Report of Secretary.

RIGHT REV. FATHER,
MADAME PRESIDENT:

In presenting the 18th Annual Report of the Nebraska Branch of the Woman's Auxiliary to the Board of Missions, we record with pleasure a most successful year's work.

Two quarterly meetings were held outside of Omaha. One in Lincoln on the thirteenth of last October. Thirty-one delegates were present, some splendid addresses of a missionary character were made by several of our clergy and the Rector Rev. Francis Easson and the ladies of the Holy Trinity Parish did all in their power to provide for the comfort and entertainment of their guests.

The second meeting was held in Blair, Feb. 3rd and 4th. Despite the inclemency of the weather an unusually large delegation was in attendance, and enjoyed the abounding hospitality of the ladies of St. Mary's Parish. Several excellent papers were read, the delightful talks given by the late Rev. Colin Tate will long be pleasantly remembered.

The branches of Omaha and South Omaha have united once a month to discuss missionary work at home and abroad. Much earnest work has been accomplished at these meetings. The papers have shown considerable thought and research and have added materially to the missionary knowledge of those in attendance. These meetings have been in charge of Miss Fannie Cole, who gives promise of becoming an able factor in Auxiliary work.

A quiet day for the women of this Diocese was held in the Cathedral, Febr. 12th. Services most helpful in their nature were conducted by the Rt. Rev. R. H. Weller, Bishop Co-adjutor of Fon-du-Lac. Those who could accept the invitation felt deeply grateful for the opportunity to listen to one blessed

in such a marked degree with the power of imparting a quickening inspiration.

We wish at this time to express our thanks to the secretaries of the different branches for sending in their reports so promptly.

From them we report the following: Parishes or Missions in the Diocese that have sent boxes or parts of boxes, 20.

Boxes sent to Missionaries' schools and hospitals outside the Diocese, seven. Value \$479.17.

Boxes sent to missionaries within the Diocese, one. Value \$54 85.

Boxes sent to missions and hospitals within the Diocese, fifteen.

Box to Club House House, Lincoln, value \$4.50.

Box to South Omaha Hospital, value \$25.20.

Boxes to Clarkson Hospital, 13. Value \$183.68.

Several branches have worked through the supply box which for the past year has been in charge of Mrs. John Williams.

Although we may feel that much has been accomplished during the past year, we are forced to admit that the work has not grown in proportion to the material prosperity with which we have been blessed. However we shall have fresh incentives for renewed effort during the coming year which will be one fraught with especial interest to auxiliary women everywhere. This is triennial year, the meeting will be held in Boston, early in October. We hope many women are planning to attend that they may return with fresh enthusiasm to carry forward the work in our own state.

In January a great missionary conference will be held in this city. This meeting we feel sure will do much to awaken the interest of many who are now giving but a half hearted support to the great cause in which they are neglecting their glorious opportunity for service.

Constitution.

ARTICLE I.

This society shall be called the NEBRASKA BRANCH OF THE WOMEN'S AUXILIARY TO THE BOARD OF MISSIONS.

ARTICLE II.

The object of this society is fourfold: 1st. To diffuse missionary intelligence. 2nd. To increase missionary activity among the women of this diocese. 3rd. To unite previously existing societies in a common interest. 4th. To encourage the formation of new societies for missionary work.

ARTICLE III.

All baptized women of the church in the diocese of Nebraska shall be considered members of this association.

ARTICLE IV.

The officers of this society shall be a President and four Vice-Presidents, a Secretary and a Treasurer. These officers shall be chosen by ballot at the annual meeting. In case of a vacancy in any office, the same may be filled by appointment of the Bishop, and any person so appointed shall continue in office until the next annual meeting.

ARTICLE V.

It shall be the duty of the President to preside at all meetings of the association, to call special meetings of the same, and to countersign all drafts on the Treasurer.

ARTICLE VI.

It shall be the duty of the Vice-Presidents to preside in their several districts in the absence of the

President, and it shall be the duty of the three rural Vice-Presidents to superintend the work of the Auxiliary in their respective districts.

ARTICLE VII.

The Secretary shall give notice of all meetings and conduct the correspondence of the society with missionaries, with the secretaries of the associated branches, and with the general secretary of the Woman's Auxiliary in New York. She shall keep a record of all meetings, prepare and keep a list of the names of all associated branches with their officers, and shall report the same once a year to the Bishop of the diocese and the general secretary in New York.

ARTICLE VIII.

It shall be the duty of the Treasurer to receive and keep account of all moneys contributed to the work of the association, to pay all drafts on the funds when countersigned by the President and present an annual report of the same.

ARTICLE IX.

An annual meeting of this association shall be held at the time and place of the Diocesan Council. Quarterly meetings shall be held at such time and place as the president shall direct. The officers or their proxies, of each associated branch, shall constitute a delegation to the general meetings of the association.

ARTICLE X.

Any parish society becomes a branch of the diocesan auxiliary by paying annually one dollar, which together with the offertories at the general meetings, shall constitute a contingent fund for defraying the necessary expenses of the diocesan branch.
