One might think from this correspondence that the whole Diocese had been visited by the Traveling Secretary, but though 26 visits have been made, and the story of the Woman's Auxiliary told, there are several places yet unvisited, and these places where as yet the Traveling Secretary is not wanted, are really the places where she is most needed, so the correspondence goes, if the Traveling Secretary does not—and she hopes and prays for the time to come when every little band of Church women in our Diocese will wish to be united in prayer and work with the Woman's Auxiliary. Have explained especially the apportionment and Current Expense Fund as asked to do by our President and find that the majority think it would be wise for a committee to reapportion the amount apportioned to the Diocesan Branch among the various Parish Branches. Literature of various kinds is sent to me from Church Missions House which is distributed as needed.

## CONSTITUTION.

### ARTICLE I.

This society shall be called "The Kansas City Diocesan Branch of the Woman's Auxiliary to the Board of Missions."

### ARTICLE II.

Its object shall be, by united effort and sympathetic action, to increase the interest, and to unite all parishes and missions, in the diocese, in the missionary work of the church.

### ARTICLE III.

All baptized women of this diocese shall be regarded as members of this society.

### ARTICLE IV.

The officers shall be: A President, six Vice-Presidents, a Recording Secretary, a Corresponding Secretary and a Treasurer. They shall be elected at the annual meeting.

### ARTICLE V.

The diocese shall be divided into six districts, each of which shall have a President, who shall hold office of Vice-President in the Board. The districts shall be: Kansas City, St. Joseph, Sedalia, Springfield, Carthage and Chillicothe. The districts shall be designated by the Bishop.

### ARTICLE VI.

There shall be a Board of Managers, consisting of the diocesan officers and the Presidents of the parish branches. Nine of these shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business. A preliminary meeting of the Board shall be called one month before each regular meeting of the Auxiliary.

### ARTICLE VII.

Each parish and mission shall be represented at the regular meetings by its officers and four delegates chosen by the parish branch. A membership fee of fifty cents a year shall be paid in advance by all officers and delegates, and one of twenty-five cents a year by all delegates of the Junior branches.

### ARTICLE VIII.

Special meetings may be called by the President at any time. There shall be three regular meetings each year, the fourth Thursdays in October and January, and the annual meeting, which shall be held on the day following the annual diocesan council. The Church or other place of meeting shall be designated by the President.



## ARTICLE IX.

This Constitution may be amended at any meeting of the Auxiliary, the proposed amendment having been submitted in writing at a previous meeting, by a two-thirds vote of the delegates present.

### BY-LAWS.

1. The president shall call meetings and preside over them. In the absence of the president a vice-president shall preside.
2. The recording secretary shall keep the minutes of the meeting, receive all moneys and make a record of them before paying the same to the treasurer. She shall also prepare an annual report for circulation in the diocese.
3. The corresponding secretary shall conduct the correspondence of the society, shall send notices of the meetings, and shall make a full report of the work annually to the general secretary of the Woman's Auxiliary in New York.
4. The treasurer shall receive and disburse all moneys as ordered by the society, presenting a report of the same at each regular meeting.
5. The president of each district shall call and preside over meetings and direct the work in her district. She shall also send to the corresponding secretary five days before the annual meeting a list of the delegates from the parishes in her district.
6. It shall be the duty of the treasurer of each parochial branch and mission to send all moneys from the various custodians to the recording secretary five days before the meeting at which the amounts are to be reported.
7. A current expense fund shall be raised by assessment of twenty-five cents a year on each member; members of the Junior branches shall pay ten cents a year. These amounts shall be forwarded to the recording secretary at least five days before the annual meeting.
8. There shall be a Nominating Committee of five, appointed by the president at the meeting previous to the annual meeting. The officers shall be elected by ballot.
9. These by-laws may be repealed, amended or suspended at any meeting by a two-thirds vote of the members present.
