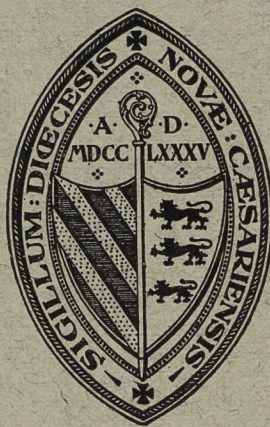

SECRETARY'S REPORT

The Thirty-eighth Annual Meeting of the New Jersey Branch of the Woman's Auxiliary to the Board of Missions was held in Trinity Church, Trenton, Wednesday, April 30, 1913.

In the opening service and in the Celebration of the Holy Communion the Bishop was assisted by Bishop Lloyd, the Ven-Archdeacon Shepherd, and the Rev. Mr. Schuyler, rector of Trinity Church.

Bishop Lloyd made a most spiritual and uplifting address, in which he reminded the women that they were not working as individuals; they were as branches of a tree, Christ Himself being the tree, and urged all present to bear in mind that they were co-workers with Christ.

Bishop Scarborough gave some very encouraging figures of the work done for Missions outside of the diocese during the past year, and the Archdeacon followed with good reports of missionary conditions in the diocese, thanking the women of the Auxiliary for their help in his work.

At 12.15 the business meeting was organized, with the President in the chair. The roll call showed 172 delegates present, representing 41 parishes.

The minutes of the previous Annual Meeting were read and accepted, followed by the Treasurer's report, which was approved. With the consent of the meeting, the minutes of the several Executive Meetings held during the year were omitted.

The President's Address gave a summary of the year's work, and sounded a note of hope for greater things to be accomplished in the coming year.

Tellers were appointed to collect and count the ballots and report at the afternoon session.

Mrs. Abbey reported for the Intercession Committee, conditions had improved; meetings were better attended; more interest was manifested, and the offerings larger than ever before.

Greatly to the regret of the meeting, Mrs. Abbey, who has for many years been an ardent worker in the Auxiliary, tendered her resignation on account of removal from the diocese.

Mrs. Stevenson reported encouraging results of the work of the Visiting Committee in the Lower Division, and Mrs. Monroe for the Upper Division. This Committee was organized for the twofold purpose of a better acquaintance between the Diocesan Officers and Members of the Parish Branches, and the discussion of the methods and work of the Woman's Auxiliary. Also to introduce the Twenty Questions,—an abbreviated catechism on Missions, into every Parish, hoping an increased knowledge and understanding of the work would stimulate interest in it.

The Rev. Mr. Schuyler, who, on behalf of himself and Trinity Church, gave the Auxiliary a most cordial welcome, invited the

delegates to luncheon, and the meeting was adjourned until 2.00 o'clock.

On reassembling for the afternoon session, the first business before the meeting was the Amendments to the Constitution and arrangement of By-laws prepared by the Committee appointed by the Executive Board for that purpose.

The Amendments were passed separately, then the revised Constitution as a whole was adopted. The By-laws were approved.

The report of the tellers was received, and the ticket as presented by the Nominating Committee was unanimously elected.

Mrs. Fitch, in behalf of the Babies' Branch, made a very encouraging report. The collections for the year were \$114.87.

The Junior Auxiliary report showed an increase in numbers; seven new branches organized during the year; their apportionment and all pledges paid.

A letter from Mr. Betticher, of Alaska, asking for scholarships in his Indian School, which was read by Mrs. Monroe, elicited a quick response, and pledges amounting to \$100.00 for one scholarship were made.

Mrs. Carpender reported good progress for the United Offering, there being over \$4,000.00 on hand already. Mrs. Carpender urged the women to make every effort during the next five months, that this amount might be at least \$5,000.00 when presented at our next Triennial Meeting.

Very satisfactory reports were made by Mrs. Shepherd on Mission Study classes; Mrs. Feickert, representing the Church Periodical Club, and the Spirit of Missions, and Mrs. Abbey on the present needs and condition of Mexico.

On a motion of Mrs. Feickert, it was resolved that the matter of appointing delegates to the Triennial Meeting be left to the Executive Board.

