RECORDING SECRETARY'S REPORT.

The fourteenth semi-annual meeting was held in S. Chrysostom's Church, Chicago, on Tuesday Nov. 1st, 1898, the Bishop presiding.

In the absence of the rector the Rev. Dr. Edsall welcomed the Auxiliary.

The roll call showed a representation from 38 branches, and about three hundred women were present. The minutes were then read and approved.

In his opening address Bishop McLaren spoke of the vastness of the work to be done for Christ at the dawn of the 20th century. We must bring to it intelligent effort. God is calling upon the nations to return to Apostolic zeal, and great events are before us.

Mrs. Sioussat, president of the Maryland branch, read an admirable paper on systematic giving. Miss Arnold called attention to the pledges made by the diocesan officers during the Convention, and Mrs. Monroe gave some account of the triennial meeting of the Auxiliary in Washington, and of the United Offering there made.

Brief addresses were given by Bishop Millspaugh of Kansas, the Rev. Dr. Rushton, and the Rev. Mr. Chattin.

A resolution of thanks to the Bishop and the speakers of the afternoon was offered by Mrs. Ward of Grace Church, after which the meeting was adjourned.

There was the usual missionary meeting in the evening, with a stirring address by Bishop Gilbert of Minnesota. He told of his early experiences as a missionary in Western Montana, and said: "A missionary should be a light bearer to touch into new life the points that seem to be extinct."

The semi-annual which follows the triennial meeting is always full of inspiration and strength. One significant fact of the convention lay in the grand missionary note there sounded.

To the Chicago branch will come many added responsibili-

ties as we send forth of our best in this diocese to the missionary field and the Episcopate.

"As Chicago is the West will be."

The offertory of the afternoon was given to the pledges made in Washington.

That of the evening, to the Mexican McLaren scholarship.

The fifteenth annual meeting was held in S. Peter's Church, Chicago, on Thursday, June 1, 1899.

At 10:30 A. M. there was a celebration of the Holy Communion by the rector, the Rev. Mr. DuMoulin, assisted by the Rev. J. H. Hopkins, of the Epiphany. The sermon was preached by the Rev. W. C. Richardson, rector of Trinity Church, and the Bishop pronounced the Absolution and the Benediction.

The Choir of S. Peter's Church rendered the musical portion of the services in a beautiful manner.

After the recessional the Rev. Mr. DuMoulin invited all to remain to luncheon, which was served by the ladies of the parish.

The business meeting was called to order at 2:30 P. M., Mrs. Lyman presiding.

After a hymn, and prayers by the Bishop, the Rev. Mr. DuMoulin welcomed the Auxiliary to his parish, and spoke of the deeper interest in missionary work among his people since his predecessor had gone out to labor in the mission field as Bishop of North Dakota.

In the absence of the recording secretary, the roll was called by the vice-president, Mrs. Fullerton, and showed that forty-nine branches were represented, and three hundred and seventy-five women were present.

The minutes of the semi-annual meeting were read by the corresponding secretary, and were approved.

The reports were next in order, and were called for by the president as follows:

That of the Society for the Relief of Widows and Orphans of Clergymen, was read by Mrs. W. R. Stirling. This report shows, at the close of its ninth year, invested funds amounting to \$68,467.67, and has six widows and eight minor children under its care.

The president gave notice that the reports of the Library

Committee and the Church Periodical Club would be printed in the annual report.

The report of the Comfort Club was read by the Secretary, Mrs. Blair, and showed that six boxes had been sent out, valued at \$130.10.

The combined report of the corresponding secretary and treasurer was read by the secretary: 406 boxes have been sent from this diocese, valued at \$8,184.07; \$3,061.25 in money has been reported to the secretary. The treasurer has received \$9,906.51 from all sources, and has disbursed \$9,781.65. The total disbursements of the secretary and treasurer were \$21,026.97. Of this sum, \$8,486.27 was given to diocesan missions, and \$12,410.38 to domestic and foreign missions.

After the reports had been read, the president introduced Mrs. Brunson, president of the Minnesota branch, who came in response to an invitation sent to Miss Carter to come to this meeting and speak of the work done by Indian women in the lace schools.

Mrs. Brunson's address was most interesting, and left an impression which will no doubt lead to continued assistance in Miss Carter's work.

Mrs. Brunson was asked to bear this assurance to Miss Carter, together with the greetings of the Chicago branch.

The address of the president was followed with closest attention by all present.

She reviewed the work of the Chicago branch for the four years during which the present committee has served the Auxiliary, and the efforts to grow and reach out to a larger and wider interest, always under the general supervision of the Bishop.

The address referred to our work under the City Missionary, done by a devoted church woman. Mrs. Lyman urged an effort to raise one thousand dollars for this work.

Attention was especially directed to the Cathedral Mission work, as done in S. Mary's Home for Children. A new home is greatly needed, and some aggressive work should be done quickly to insure its success.

Mrs. Lyman asked that the paper prepared by the Sister Margaret Clare be carefully read in each branch, and also urged

an earnest effort on the part of all members to know more of the Auxiliary and its work, as done for Christ.

After the address the president read a letter just received from a lady who will give her jewels, valued at \$8,000, to be sold, and the money given to S. Mary's Home for Children.

Pledges for the City Missionary were then called for, and met with a generous response, eight hundred and seventy-nine dollars being promised for this work.

Some proposed changes in the constitution were submitted, each change being read to the Auxiliary and sanctioned by a rising vote. The Bishop made a short address on the work done by the officers, and paid a special tribute to the president for her faithful devotion to her duty.

