Secretary's Report.

TRINITY CATHEDRAL, OMAHA,

May 17, 1898.

During the past year there have been held two meetings of the Diocesan Branch of the Woman's Auxiliary; one, an afternoon meeting on the first of December, when in the absence of our President, Mrs. Welsh of All Saints' Church served as President *pro tem*. A special pledge of \$25.00, for missions among the colored people, was made in response to an appeal from Florida. At the second meeting, held on the 15th day of February, there were present about one hundred ladies. Among the reports, \$237.68 was reported in the United Offering fund, which Mrs. Worthington asked to have greatly increased by next September. She also reminded us of our pledge towards Miss Crummer's salary. Late letters from Miss Crummer state that she will stay two years longer in China than she intended when she went out to work, so it will be nearly three years yet before she returns home.

Very incomplete reports were made concerning boxes, though the yearly reports just received show about the usual number sent.

Mrs. Worthington read a most interesting account of her foreign trip and the Lambeth Conference, and it was voted to have it published, but after considering the matter, Mrs. Worthington declined to allow it.

The next day, February 16th, was observed as a "Quiet Day," and the services were conducted by Bishop Dudley of Kentucky. Luncheon was served on each of these two days by the Cathedral ladies, assisted by ladies from St. John's on the first day, and from St. Andrew's, St. Paul's and St. Augustine's on the second.

One branch held interesting and instructive meetings during Lent, laying aside the box work and spending the time upon the study of Missions. Six topics were studied and discussed at the meetings, during the six weeks of Lent: Missions, Diocesan, Domestic and Foreign, in Alaska and among the Indians and Colored people. This was done hoping to increase the number of women interested in missions, for out of our 3,000 women communicants, we have only about four hundred Auxiliary members. What can we do to increase our membership? We are too apt to do all for ourselves, forgetting that there are so many that are much more needy.

In the fifty-three Parishes and Missions in Nebraska we have about twenty-seven active branches of the Auxiliary, including the Juniors, one of which is a new branch, and, including Juniors, we have 500 members.

Besides the amounts given in cash to different objects as reported by the Treasurer, the branch has sent out boxes as found in "Box Report."

Among the small branches where they have perhaps only five dollars to spend on material, very acceptable boxes can be prepared for our own Clarkson Hospital.

If any branches can make up boxes of second-hand clothing, there are missions among the Colored people in the South that would gladly receive them. A very nice work for girls' Juniors is dressing dolls for the Christmas festivals.

Lists of boxes can be procured at any time by writing to the Secretary, though enough time should be allowed to get letters from Miss Emery in New York, where the list is kept.

Woman's Auxiliary to the Board of Missions.

To Branches Undertaking the Preparation of Missionary Boxes.

1. Please decide upon the Missionary letters enclosed, and return, as soon as possible, those you do not wish to keep to the person from whom you receive them.

2. Please write *at once* to the Missionary to whom you have decided to send your box, and tell him that you have undertaken it, how complete you think it likely to be, and how soon you hope to have it ready.

To comply with these requests will very much oblige the Missionary, your own Diocesan Officers, and the Secretary of the Auxiliary.

N. B.—The names of Missionaries to whom boxes are sent should never be printed in reports, parish papers, or elsewhere.

The names of Missionaries should be omitted when their letters are read at the meetings of the Auxiliary.

If any clothing that has been worn is offered for a box, write to the Missionary for whom the box is being prepared, and ask if he would like to receive it for distribution in his parish, or for other purposes. Second-hand clothing for the personal use of a clergyman should never be substituted for new. If in excellent condition it may sometimes be sent in addition to new clothing, but its disposition should always be left to the discretion of the Missionary.

It seems unnecessary to add that no article of any kind should be put into a Missionary box that is not *absolutely whole and clean*.

In sending to the families of Missionaries it is desirable to pack in boxes rather than in barrels.
