
## **"BRING THEE HITHER TO ME"**

The Woman's Auxiliary asks for the prayers of the Church on the Festival of the Transfiguration of Christ (August 6), the Auxiliary's "Altar Day."

The following resolution was unanimously adopted at the Annual Meeting of the Woman's Auxiliary, St. John's Church, Los Angeles, May 24, 1898, and endorsed the following day by the Diocesan Convention, with the addition that where practicable the offerings be devoted to the General Fund of the Woman's Auxiliary, viz.:

**Resolved**, That we set apart the Feast of the Epiphany for an Auxiliary Day, and that, as members of the Auxiliary, we consider it not only a privilege but a duty to attend the services held on that day in the parish to which we belong; and further,

**Resolved**, That should the appointment of this day meet with the approbation of the clergymen of the Diocese, they be requested to offer, at the celebration of the Holy Eucharist on the Feast of the Epiphany, special prayers for the work of the Auxiliary.

Grant that to many hearts may go the call of opportunity to serve Thee in this work, in the bearing of others' burdens and the fulfillment of the law of Christ. In what they think and do, enable them to hear the voice of Thy Son to guide and strengthen them. And in all the means of grace in Thy Church, and more especially in the Holy Communion at Thy Altars, help them to see Him Who is invisible, that in their aims and difficulties and trials they may have the abiding faith that all things are possible to them that believe. We ask this for the merits of Him Who came not to be ministered unto, but to minister, Thy Son, our Saviour, Jesus Christ. Amen.

O Lord, our Heavenly Father, we pray Thee to send forth more laborers into Thy harvest, and to grant them Thy special grace for every need. 



## Minutes of the Fortieth Annual Meeting of the Woman's Auxiliary

The fortieth Annual Meeting of the Woman's Auxiliary was held on January 28, 1936, at St. John's Church, Los Angeles. Holy Communion was celebrated at nine-thirty with Bishop Stevens as celebrant, assisted by Bishop Gooden, Dr. Davidson and the Rev. Harry G. Gray.

The business session was called to order at ten-thirty by the President, Miss Patton. After a hymn, the Auxiliary prayers were read by Bishop Stevens. Mrs. George Davidson, President of St. John's Branch, welcomed the Auxiliary. The reading of the minutes of the thirty-ninth Annual Meeting was omitted on motion. The reports of the officers were read, that of the Treasurer being accepted on motion. The reports of the department heads were then heard, that of the Educational Secretary being read by the Recording Secretary in the absence of Mrs. Laslett. Mrs. B. W. Vallat gave a report on the Birthday Thank Offering and box work of the Church Schools. Mrs. George F. Weld read a report of the Committee on Church Literature for the Blind. Mrs. W. B. Stevens gave a short message of greeting and Miss Rebekah Hibbard spoke briefly of the meetings of the National Council which she had attended during the year.

Roll call showed 475 present from 62 branches in the Los Angeles Convocation, 30 from 10 branches in the San Bernardino, 21 from 10 branches in the San Diego, and 22 from 5 branches in the Santa Barbara with 3 visitors from 3 other dioceses.

The report of the nominating committee was presented by Mrs. G. A. Hanson, chairman, nominating Mrs. C. J O'Connor of Monrovia as Treasurer. Nominations from the floor were called for but none were made. It was moved and passed that the nominations be closed and that the secretary cast the ballot for the nominee.

The President read the list of department heads appointed by the Executive Committee for the coming year, as follows: U. T. O. Treasurer, Mrs. George A. Robison; Supply Secretary, Mrs. Quintin; Educational Secretary, Mrs. Lawrence Laslett; Social Service Secretary, Mrs. John L. Riddell; Directress of Altar Department,

Mrs. Roy L. Strong; Chairman Advance Work Program, Mrs. F. A. Habersham; Secretary Pre-School Department and Font Roll, Mrs. R. B. Gooden; Diocesan Directress, Church Periodical Club, Mrs. Livingstone Porter. Miss Patton also announced the appointment of Mrs. Fred Mercer of Ventura as Recording Secretary to fill the unexpired term of Mrs. O'Connor, resigned.