The following officers were chosen for the ensuing year: President, Mrs. D. B. Lyman, La Grange; vice-presidents, Miss K. D. Arnold, of S. James; Mrs. V. B. Fullerton, of Ottawa; Miss A. B. Stahl, of Galena; Mrs. W. D. C. Street, of S. Chrysostom, and Mrs. J. H. Hopkins, of Epiphany; treasurer, Mrs. James T. Hoyne, of Trinity; corresponding secretary, Mrs. C. O. Meacham, of Grace; recording secretary, Mrs. Geo. A. Coe, of S. Paul's, Hyde Park.

The offering of the morning was given to the general fund. That of the afternoon to the mission house in China, for which we have a pledge.

The thanks of the officers and members of the Auxiliary were extended to the rector and ladies of S. Peter's parish for their hospitality, after which the meeting was adjourned with the doxology and the benediction.

These have all been forwarded at the expense of the donors, or free of charge by the express companies.

CONSTITUTION.

ARTICLE I.

This Association shall be called THE CHICAGO BRANCH OF THE WOMAN'S AUXILIARY TO THE BOARD OF MISSIONS.

ARTICLE II.

The object of this Association shall be to unite all the congregations in the Diocese of Chicago in the different branches of missionary work, as conducted by the General and Diocesan Boards.

ARTICLE III.

Every parish or mission in the Diocese is a member of this Association, and, upon the payment of an annual membership fee of one dollar, shall be entitled to representation at the meetings, each parish or mission voting as a unit, when such vote by unit shall be demanded by two parishes or missions.

ARTICLE IV.

SEC. 1. An annual meeting shall be held the day after the close of the Diocesan Convention, except when that day falls on a legal holiday, when the Executive Committee shall appoint another day, for the election of officers, the adoption of the annual report, and the transaction of such other business as may properly come before such meeting.

SEC. 2. A semi-annual meeting shall be held in the autumn, at the discretion of the Executive Committee; which meeting shall consist of an afternoon session for the transaction of business, followed by a general missionary meeting in the evening, when addresses shall be made by speakers, approved by the Bishop and the Executive Committee.

ARTICLE V.

SEC. 1. The officers shall be a president, five vice-presidents, a corresponding secretary, a recording secretary, and a

treasurer, who shall constitute the Executive Committee and meet monthly.

SEC. 2. The Executive Committee shall have power, as necessity may arise, to appoint annually, with the approval of the Bishop, other officers who shall not, however, be members of the Executive Committee.

SEC. 3. The duty of the president shall be to preside at all meetings of the Association and of the officers; to arrange for the organization of branches, to visit the same and to have the general charge of the work, under the direction of the Bishop.

SEC. 4. The duty of the vice-presidents shall be to choose one of their number to preside in the absence of the president, to co-operate with her in the general supervision of the work of the Association, and to take special charge of the departments of work to which they may be assigned by the Executive Committee.

SEC. 5. The duty of the corresponding secretary shall be to conduct the necessary correspondence required by the Auxiliary, and to prepare such reports as are needed. The duty of the recording secretary shall be to send out notices of all meetings, to keep a record of the same, and to assist the corresponding secretary in the preparation of reports.

SEC. 6. The duty of the treasurer shall be to receive all special and general funds, to disburse the former as the donors indicate, and the latter under the direction of the Executive Committee, and to render an account of the same at the annual meeting.

SEC. 7. There shall be a committee of two appointed to audit the treasurer's accounts each year.

ARTICLE VI.

Each branch shall submit a report of the year's work to the corresponding secretary of the diocesan branch, to be incorporated in the annual report and read at the annual meeting.

ARTICLE VII.

This constitution may be altered or amended at any annual meeting by a vote of two-thirds of the members present, subject to the approval of the Bishop.

BY-LAWS.

I. The election of officers at the annual meeting shall be by ballot, each parish or mission having one vote.

II. When a vacancy shall occur in the Executive Committee by death or resignation, or removal of residence from the diocese, the members of said Committee shall have power, with the advice and consent of the Bishop previously obtained, to appoint an officer to fill the vacancy. The officer so appointed to serve until the next annual meeting.

III. Special meetings may be called by the president at such time and place as she may designate, for the purpose of stimulating interest in the work.

IV. It shall be the duty of every parochial branch to contribute annually a sum of money, the amount thereof to be determined by itself, to the Executive Committee of this diocesan branch, to be appropriated by them according to their discretion in the Missionary work of the church, which money shall constitute the General Fund of the Chicago Branch, and shall be so designated by the contributors.

V. The regular order of business at the annual meeting shall be as follows:

1. Offices of devotion.
2. Calling of roll by branches.
3. Reading of minutes of last meeting.
4. Reports of officers and committees.
5. Election of officers.
6. Unfinished business.
7. Miscellaneous business and addresses.

VI. These by-laws may be amended at any annual meeting by a majority vote of the branches present.

THE ANNUAL DAY OF PRAYER for Missions is held on S. Andrew's Day, November 30.

The Annual Meeting is held on the day after the close of the Diocesan Convention.

The Semi-Annual Meeting is held in the autumn, generally in October, the date being fixed by the president, and due notice being given to all the Parochial Branches.

A meeting of the Diocesan officers is held on the first Thursday of each month, at the Church Club Rooms, room 510 Masonic Temple, Chicago.

Different branches are asked to co-operate with the President in taking charge of the noon-day meetings. Interesting papers are read, and Missionaries speak on the work in their jurisdictions.

It is hoped that each branch will send at least two representatives to these monthly meetings.
