

Proceedings of the Woman's Parochial and Missionary Society

(The Woman's Parochial and Missionary Society in its missionary capacity is the Montana branch of the Woman's Auxiliary to the Board of Missions.)

June 18, 1913.

The tenth annual meeting of the Woman's Parochial and Missionary Society of the Diocese of Montana was held in St. Luke's church, Billings. The meeting opened with a celebration of the Holy Communion at 9:30 a. m. by Bishop Brewer, assisted by the Rev. Royal K. Tucker of Red Lodge and the Rev. C. P. Burnett of Livingston, who also preached the sermon.

The business meeting was called to order, after the service by the president, Mrs. F. J. Mynard of Great Falls. The president appointed as the committee on credentials, the secretary, Mrs. H. S. Gatley and Mrs. G. G. Bennett. The committee reported the following parishes and missions represented and their delegates responded to the roll call:

WOMAN'S PROCEEDINGS.

The annual report of the Secretary was read showing \$15,995.89 raised for parochial purposes and \$2,458.38 for missionary purposes, making a total of \$18,454.37 raised by the women of the Diocese for the year ending May 31, 1913.

The treasurer read her annual report which showed the balance on hand June 1912 to be \$104.25 and the receipts for the year \$1239.52. The amount paid out was \$832.75 leaving a balance on hand of \$511.

The president called for the report of the committee appointed to ask the Board of Missions to send Miss Lindley to the convention of the diocese to conduct mission study classes. The committee reported that the Board had consented to send Miss Lindley, and the officers had sent a circular letter to each parish and mission in the diocese, notifying the women that Miss Lindley would be present to conduct such classes. The committee also reported that Miss Lindley had been present at the convention and conducted the mission study classes on Monday and Tuesday, morning and afternoon, to the great pleasure and profit of the delegates.

Mrs. Moore reported for the Alaska box, that fifteen parishes and missions had contributed to it, and that a bale had been sent to Alaska, valued at \$3386.40.

Mrs. Craig reported for the United Offering that there was \$94.48 on hand June 1912, and \$378.42 had been received during the year, making a balance on hand of \$472.90.

A motion was made by Mrs. Moore to add the balance of the contingent fund, \$21.10 to the United Offering. Carried.

Mrs. B. A. Conard of Bozeman, who had been appointed diocesan secretary to increase the subscriptions to the Spirit of Missions, spoke of her work and urged that all new subscriptions be sent through her.

Mrs. Lillian B. Cain, diocesan secretary of the Daughters of the King, reported that there were three chapters in the diocese, one in Great Falls and a senior and junior chapter in Butte, with a total of 46 members.

The president announced that the election of five delegates and five alternates to the Triennial Meeting of the Woman's Auxiliary, to be held in New York in October, would take place in the afternoon. Mrs. Messias moved that the delegates be elected by ballot and that the election be made the order of the day at 1:30 p. m. Carried.

The Bishop then suggested that a committee be appointed to present nominations at the afternoon meeting. It was so ordered and the president appointed Mrs. J. G. Sherman of Billings, Mrs. J. S. B. Clements of Missoula, Miss Nicholson of Big Timber and Mrs. J. W. Heyward of Hamilton.

Noonday prayers for missions were then read by the Rev. Mr. Hirst of Lewistown.

Pledges for diocesan missions were made as follows: Anaconda \$35; Bear Creek \$5; Belt \$10; Big Timber \$10; Billings \$50; Bozeman \$60; Butte, St. John's \$400; Deer Lodge \$15; Dillon \$35; Glendive \$15; Great Falls \$75; Hamilton \$20; Helena \$100; Joliet \$5; Kalispell \$25; Livingston \$35; MacDonald Creek \$5; Madison Valley \$15; Miles City \$5; Missoula \$50; Philipsburg \$12.50; Red Lodge \$20; Townsend \$15; Virginia City \$15; Total \$1032.50.

Mrs. H. G. McIntyre of Helena reported that many boxes for

St. Peter's Hospital, Helena, had been received from parishes and missions in the diocese.

Mrs. Conner spoke on the work of the Little Helpers.

The diocese secretary of the Junior Auxiliary not being present, Miss Lindley spoke on the work, and Mrs. Gatley spoke of the work of the Juniors in Missoula. The Rev. W. A. Atkinson of Detroit also addressed the meeting.

Recess was then taken until 1:30 p. m.

AFTERNOON SESSION.

The meeting was called to order by the president and Hymn 672 was sung.