After noonday prayers, read by the President, the meeting was adjourned for lunch.

Upon reconvening at 2:00 P.M., Dr. Davidson extended a welcome to the Auxiliary.

Mrs. J. E. Cowles was called to the chair. She called attention to the fact that there were four past presidents present, Mrs. P. G. Hubert, Miss Helen G. Magill, Miss Rebekah L. Hibbard, and herself. Miss Patton then read her President's address.

A motion was made and passed that a vote of appreciation be given the retiring Treasurer and retiring Directress of the Altar Department.

A motion was made and passed that a vote of thanks be extended to St. John's Auxiliary and to Miss Davidson, Mistress of Ceremonies.

A motion was made and passed that a vote of appreciation be sent to the outgoing Recording Secretary.

Miss A. Bowden, Principal, St. Phillip's Junior College for Negroes, San Antonio, Texas, spoke on the work of the college and the need for such an institution.

Mrs. William P. Remington of the Missionary District of Eastern Oregon, gave a helpful and inspiring talk on "The Auxiliary and the Forward Movement."

The offering, which was announced for the work at St. Philip's Junior College and for that in Eastern Oregon, was then taken.

Bishop Stevens dismissed the meeting with the Benediction.

## Condensed Report of the Vice-President-at-Large






### **Report of the Vice-President of the Los Angeles Convocation**



## Report of the Supply Department

The Lenten work for 1935 was sent to the following stations: The Cathedral Home for Children, Wyoming; St. Anne's Mission, El Paso; St. Francis Mission, Philippines; St. Paul's Mission, and St. Mark's School, Alaska; also St. Thomas Mission, Point Hope Alaska, and the Robert W. Shingle Hospital, Hawaii. One hundred and seven Branches worked for these Missions. There were 91 boxes and five large bales sent valued at \$5,108.06. Also individual gifts to the amount of \$483.35 were contributed. The supplies all reached their destinations, and letters of thanks have been received from the Missionaries.

For Advent we sent two personal boxes to missionaries in the United States, one being filled by St. Paul's, San Diego, and the other by All Saints', Pasadena. St. Paul's, Pomona, sent a suit and two sets of underwear to an Indian Catechist, the Girl's Friendly sent two \$5.00 Christmas gifts to women missionaries. Besides this, thirty-four checks were sent to Diocesan Missionaries at Christmas. The Advent total was \$1,193.70. The Girl's Friendly contributed to the Supply Department \$279.70, thus making the total for the year \$6,780.11.



## **Report of the Social Service Department of the Woman's Auxiliary in the Diocese of Los Angeles**

The Branches and interested individuals through the Diocesan Treasurer have contributed to the Social Service Department \$1,862.95 for relief work; besides this amount clothing has been distributed, also food and medicine, the case work which did not fall on any particular Parish has been carried on by this department. At Christmas and Thanksgiving baskets were distributed as usual but not as many as in past years because many Parishes took care of their own. Employment has been secured for fourteen women and five men. One of our Social Service Secretaries, Mrs. Harry Reynolds, presented to the National Council of Federated Church Women the program of our National Council in this field of work. They accepted it. My recently appointed assistant, Mrs. E. C. Barrett, is proving of great value in presenting the work of this Department to the Branches.

## **Report of Educational Department**

The past year has shown a wide range of topics covered in many parish classes; also a deepening of spiritual life among the women in prayer groups and Bible classes.

I have spoken at two Convocation meetings, five District meetings, addressed twenty-four Branch sessions and have held five leaders conferences. A well stocked book table has been shown at each diocesan meeting also daily at the Cathedral during Convention week and at Harvard Summer School.

Receipts from the sale of books, pamphlets, magazines, etc., and from gifts, \$924.36; expenditures for printing, postage, purchase of books, magazines, etc., \$909.20, leaving a balance of \$15.16.

