**Secretary's Report**  
**For the Year Ending May, 1907**

---

The number of Parishes in the Diocese having a Woman's Auxiliary, thirty-one.

Number having Junior Branches, eleven.

Number having Babies' Branches, eight.

During the year one new Auxiliary was formed, at Hartington.

Quarterly meetings were held at Plattsmouth, in November, and at Nebraska City in February. At these meetings papers were prepared by Mrs. James Wise, Mrs. John Williams, Miss Royce, Mrs. Cole, and Rev. G. L. Neide of Falls City, besides informal talks from Bishop Williams, Rev. Messrs. Moor, Collar, Bean, Palmer and Chandler.

Boxes to the value of \$306 have been sent by the Woman's Auxiliary to missionaries, schools and hospitals outside the diocese, and one in the diocese valued at \$60.

Boxes to the value of \$189.60 have been sent to Clarkson Hospital.

The Juniors contributed \$11.50 in toys to the school at St. Simon's Mills, Georgia; \$14.50 to the Child's Saving Institute, and boxes to the amount of \$19 to the Clarkson Hospital.

Of the blanks sent out, Fremont was the first to send in a report, with Schuyler a very close second, while of the Omaha Auxiliaries the first to respond was St. Paul's.

Fifty-one letters have been written by the Secretary, two hundred and forty cards averaging sixty words each, and seventy-five reports were sent out.

## Constitution.

### ARTICLE I.

This society shall be called the NEBRASKA BRANCH OF THE WOMEN'S AUXILIARY to the BOARD OF MISSIONS.

### ARTICLE II.

The object of this society is fourfold: 1st. To diffuse missionary intelligence. 2d. To increase missionary activity among the women of this diocese. 3d. To unite previously existing societies in a common interest. 4th. To encourage the formation of new societies for missionary work.

### ARTICLE III.

All baptized women of the church in the diocese of Nebraska shall be considered members of this association.

### ARTICLE IV.

The officers of this society shall be a President and four Vice-Presidents, a Secretary, a Treasurer, two Diocesan Visitors, a Directress of the Junior Auxiliary, a Secretary of the Junior Auxiliary, a Treasurer of the United Offering, a Custodian of the Diocesan Box, a Diocesan Librarian, a Correspondent of the Church Periodical Club and a Secretary of the Babies' Branch. These officers shall be chosen by ballot at the annual meeting. In case of a vacancy in any office, the same may be filled by appointment of the Bishop, and any person so appointed shall continue in office until the next annual meeting.

### ARTICLE V.

It shall be the duty of the President to preside at all meetings of the association, to call special meetings of the same, and to countersign all drafts on the Treasurer.



#### ARTICLE VI.

It shall be the duty of the Vice-President to preside in their several districts in the absence of the President, and it shall be the duty of the three rural Vice-Presidents to superintend the work of the Auxiliary in their respective districts.

#### ARTICLE VII.

The Secretary shall give notice of all meetings and conduct the correspondence of the society with missionaries, with the secretaries of the associated branches, and with the general secretary of the Woman's Auxiliary in New York. She shall keep a record of all meetings, prepare and keep a list of the names of all associated branches with their officers, and shall report the same once a year to the Bishop of the diocese and the general secretary in New York.

#### ARTICLE VIII.

It shall be the duty of the Treasurer to receive and keep account of all moneys contributed to the work of the association, to pay all drafts on the funds when countersigned by the President and present an annual report of the same.

#### ARTICLE IX.

An annual meeting of this association shall be held at the time and place of the Diocesan Council, Quarterly meetings shall be held at such time and place as the president shall direct. The officers or their proxies, of each associated branch, shall constitute a delegation to the general meetings of the association.

#### ARTICLE X.

Any parish society becomes a branch of the diocesan auxiliary by paying annually one dollar, which, together with the offertories at the general meetings, shall constitute a contingent fund for defraying the necessary expenses of the diocesan branch.
