

The following Resolution was passed at the Annual Meeting, April 26, 1912:

"Resolved, That inasmuch as the Board of Missions has decided to include Mexico in the Foreign Work, the separate committee for Mexican Work in this diocese be abolished, and the Mexican Work be put in charge of the Chairman of the Foreign Committee."

The following Resolution was passed at the Annual Meeting April 29, 1908.

"Resolved, That the several departments of the work shall hereafter be cared for by committees, each of which shall consist of a Chairman and Vice-Chairman, who shall be members of the Board and who shall have power to associate others with them as the interests of the work may demand."

In accordance with the power given them, the members of the Foreign Committee have requested Mrs. Abbey to become an Associate Member of their committee to take charge of the Mexican branch of the Foreign work. All correspondence pertaining to Mexico, or contributions for that work, should be addressed as heretofore to Mrs. Abbey.

SECRETARY'S REPORT

The Thirty-seventh Annual Meeting of the New Jersey Branch of the Woman's Auxiliary to the Board of Missions was held in All Saints' Church, Trenton, Wednesday, April 24th, 1912.

At 10:30 there was a Celebration of the Holy Communion by the Bishop, assisted by the Rev. Mr. Urban, Rector of All Saints' Church; Archdeacon Shepherd and the Rev. Dudley Tying of China, who made a very interesting address on the conditions and opportunities of New China.

The Bishop reviewed the work done during the past year within the diocese and outside and on every hand the harvest seemed abundant.

The Rev. Mr. Urban welcomed the Auxiliary to All Saints' Parish and extended a cordial invitation to all present to luncheon.

At 12:30 the business meeting was organized, the President presiding.

The roll-call showed thirty-eight parishes represented by 160 delegates.

The Minutes of the previous Annual Meeting, also those of the several Executive Meetings held during the year, were read and after minor corrections were accepted. The Treasurer's report was read and approved.

Tellers were appointed by the chair to collect and count the ballots and report at the opening of the Afternoon Session.

Mrs. Ole, of Colorado, who was present, was introduced by the President and extended to the meeting the greetings of her Western Branch.

The meeting then adjourned for luncheon.

At the opening of the Afternoon Session the report of the tellers was handed in. The ticket, as presented by the Nominating Committee, was unanimously elected.

The President gave notice of the approaching Missionary Commission and asked that delegates be appointed to represent the New Jersey Branch. The meeting appointed Mrs. Phelps and Mrs. Shepherd.

The Secretary then read the Amendment to the Constitution passed by the Executive Board regarding the changed condition of the work in Mexico. Before putting the question to vote, Mrs. Abbey explained the matter fully to the delegates. In accordance with the policy of the Board and a subsequent resolution passed by the Executive Committee, it was resolved to abandon the Mexican Committee and place the work under the Foreign Committee. Carried.

Owing to these changed conditions and a consequent increase of interest in the Mexican work, it was decided to re-establish the Bowne Scholarship, given up last year for lack of sufficient funds to meet all pledges.

A very encouraging report was made by the Church Extension Committee through Mrs. Stevenson, Chairman.

Mrs. Abbey reported for the Intercessary Committee and asked that the parishes would interest themselves in increasing the membership of the Prayer League.

The Educational Committee reported, through Mrs. Shepherd, two new leaders acquired for the work this year, study classes increasing, students multiplying and results most satisfactory.

Mrs. Teickert reported a very successful season for the Church Periodical Club.

The Junior Auxiliary reported progress both in an increased number of branches and in amounts of gifts, which totaled \$1,122.00 not included in the above figures.

The Babies' Branch, which suffered a severe loss in being without any Chairman for several months, reported \$87.42, being only about \$4.00 less than last year, which gives promise of much better things this year.

The Treasurer of the United Offering reported \$1,800 on hand and the three years just half gone.

ANNUAL REPORT JUNIOR AUXILIARY

Since my report of last year six new Branches have been reported, namely: Haddon Heights, Lambertville; St. James, Atlantic City; Haddonfield; St. Barnabas, Burlington, and a Young Woman's Branch at St. Paul's, Camden.

At an Executive Meeting of the officers, held in Trenton last Fall, it was decided to have the usual neighborhood meetings during the year. The first of these was held at Elizabeth, in Trinity Church, January 20th. After a few general remarks on junior work by Miss Wood and your Chairman, Mrs. Monroe gave a most interesting talk to the children on the Oneida Indians.

At Trinity Church, Trenton, February 11th, a large attendance greeted the officers. Miss Claire Widdefield, of Philadelphia, was the speaker of the afternoon, her subject being "Junior Work."

The third meeting was held at Shrewsbury on Saturday, April 27th in Christ Church. There was an unusually large attendance. The devotional services were in charge of Rev. Mr. Swezey. The chief speaker of the afternoon, however, was Mr. Stroup, who told of the mountaineers in the South, of their homes and life. He was a pupil of Christ School, Arden, of whose history and struggles he told.