I am happy to report that the Prayer Partnership plan has been adopted by this Diocese and Mrs. George Edwards appointed secretary.


### **Report of the Altar Department**




### **Report of the Church Periodical Club**

## President's Address

*Bishop Stevens, Bishop Gooden, Officers and Members of the  
Woman's Auxiliary, Diocese of Los Angeles.*

This is our fortieth Annual Meeting, we have had many celebrations of this fact during the past few months. It is well perhaps to stop and think for a moment how we have grown. We started with twenty-four branches, most of them are still in existence; we end this year with one hundred and eleven. The faith, the enthusiasm and the unfailing devotion of the women of the Church have made this growth a spiritual as well as a material one. Let us be very careful to keep it so. In a new country the growth is inevitable, but to have the right kind of growth is up to us; let us therefore keep faith with our founders and carry forward under the banner of Christ.

The Woman's Auxiliary is an international and interracial fellowship, working together for the furtherance of God's Kingdom on Earth. Only by remembering this can we maintain our efficiency. Miss Lindley writes in her quarterly letter that we should be occupied with large things, that the Church faces great questions, and that we must think about them and help solve them. This is very true, but we must also be practical in our efforts. It is not enough to say, "Yes, indeed the world faces a crisis." We must act out our part in that crisis to the very best that is in us. Take for example the Forward Movement; you will hear about that from Mrs. Remington this afternoon, but when you have heard, take that message back to your Branches and do something about it.

WE ARE THE CHURCH, on us depends its success or failure, not on a vague organization somewhere that we can blame for things we dislike, but on us ourselves rests the responsibility. Another phase of our work, Christian Social Service, has come to stay. Are we, as Church women, incorporating it into our mission of the Church; are we doing our bit towards social justice?

On February 28 there is to be a World Day of Prayer among all Christian people. I hope that we will enter into this in our communities, and use that day the pamphlets on peace which you have been given today.

There has been a fine forward looking movement in this Diocese to combine the women's work into one good organization. I hope that this goes forward; it is being urged and encouraged throughout the Church and when it has come about it will increase our ability to work and to succeed very greatly. I should be very proud if Los Angeles could lead the country in making this an accomplished fact.

One exceedingly important thing in parish and diocesan meetings is programs, to have interesting ones, but above all to have suitable ones, for what is right in one branch may be very wrong in another.

The Supply Department in New York is having a very hard time this year in getting the many calls from Missions filled, so let us as a Diocese cooperate with Mrs. Quintin and fill our quota one hundred per cent; we can do it, and it is worth the effort. So do all you are asked for Lent and then a wee bit more.

I hope that during the luncheon interval you were all able to see the Book of Remembrance, that is not being used as much as we had hoped. It is such a lovely way to keep green the memory of faithful workers in our Auxiliary that I wish it could be more thought about and spoken of in your meetings.

We have at St. Margaret's House, Berkeley, a new student secretary for the Province, Miss Gammack; we hope that we may have her in this Diocese some time soon and hear from her about her work. These workers among the students do an uncounted amount of good in these days of lack of interest amongst our college boys and girls.

Again this year we have changes in our Diocesan Board, and welcome new officers and regretfully say good-bye to old ones. Change is always sad, I think. We welcome our new Diocesan Treasurer, Mrs. C. J. O'Connor, and we know we shall enjoy working with her in her new capacity, but we hate to lose Mrs. Crawford from the Board. The treasurer never has a spectacular role, but she could not be gotten along without, and she has a great deal of hard work. Mrs. Crawford always did that work joyfully and well. We deeply appreciate it.

