all the congregations in the Diocese of Chicago in the different branches of missionary work, with special reference to the necessities of the field in our own Diocese.

### ARTICLE III.

Every parish or mission in the Diocese is a member of this Association, and, upon the payment of an annual-membership fee of one dollar, may be represented in its meetings by not more than five delegates.

### ARTICLE IV.

SEC. 1. An annual meeting shall be held during the session of the Diocesan Convention for the election of officers, the reception of reports from the various branch societies, the adoption of the annual report, and for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before such meeting.

SEC. 2. A public meeting shall be held, in conjunction with the Board of Missions, on the evening of the first day of the Diocesan Convention, in one of the churches of the city of Chicago, at which meeting the annual report shall be read, and addresses shall be delivered by speakers appointed by the Bishop.

### ARTICLE V.

SEC. 1. The officers shall be a president, three vice-presidents (one from each deanery), secretary, and treasurer, who shall constitute the Executive Committee, and shall meet monthly.

SEC. 2. The duty of the president shall be to preside at all meetings of the Association, and of the officers to arrange for the organization of branches, to visit the same, and to have the general charge of the work, under the directions of the bishop.

SEC. 3. The duty of the vice-presidents shall be to choose one of their number to preside in the absence of the president, and to coöperate with her in the general supervision of the work of the Association in the deaneries to which they respectfully belong.

SEC. 4. The duty of the secretary shall be to keep a record of the meetings and to conduct the necessary correspondence.



SEC. 5. The duty of the treasurer shall be to receive all special and general funds, to disburse the former as the donors indicate, and the latter under the direction of the Executive Committee, and to render an account of the same at the annual meeting.

## ARTICLE VI.

Each branch shall submit a report of the year's work to the secretary of the diocesan branch, to be incorporated in the annual report and read at the annual meeting.

## ARTICLE VII.

This constitution may be altered or amended at any annual meeting by a vote of two-thirds of the members present, subject to the approval of the bishop.

## BY-LAWS:

I. The election of officers at the annual meeting shall be by ballot, each parish or mission having one vote.

II. Whenever a vacancy shall occur in the Executive Committee, the president, or in her absence, the other members of the Executive Committee, shall call a meeting of the parochial officers of the diocese, at which meeting the vacancy shall be filled by the election of an officer chosen by a majority of those present. The officer so elected to serve until the next annual election.

III. Special meetings may be called by the president at such time and place as she may designate, for the purpose of stimulating interest in the work.

IV. It shall be the duty of every parochial branch to contribute annually a sum of money, the amount thereof to be determined by itself, to the Executive Committee of this diocesan branch, to be appropriated by them according to their discretion to the Missionary work of the church, which money shall constitute the General Fund of the Chicago Branch, and shall be so designated by the contributors.

V. The regular order of business at the annual meeting shall be as follows:

1. Offices of devotion.
2. Reading of minutes of last meeting.
3. Reports of officers and committees.
4. Election of officers.
5. Unfinished business.
6. Miscellaneous business and addresses.

VI. These by-laws may be amended at any annual meeting by vote of a majority present.