The committee on nominations of delegates to the Triennial Meeting of the Woman's Auxiliary reported as follows:

The Secretary, on motion of Mrs. Messias, cast one ballot for the names submitted by the committee, for delegates and alternates.

The Secretary then read a letter from Miss Julia C. Emery, the general secretary of the Womans Auxiliary.

The president then read her annual address as follows:

PRESIDENT'S ANNUAL ADDRESS.

While it is a very great privilege and pleasure for me to be with you today as your presiding officer it is with very deep regret which I am sure is also in the hearts of you all that it has seemed wise for Mrs. Hooker to withdraw from active work in this organization. My regret is the deeper because at this time there has been made possible the fulfillment of one of her long cherished plans in the coming to us of an expert in the line of mission study to instruct us in methods and to inspire us to action. She has been a faithful worker and leader for years. We still have her prayers. She is still our counsellor and friend. I heartily endorse the Bishop's suggestion that she be made honorary president of the Woman's Parochial and Missionary Society.

When our hearts are filled with the thought of temporary losses we often forget great blessings still vouchsafed us and I should like this body to rise now as an expression of thankful appreciation of the twenty years continuous loving and faithful service of Mrs. Clinton H. Moore as treasurer of this organization.

I wish to bring before your minds this afternoon the great opportunities which it seems to me are now opening up to the women of the church. In the past years much dependence has been placed upon women for the lifting of many of the heavy financial burdens connected with church life. These burdens we have courageously lifted at a great expense of time, strength and anxiety. Gradually during the past decade things have been changing until now it seems a new era of Christian giving has developed, by bringing a sense of individual responsibility to every member of the church is bringing also a fairer and better way and more in accord with scriptural injunction. The Woman's Auxiliary to the Board of Missions has been urged by the board of missions, and we of Montana by our

bishop, to aid in this great movement. We certainly feel strongly in accord with it and lend our energies willingly in its interest. The problem we must be ready to meet is that of conservation and redirection of the energy so released, lest it run off into secular and unworthy activities.

"When financial responsibility ceases to be our greatest motive for organization, a vision comes to me of more intelligent understanding of the church and its purpose; a greater spirituality shown in closer attention to religious duties and more attention given to the needs of the young and inexperienced in our parishes. I see Sunday schools equipped with more competent teachers. I see more organized branches of the Woman's auxiliary giving themselves gladly to the solving of problems of the missionary cause. I see more chapters of the "Daughters of the King" and a consequent enlarged body of devoted young women praying and working for the extension of the kingdom among young women.

I see in our larger cities branches of the Girls' Friendly Society caring for the social and religious needs of the working girls in our midst. I hope to see such provisions for the social needs of our young people as will furnish wholesome recreation and entertainment under the auspices of the church and help them to form their closest friendships and relations within the bounds of our own household.

In closing let me express to you the satisfaction your officers feel at the response to their appeal for full attendance at this convention and active cooperation in the work Miss Lindley came so far to give us.

We have had a larger attendance than ever before and we have all certainly been repaid for any effort which has been made by us.

It was moved and seconded that a rising vote of thanks be given to Mrs. Clinton H. Moore in recognition of twenty years of faithful service as treasurer of the Woman's Auxiliary of the diocese. Carried.

It was moved and seconded that Mrs. S. D. Hooker be made honorary president of the diocesan branch. Carried.

Miss Grace Lindley then gave an hour of Bible study on the Gospel according to St. Matthew which was most interesting and instructive.

Hymn 485 was then sung after which Mrs. W. A. Atkinson of Detroit gave an interesting address on Missions in the Sunday school.

The president then called on the Rev. William S. Watson of Dillon to address the meeting and he responded with an inspiring talk.

The following resolution was offered by Mrs. W. W. Conner: Resolved, That the members of the Woman's Parochial and Missionary Society of the diocese of Montana extend their hearty thanks to Mr. and Mrs. Anshutz, the ladies of the guilds and all members of this parish for their kind hospitality and entertainment so generously offered. Carried.

The following resolution was also offered by Mrs. W. W. Conner: Resolved, that a rising vote of thanks be expressed to the Board of Missions for sending Miss Lindley to this annual meeting, and also to Miss Lindley for the splendid inspiration she has been to us all during the meetings of this convention, and that we further thank her for the personal sacrifice she has made in coming so far to encourage us in missionary work and missionary study. Carried.

It was moved by Miss Withers that the proceedings of this an-

nual meeting be printed in the Journal, and that five hundred copies be sent the secretary for distribution among the different parishes and missions. Carried.

The minutes of the meeting were then read and approved, and the meeting closed with the singing of the doxology.