Mrs. W. J. Pierce, the head of the Altar Department, has felt that she, too, must resign. We are very sorry to lose her splendid work and her companionship. She has literally worked her fingers to the bone to make beautiful the altars of our little Missions, and I know that they are undyingly grateful to her. We welcome the new head of the Altar Department, Mrs. Roy Strong, and we know that we shall enjoy working with her and will try in every way to cooperate with her. Mrs. Fred Mercer of Ventura has been appointed to fill out the unexpired term of the Recording Secretary, and we welcome her also and are glad that she represents one of the other Convocations. Motor cars and good roads have at least done that. We can now stretch forth our hands and pluck Diocesan Officers from any part of the Diocese; it gives wider choice, more varied outlook, and it draws the Diocese closer together.

Next year another Triennial will be held by all the women of the Church. Are we studying, thinking and discussing the message which was sent out from our last Triennial, so that we shall be more capable of entering into the next? I hope so. I am very proud of you, my friends; I feel very humble that I have been chosen as your president, and I am very well aware that I am nothing without you, but as head of the Los Angeles Diocesan Auxiliary, I feel justified in thinking that the large things which face us can be met in a true and spiritual manner, that we can go forth and accomplish great things, in the name of Jesus Christ our Lord and Master.

### **Report of the Woman's Auxiliary**

*Submitted to the Annual Convention January 29, 1936*

During the year 1935 the Woman's Auxiliary has held seven Diocesan meetings, at which we were fortunate enough to secure interesting and instructive speakers. These meetings have been well attended. On account of the celebration of the 40th Anni-

versary of the Diocese falling on the same day we did not hold our annual diocesan Quiet Day this year; we did, however, make a special effort to have all the Branches take part in the November 11th Day of Prayer. I feel that the spiritual note of the Auxiliary has increased and that there are more Branch quiet days and corporate communions.

The Educational Department reports a good year with many books being bought, and by more study groups. There was a well stocked book table at the Convention last year, and at Summer School as well as at all of our Diocesan meetings.

The Church Periodical Club reports an increasing amount of literature sent out, and has adopted for its slogan the coming year "A C.P.C. secretary in every parish, and a Church Periodical in every town or city library." I have every hope that this will become an accomplished fact during 1936.

The Supply Department sent out 81 boxes and five bales to nine Mission Stations, in both foreign and domestic fields, valued at \$5,108.06 during last Lent. In Advent checks were sent to missionaries to the amount of \$1,218.70. Besides this there were gifts from individuals amounting to \$483.35, so that during 1935 the Supply Department sent money and material to the total of \$6,810.11.

During the year the Social Service Department has given through our Diocesan treasurer \$1,862.95 to help families of needy Church people; besides this, much money has been given by individuals which has enabled the department to carry on its splendid and increasing work. Baskets were distributed at Thanksgiving and Christmas. We are happy to report that the Social Service Programme of the National Council of the Episcopal Church has been accepted by the National Council of Federated Church Women. This is a big forward step.

The United Thank Offering has had a splendid year of work and accomplishment, and more women are giving through it than ever before in the history of our Diocese. During 1935 \$5,997.02 was given and as this is the first year of the Triennium we feel that Los Angeles has just cause to be proud.

It is with regret that I report that the head of the Altar Department, Mrs. W. J. Pierce, felt that she could no longer continue the work and sent in her resignation. She has done a very fine piece of work for this department and we shall miss her very much indeed. During the past year she has helped in different ways fourteen of our missions, and she has never spared herself in her work, which was of the highest order. We of the Auxiliary welcome her successor, Mrs. Roy Strong, and will give her our full cooperation in her work.




