Helena, June 21, 1905.

The Second Annual Meeting of the Woman's Parochial and Missionary Society of the Diocese of Montana, was held in St. Peter's Church, Helena, June 21, 1905.

The Holy Communion was celebrated by the Bishop, assisted by the Rev. S. D. Hooker.

After the service, the business meeting was called to order by the Vice-President, Mrs. Patterson.

The Secretary called the Roll and found the following number of Representatives present: Helena, 15; Butte, St. John's, 5; St. Paul's, 3; Centerville, 1; Great Falls, 2; Anaconda, 3; Missoula, 1; Kalispell, 1; Virginia City, 1; Deer Lodge, 1; Bozeman, 2; Madison Valley, 1; Fort Benton, 1; Dillon, 2; Townsend, 5; Boulder, 2; Lewistown, 2; Billings, 1; Philipsburg, 1; Big Timber, 2; Fridley, 1; Red Lodge, 1. Total, 54.

A letter, in regard to the United Offering of 1907, from Miss Julia C. Emery, Secretary of the Woman's Auxiliary, was read.

The Reports of the Treasurer and Secretary were read and approved.

After Noon Day Prayers, which were said by the Rev. H. E. Clowes, a recess was taken until 1:30 p. m.

At 1:30 p. m. the meeting was called to order by the Vice-President.

Hymn 254 was sung.

Minutes of the Morning session were read and approved.

The President's Address was then read by the Vice-President.

THE PRESIDENT'S ADDRESS.

My Dear Friends: It is a great disappointment that I am not able to be with you today. I feel that I need every opportunity to become better acquainted with you all and I hope this will be the last time that I shall have to miss a Convention.

Since we last came together, the Triennial meeting of the Woman's Auxiliary has met in Boston and I wished so much that

some other Montana women, besides our deaconess and myself, could have been there to store up inspiration and knowledge for our work here. During all those three weeks, from four to six hundred women met twice a day, and often three times every day in the week except Saturday and Sunday, to listen to missionaries and to discuss ways and means of carrying on their work. If you could have seen those missionaries and heard them tell about their work, women as well as men, and some of them so full of enthusiasm, you felt you must drop everything and go and help them; you would have different ideas about many things. One of which would be that The Spirit of Missions would be positively interesting, yes, even thrilling in places. For the faces of the men and women would come up before you and you would be able to read between the lines of their articles until you almost felt you had seen them again and shaken them by the hand.

You cannot possibly be interested in Missions unless you know something about them and get to feel it is all real live work. And so I hope that after the paper on the Ichang missionaries and the discussion on Mission Study Classes, this afternoon, you will all feel anxious to study more next year. There is no need that you have a separate organization for it, the only need is that you do it. Every group of women may wish to go about it a different way; there are subjects and methods enough to suit all, but let me tell you there is an interest that comes from a united study course that does not come with the others, also the subjects are especially chosen and the helps for preparing the lessons especially full. The Rev. Everett P. Smith, Church Missions House, 281 Fourth Avenue, New York, and Miss Mary Beach, 211 State Street, Hartford, Connecticut, are the people to whom to write for information about material for Mission Study Classes.

Two other subjects that interested me very strongly at the Triennial meeting were the splendid organization of the Eastern Auxiliaries and their custom of having the Diocesan Officers visit all the Auxiliaries in their Diocese.

In the Eastern Dioceses, with their smaller number of square miles, it is easier to travel and look after the work, but I hope the time is not far distant when our officers will be able to visit the different Auxiliaries and Mission Study Classes in this Diocese and not only help them, but be inspired and encouraged by the good work that is being done.

Our organization is good as far as it goes, but there is one point where it can be improved right away. I often lose a great deal of time because I do not know who the workers are and what they are doing, so I wish you would all let our Secretary, Mrs. Gibble, know:

First—The names and addresses of all the Officers in every Parish and Mission Auxiliary, remembering to inform her when any changes are made.

Second—Let her know when a Study Class is formed with the names and addresses of the Officers and the subject to be studied.