ANNUAL REPORT, JUNIOR AUXILIARY

During the past year we have been once more deprived of a leader. In January, Mrs. Weaver, who had been Chairman of the Junior Auxiliary for the past three years, resigned on account of ill health. During her Chairmanship, Mrs. Weaver endeared herself to all, and under the guidance and inspiration of her lovely Christian character, all Junior work greatly advanced. The officers and leaders feel the need of her guiding hand, and are striving to hold the work to the same high standard of the past three years.

We can report 48 branches of Junior workers, four of which are composed of boys. Seven new branches have been formed this year, two of these being Boys' Branches. We feel that slowly but surely, the boys are being gathered in.

We earnestly commend this phase of the work to all parishes—the forming of a Boys' Auxiliary to the Board of Missions. The men of the future must be trained for the Mission work of the Church.

The Institute held in Asbury Park last fall was a great help to the Junior leaders attending.

During January a neighborhood meeting was held in Metuchen, and although the day proved stormy, the attendance was large. After a devotional service led by the rector, Miss Wood, the Diocesan Secretary for the Juniors, gave a very interesting talk on Junior work.

Miss Schwartz has conducted a Correspondence Course in Mission Study which has proved successful. All branches report that some study of Missions has been done during the year, Japan being the main subject, many using "The Honorable Little Miss Love" as their text-book.

The United Christmas Boxes were sent off in good season for the Christmas festivities. Miss Curtis, Director of Box work, reports 38 boxes sent to the various stations in the South to the Mountaineers, the Indians in the West, and to far-off Alaska.

Miss Wood reports all pledges nearly, if not quite, paid in full; we have also made our apportionment, always a subject for rejoicing.

May 10th a neighborhood meeting was held at St. Paul's, Camden. This was the largest meeting ever held in the Lower Division, many parishes were represented.

A Missionary from Cuba addressed the Juniors.

Two meetings were held for the Shore parishes, one at South Amboy, June 7th; the other at Sea Girt, June 15th.

Both meetings reported good attendance.

We feel that these neighborhood meetings are a great means of creating enthusiasm, and of binding the Junior forces together to work for the great cause of Missions.

Thanking all the leaders for their loyal support and co-operation during the year that is past, we urge them to greater deeds in the future, striving to their utmost to send the Glad Tidings to all the world.

REPORT OF THE MISSION STUDY DEPARTMENT.

The past year has been the most productive of results in both the study of Missions and the distribution of Mission Literature.

Early in April, your Educational Secretary sent out to seventy Auxiliaries, a carefully prepared card asking for definite information in regard to the winter's work in each branch, so far as the dissemination of missionary information was concerned; either by Study Classes, special addresses, and distribution of literature.

She has received thirty-six answers, from which she makes the following summary:

These, with two exceptions, all were on the text-book of the year, "Japan Advancing—Whither?"

The two were on "The Conquest of the Continent," last year's book.

Twenty Parishes report missionary addresses or talks, to the number of forty (40). Twelve individuals have attended Summer Schools or Conferences.

In addition, the Educational Secretary has given fourteen talks in these Parishes on the Twenty Questions, and the Organization and Working of the Woman's Auxiliary.

We have two Normal leaders, and the reports show twelve Parish leaders. Only eight of the thirty-six reporting say that nothing in this line has been attempted. This shows a very great increase of interest over other years.

Several of the Mission Study Classes have sent money to some specific object at the close of the course. Amount reported \$52.00.

The number of books sold from the distributing centre (the Diocesan House) has more than doubled. Last year we reported fifty dollars' worth. This year, \$130.00—three hundred and fifty books in all, the text-books, "Japan Advancing" and "Little Miss Love," making up 245 of these. The books on the course also make quite a large list.

This only shows what can be done by co-operation. The Educational Secretary thanks the Branches for thus aiding her in her special work, and she would suggest the appointment in every Parish, of an Educational Secretary, to be the medium between her and the Parish in the dissemination of Literature and the advancement of the Mission Study idea.

The Lending Library has been used, but inasmuch as the books for the Course were supplied in a special library very cheaply, which it was well for every Parish having a Mission Study course to own, the number of books loaned was necessarily smaller.

Several new books have been added: "Points of Contact," DuBois; "The Art of Story Telling," St. John; "The Island Empire of Japan," Robinson; "Missions, Rise and Development," Mrs. Creighton; "Missionary Methods," Roland Allen.

These and many others may be had for the asking, and the payment of expressage both ways.

