Secretary's Report

For the Year Ending May 14, 1912.



Number of Parishes in the Diocese having a Woman's Auxiliary, twenty-nine.

Number having Junior Branches, fourteen.

Number having Babies' Branches or "Little Helpers," nine.

Total membership of Woman's Auxiliary as given in the reports, 531.

Total Junior membership, 222.

The semi-annual meeting was held at Nebraska City, November 14, 1911. The speakers were the Rev. W. H. Moor in the morning and the Bishop and the Rev. S. Mills Hayes in the afternoon. One beloved member has died, Miss Emma Morton, President of the Nebraska City Branch.

The Diocesan Supply Box was valued at \$176.60. Trinity Cathedral's box to the Rev. Paul Williams at Nenana, Alaska, was \$150.00; a Christmas box to Diocese of Nebraska, \$10.00; one to Valle Crucis, N. C., \$50.00; one to Morganton, N. C., \$10.00. All Saints sent one to Idaho valued at \$85.00, St. Paul's one to Kentucky, \$50.00, and one to Diocese of Kearney, \$25.00. St. Andrew's sent one to Michigan worth \$12.00, St. Barnabas, one to Idaho at \$35.00. Holy Trinity, Lincoln, furnished one to Tennessee worth \$45.00 and one to Idaho at \$32.00. St. James, Fremont, to Kentucky mountaineers, box worth \$25.00. The Church of the Ascension, Auburn, one to Corbin, Kentucky, valued at \$17.00, and one to Clarkson Hospital at \$49.75. St. Luke's, Plattsmouth, to Virginia, \$23.17, making a total value of boxes, including the Diocesan box, \$795.47.

Of the reports sent out the middle of April, Schuyler was the first to respond and St. Andrew's the first among the Omaha branches.

Meetings of the Omaha, South Omaha and Florence branches have been held the last Friday in each month, with the exception of December, in the different churches in the following order: St. Mark's, Florence; St. Matthias', St. Philip's, St. Barnabas and St. Paul's. The January meeting was held in the Lecture Room of the

Public Library, where a stereopticon lecture on Mexico was given.

These auxiliaries completed the study work on Mexico and have adopted Japan as the subject for the coming year. The offerings at these meetings, amounting to \$33.78, were used for the expense fund of the Woman's Auxiliary of the Diocese, with the exception of that of the business meeting in April, when half of the offering was given the Diocesan Librarian, as usual.

Ninety-five reports, one hundred and twelve cards have been sent out and twenty-one notices given to the newspapers.

Report of the Junior Auxiliary



For the year 1911-12 the Junior Auxiliary of Nebraska reports fourteen branches, a membership of 222. The offerings for all purposes aggregate \$534.50 and the pledges for next year \$131.50.

A very promising branch at St. John's, Omaha, was discontinued during the past year because the mission was disbanded. St. Philip the Deacon has organized a Junior Auxiliary. Holy Trinity, Lincoln, has reorganized after an interval of some months. One rector of the Diocese, after several years' effort to establish a branch in the usual manner, has solved his problem by calling his Sunday School a Junior Auxiliary.

Last Christmas the Juniors of Omaha and South Omaha sent to the Sunday Schools of the Sand Hills region in Western Nebraska a box valued at \$138.25, exclusive of freight. Mrs. Geo. Ware wrote a most appreciative letter of thanks for these gifts.

Beside this Christmas box, the Juniors have sewed for Clarkson Hospital and worked in many ways to raise money for their pledges and for parish aid.

It is encouraging to report greater interest in mission study. The Junior leaders have held their usual monthly meetings this year, and to the business and social features have added a missionary program. They studied the course "From Jerusalem to Juneau," outlined by the Board of Missions. Several parish branches have regular missionary instruction. The talk given last fall by Rev. Mr. Hoare of Point Hope, Alaska, was a great inspiration to the Juniors.

By invitation of Miss Johnson, principal of Brownell Hall, the Junior Auxiliary held its annual all-day meeting this year at the Hall, on Saturday, May 4. About 160 were present, including the Bishop and several of the clergy who have always shown such kind interest in the work.

To them and to all friends the Junior Auxiliary extends sincere thanks and bespeaks their prayers for future blessings.

Constitution



ARTICLE I.

This society shall be called the NEBRASKA BRANCH OF THE WOMAN'S AUXILIARY to the BOARD OF MISSIONS.

ARTICLE II.

The object of this society is four-fold: 1st. To diffuse missionary intelligence. 2d. To increase missionary activity among the women of this diocese. 3d. To unite previously existing societies in a common interest. 4th. To encourage the formation of new societies for missionary work.

ARTICLE III.

All baptized women of the church in the diocese of Nebraska shall be considered members of this association.

ARTICLE IV.

The officers of this society shall be a President and four District Vice-Presidents, a Secretary, a Treasurer, two Vice-Presidents in charge of Organization and Visiting, a Vice-President in charge of the Junior Auxiliary, a Secretary of the Junior Auxiliary, a Vice-President in charge of the United Offering, a Vice-President in charge of the Diocesan Box, a Vice-President in charge of the Diocesan Library, and a Vice-President in charge of the Babies' Branch. These officers shall be chosen by ballot at the annual meeting. In case of a vacancy in any office, the same may be filled by appointment of the Bishop, and any person so appointed shall continue in office until the next annual meeting.

ARTICLE V.

It shall be the duty of the President to preside at all meetings of the association, to call special meetings of the same, and to countersign all drafts on the Treasurer.

ARTICLE VI.

It shall be the duty of the Vice-Presidents to preside in the absence of the President, and to superintend the work of the Auxiliary in their respective districts.

ARTICLE VII.

The Secretary shall give notice of all meetings and conduct the correspondence of the society with missionaries, with the secretaries of the associated branches, and with the general secretary of the Woman's Auxiliary in New York. She shall keep a record of all meetings, prepare and keep a list of the names of all associated branches with their officers, and shall report the same once a year to the Bishop of the Diocese and the general secretary in New York.

ARTICLE VIII.

It shall be the duty of the Treasurer to receive and keep account of all moneys contributed to the work of the association, to pay all drafts on the funds when countersigned by the President, and present an annual report of the same.

ARTICLE IX.

An annual meeting of the association shall be held at the time and place of the Diocese Council. A semi-annual meeting shall be held at such time and place as the President shall direct. Three officers, or their proxies, of each associated branch, shall constitute a delegation to the general meetings of the association, and shall be entitled to a vote.

ARTICLE X.

Any parish society becomes a branch of the Diocesan Auxiliary by paying annually one dollar, which, together with the offertories at the general meetings, shall constitute a contingent fund for defraying the necessary expenses of the Diocesan branch.