## CONSTITUTION

1. This organization shall be called, **The Los Angeles Diocesan Branch of the Woman's Auxiliary to the National Council.**
2. The object of this organization is: To advance the devotional life of the women of the Church, and to support the work of the National Council in all its Departments.
3. Membership shall be open to any woman in the Diocese of Los Angeles, who is willing to help further the object of this Auxiliary.
4. The officers shall consist of: a President, a Vice-President-at-Large, a Vice-President for each Convocation, a Recording Secretary, a Corresponding Secretary, and a Treasurer.
5. Officers shall be elected as follows: The President and Recording Secretary at the Annual Diocesan Meeting the year of the Triennial. The Vice-President-at-Large and the Corresponding Secretary at the Annual Diocesan Meeting the year following the Triennial. The Treasurer at the Annual Diocesan Meeting the year preceding the Triennial. These officers shall be elected for a term of three years, and may not hold the same office for more than two consecutive terms. The Vice-Presidents of the several Convocations shall be elected for a term of two years at the Convocational Auxiliary meeting preceding the Annual Diocesan Meeting. All elections shall be by ballot.
6. The Executive Committee shall consist of: The President, the Vice-President-at-Large, the Recording Secretary, the Corresponding Secretary and the Treasurer.
7. All Departments of the Auxiliary shall correspond to those in the National Council. The Chairman of each Department shall superintend the work of her department in consultation with the Executive Committee. The Department Chairmen shall be appointed annually by the Executive Committee.
8. The Diocesan Board shall consist of: The Executive Committee, the Convocational Vice-Presidents, and the Chairmen of all Departments.
9. Any member of the National Executive Board, and any Provincial officer of the Eighth Province, residing in the Diocese shall be a member of the Diocesan Board.

10. A Branch of the Woman's Auxiliary may be formed in any Parish or Mission with the consent of the rector or clergyman in charge, by notifying the Convocational Vice-President.

11. The Annual Meeting shall be held at the time of the Diocesan Convention, and monthly Diocesan Meetings on such dates and in such places as the President may appoint. General meetings may be arranged by the Vice-Presidents in their respective Convocations.

12. An Annual Quiet Day shall be held during the Season of Advent.



## BY-LAWS

1. The duty of the President shall be to preside at the meetings of the Diocesan Auxiliary, and have general charge of the work, under the direction of the Bishop. The Vice-President-at-Large shall act for the President in her absence, and assist her in her work.

2. The duties of the Convocational Vice-Presidents shall be to preside at the general meetings held in their Convocations, to organize all new branches, and to cooperate with the President in the supervision of the work of the Diocesan Auxiliary.

3. The duty of the Corresponding Secretary shall be to correspond with all Branches in the Diocese, to receive their reports, and to prepare the Annual Report.

4. The duty of the Recording Secretary shall be to give notice of meetings, to keep a record of such meetings and to prepare an abstract of the minutes for the Annual Report.

5. The duty of the Treasurer shall be to keep an account of all money received and expended and to make a report at the Annual Diocesan Meeting.

6. All requests for information or supplies from Parish Branches shall be made to Diocesan officers or Chairmen of Departments and not to National Headquarters.

7. Each Branch of the Auxiliary to be in good standing shall pay an annual pledge according to its ability to the following Diocesan Funds: General Working Fund, Bishop's Discretionary Fund and the Altar Fund. These pledges and all other money, with the exception of the United Thank Offering, shall be sent through the Diocesan Treasurer, and all checks made out to her.

8. All money collected by the Branches for the United Thank Offering Fund shall be sent to the Diocesan United Thank Offering Treasurer and by her to the Diocesan Auxiliary Treasurer.

9. At the Annual Diocesan Meeting only those Branches in good standing shall have a vote, and each Branch shall have but one vote.

10. A Nominating Committee shall be appointed each year by the Bishop, at least six months before the Annual Diocesan Meeting, and shall consist of a Chairman and one member from each Convocation. Nominations may be made from the floor at the time of the Annual Diocesan Meeting provided that the consent of the nominee has been previously obtained.

11. Delegates to the Triennial and to the Woman's Auxiliary of the Provincial Synod shall be appointed by the President, with the consent of the Executive Committee.

12. The Constitution and By-Laws must be read in every Branch at its Annual Meeting.

13. The Constitution may be amended by a motion made at the Annual Diocesan Meeting and voted on the following year. The By-Laws may be amended at any Annual Diocesan Meeting by a two-thirds vote of Branches present and voting, provided the proposed amendment has been submitted in writing to the Branches sixty days before the meeting.