The new book for Mission Study next year on China will be ready in June with the accompanying literature. Orders will be gladly received at any time, and the books delivered as soon as published.

Your prayers and your interest are asked again in behalf of this most important work of giving systematic information to the women of the Church.

NEW JERSEY BRANCH OF THE WOMAN'S AUXILIARY

Diocesan Constitution.

ARTICLE I.—*Name.*

The name of this Society shall be, "THE NEW JERSEY BRANCH OF THE WOMAN'S AUXILIARY TO THE BOARD OF MISSIONS."

ARTICLE II.—*Object.*

The object of this Society is to interest all women in the general missionary work of the church, to communicate missionary intelligence, and to secure increased contributions and prayers for the spread of the Gospel of Christ.

ARTICLE III.—*Officers.*

The officers of this Society shall be a president, 2 vice-presidents, one for the Upper and one for the Lower Division, a chairman and vice-chairman to represent each branch of the work, a secretary, treasurer, treasurer of the United Offering, Division corresponding secretaries and a secretary of the "Spirit of Missions," to be elected at the Annual Meeting to serve for one year. The election of officers shall be by ballot, nominations to be made by a nominating committee appointed by the president, and sent to each parish secretary one month before an Annual Meeting. The Diocesan Correspondent of the Church Periodical Club shall be appointed by the Bishop of the Diocese.

ARTICLE IV.—*Executive Board.*

The Executive Board shall be composed of the above officers; it shall meet twice or more each year, these meetings to be arranged by the president. Nine members shall constitute a quorum.

The Right Rev. Bishop of the Diocese shall be a member ex-officio of the Executive Board.

ARTICLE V.—*Representation.*

Any parish may become a member of this Society by appointing a secretary and notifying the president.

A membership fee of ten cents shall be paid annually by each member toward a general missionary fund. This fund is to be known as the Ten Cent Assessment Fund, to be apportioned to different objects by vote of the annual meeting. Each parish shall send to the annual meeting two or more delegates.

ARTICLE VI.—*Meetings and Collections.*

The annual meeting shall be held in the spring before the convention. There shall be meetings in the Upper and Lower Divisions in the autumn and winter, to enable the officers to present their several branches of work.

The collections at Division meetings shall be used for the contingent fund of the Auxiliary and sent to the diocesan treasurer.

ARTICLE VII.—*Amendments.*

The Constitution may be amended by a two-thirds vote at any annual meeting, when such amendments have previously been submitted in writing to and approved by the Executive Board, and read at an Upper and a Lower Division meeting.

The By-laws may be amended by a two-thirds vote at any meeting of the Executive Board, a copy of the proposed amendment having been sent to each member before hand.

BY-LAWS.

I.—*Duties of Officers.*

1. The president shall preside at all meetings, have a general oversight of all branches of the work, and perform such other duties as usually appertain to that office.
2. The vice-presidents shall assist the president in arranging for, and conducting meetings, and, in the absence of the president, preside at meetings in their respective divisions.
3. A committee, having a chairman and vice-chairman, shall have charge of each of the several branches of Mission work, respectively,—Domestic, Foreign, Diocesan, Indian and Negro Missions, the Junior Auxiliary, The Babies' Branch, Educational and Devotional,—shall receive and forward all moneys contributed for the same, and make full report to the secretary at the annual meeting.
4. The secretary shall call the roll at the annual meeting, and prepare and read the minutes, performing all duties belonging to the office.
5. The treasurer shall take charge of all moneys appropriated to the incidental expenses of the Society, and the Ten Cent Assessment Fund.
6. The treasurer of the United Offering shall take charge of all moneys contributed for that object.
7. The corresponding secretaries shall send to the Rectors, Diocesan officers and parochial secretaries, notices of each Division meeting, keep the minutes of said meetings, make an Annual report of the same, and diffuse among the parishes intelligence concerning the missionary work of the Church.
8. The chairman of the Educational Committee shall have charge of Mission Study, and of the Missionary Lending Library, which is for the use of all members of the Woman's Auxiliary in the Diocese.
9. The chairman of the Devotional Committee shall make arrangements for the days of devotion.

II.—*Meetings.*

Days of devotion shall be observed each year, at such time and place as shall be deemed advisable by the committee. Any other meetings which may be desirable can be held at times proposed by the parish or corresponding secretaries and concurred in by the president.