The officers feel greatly indebted to Mrs. Monroe for her valuable services throughout the year and take this means of expressing their grateful thanks to her.

The last meeting will be held in Camden on May 25th, and will be reported in next year's report.

These meetings have been well attended this year and many Branches report that they find them helpful and inspiring. Moreover they make the Juniors realize the part each branch bears toward the whole organization.

A three days' Institute for Junior leaders was held in Lakewood in November. This was in charge of Miss Schwartz and was well attended.

At the request of Mrs. Phelps, a new officer has been added to the Juniors, this being Miss Cornelia Schwartz, of Lakewood, as Educational Secretary.

The educational movement of the present time is a very important one, for the Church must have at her command both intelligence and knowledge, combined with spiritual and religious zeal, to make her ideal and we hope for many good results from this new appointment.

The Educational Secretary is the result of a resolution presented at the Cincinnati Conference for the purpose of a united

effort to form Junior Branches of older girls and young women.

Miss Wood reports a successful year financially, although twelve Branches have not been heard from as yet.

Miss Curtis, Box Director, reports the following: Total value of boxes for the year, \$788.97. This gives us an amount of \$273.97 above last year's value. She also reports that thirty-three boxes were sent to various stations. This is a gain of three over last year.

Miss Kelly, Study Mission Librarian, writes that new literature has been added to her library during the year, for which she has many demands.

REPORT OF THE MISSION STUDY DEPARTMENT

During the past year this department has been more fully organized under the Chairman by the appointment of two leaders, Mrs. Feickert, for the Upper Division, and Mrs. Pilsbry, for the Lower Division.

The Winter's Study Classes, with the exception of a Parish Class at St. Paul's Church, Westfield, on "The Why and How of Foreign Missions," conducted by Mrs. Feickert, have been devoted to the study of "The Conquest of the Continent," the course particularly desired by the Educational Department of the Board of Missions.

Normal classes have been held at Elizabeth, composed of women from Trinity and St. John's Churches, and at St. Luke's, Metuchen, both conducted by Mrs. Feickert. At the Diocesan House in Trenton (where representatives of ten neighboring parishes gathered weekly for eight weeks) and at St. Paul's, Camden, Mrs. Pilsbry conducted Normal Classes.

Parish Classes have been held as follows: By Mrs. Feickert, at Christ Church and St. John's Church, Elizabeth; by Mrs. Joyce, at Christ Church, New Brunswick; by Miss F. M. Roberts, at Trinity Church, Trenton; by Mrs. Jennings, at Christ Church, Shrewsbury; by Mrs. Phelps, at St. Paul's, Bound Brook, and Holy Innocents, Dunellen; by Mrs. Pilsbry, at Christ Church, Riverton; by Mrs. Crowel, at Christ Church, Riverton; by Mrs. McKay, at Trinity Church, Moorestown; by Mrs. Stevenson, at Grace Church, Haddonfield, and an attempted class at Christ Church, Palmyra, by Mrs. Keen.

In connection with the Missionary Institute held in Elizabeth during Passion Week, Miss Lindley, of New York, gave three mission study instructions for normal leaders, using the "Why and How of Foreign Missions" as a basis.

Your Chairman gave six talks during Lent on the work and purposes of the Woman's Auxiliary at Christ Church, Trenton.

A program meeting was held at Grace Church, Plainfield, and there has no doubt been a number of other meetings held in various parts of the Diocese of a missionary character, of which your Chairman has not been notified.

This report shows great gain in the number of Mission Study Classes, especially in the Upper Division. We estimate that at least one hundred women have attended these classes.

The Educational Department of the Board of Missions announces that the course next year will be upon Japan, and that the text book will be ready in June, so that leaders can prepare themselves during the Summer for their Fall and Winter work.

This department also desired that each Diocese should have a distributing centre, from which all mission study and mission literature could be sent forth. The removal of your Chairman to Trenton made this possible, and the offer of a room in the Diocesan House for the Missionary Lending Library provided for an office. Over \$50 worth of text books and other publications have been sold from this office.

Your Chairman wishes to say that this venture can only be made really efficient when all the Parish Branches act upon this suggestion of the Educational Department in New York.

If they buy their books and literature elsewhere they just to that extent reduce the practical efficiency of this work.

Several new books, notably the Life of Bishop Hare, The Indian Problem and An Officer of the Line, have been added to the Library. All the books in the Library bearing upon the course studied have been in constant circulation among the various classes. These books, or any others in the Library, can be had for the asking, the only expense being the expressage both ways.

Your Chairman asks your hearty co-operation in this important educational work, which she feels is better equipped than ever before to help the Parochial Branches, owing to its greater centralization.