I will ask her to send this information to me and so we will be able to keep track of what is going on among ourselves, and I hope make us all feel more strongly than ever the fact that we belong to the one family of the Diocese.

In our Parish work we think of ourselves, but in the Diocese we have many things to bring us together:

The Bishop's Missionary.

The Henrietta Brewer Memorial Hospital.

The Alaska Box.

The United Offering and our Offerings for Domestic and Foreign Missions.

The Mission Study Classes.

As I write I do not know what the Reports from these objects will be this year, but I am sure they will show progress. I know that you take more interest in them than you did in the past and yet I urge you to take even more. Learn about each one until it is absolutely familiar to you and then see that your friends understand too, until every woman feels that she must do her share in the work of the Diocese.

With knowledge and with prayer there will come abundant fruits and the world will be so much the better off because we women of Montana have joined together to do just as much of our Savior's work as we possibly can.

We also wish to express our sincere love for him and appreciation of his earnest and faithful work, and we hope and pray that he may be spared for many years to continue this work for the Glory of God and the spread of Christ's Kingdom.

The Report of the Secretary of the Junior Auxiliary and Babies' Branch was read and approved.

Mrs. Mynard reported the box for Alaska packed in Great Falls.

Mrs. McDonald reported the box packed in Butte.

Mrs. McDonald moved that the work for Alaska be continued. Carried.

The following Pledges for the Bishop's Missionary were made: Helena, \$100; Butte, St. John's, \$150; St. Paul's, \$10; Centerville, \$15; Great Falls, \$75; Anaconda, \$25; Missoula, \$20; Virginia City, \$10; Deer Lodge, \$10; Bozeman, \$35; Madison Valley, \$10; Dillon, \$35; Glendive, \$5; Townsend, \$10; Boulder, \$10; Philipsburg, \$10; Sheridan, \$10; Kalispell, \$15; Big Timber, \$20; Billings, \$25; Red Lodge, \$15; Fridley, \$10; Lewistown, \$10; Cameron, \$5.

Mrs. Cobban of Butte read an instructive paper on "The Woman's Auxiliary."

It was moved and seconded that the Editor of the Montana Churchman be requested to publish it. Carried.

A letter from China requesting a gift of books for Boone School Library, was read. In response, there was an Offering of \$14.04 and the Gift of four books. It was moved and seconded that the money and books be sent to Mrs. Hooker. Carried.

A paper on "Our Work in Ichang, China," by Mrs. Cory of Helena, was read by Mrs. Atwater.

Reports of methods of Guild Work were made by Mrs. Cobban of Butte, Mrs. Quinney of Virginia City and Mrs. Booker of Helena.

After a solo by Mrs. Moore of Philipsburg, the Vice-President asked for a Report of Mission Study Classes.

Mrs. Dodds of Anaconda, told of the interesting class in Helena; Mrs. Cobban of Butte, Mrs. Berg of Townsend, Miss Paxton of Dillon and Mrs. Edwards of Missoula gave excellent Reports of the classes in their respective fields.

Mrs. McDonald reported that the Offering at the Morning service amounted to \$25. It was moved and seconded that this amount be placed in the Contingent Fund.

An Amendment, offered by Mrs. Atwater, that \$10 be placed in the Contingent Fund and \$15 in the United Offering, was carried.

It was moved and seconded that the Editor of the Montana Churchman be requested to print the paper written by Mrs. Cory. Carried.

The following Resolution, offered by Mrs. Wakefield, was, on motion, adopted by a rising vote.

Resolved, That the Woman's Parochial and Missionary Society express its regret at the inability of its President and Treasurer to be present at this, its Annual meeting.

It was moved and seconded that Convention be asked to print 500 copies of the Proceedings of Woman's Day. Carried.

Mrs. Quinney of Virginia City offered the following resolution:

Resolved, That we, the members of the Woman's Parochial and Missionary Society, thankfully appreciate the hearty and generous manner in which the Rector and members of St. Peter's Parish and the people of Helena have entertained us during the whole of this Convention.

The Minutes of the Afternoon Session were read and approved. The meeting then adjourned until next Convention.
