

## SECRETARY'S REPORT

The Thirty-ninth Annual Meeting of the New Jersey Branch of the Woman's Auxiliary to the Board of Missions was held in St. Michael's Church, Trenton, Wednesday, April 29, 1914.

At 10.30 a.m. there was a Celebration of the Holy Communion by the Ven. Archdeacon Shepherd, assisted by the Rev. Edward Sibley, of the Philippine Islands, and the Rev. Mr. Eddy, rector of St. Michael's Church.

The Rev. Mr. Sibley gave a very interesting account of his work among the Igorots in the Philippines.

Archdeacon Shepherd made a most encouraging report of conditions in the Diocese, and took occasion to render an affectionate and sorrowful tribute to our late Bishop, whose absence brought to each one present a deep sense of loss.

The Rev. Mr. Eddy welcomed the Auxiliary most cordially in behalf of himself and the members of St. Michael's Church, and extended an invitation to all present to luncheon.

At 12.15 the business meeting was organized, the President in the Chair.

The roll call showed one hundred and seventy-five delegates present, representing forty-eight parishes.

The minutes of the Thirty-eighth Annual Meeting were read and approved. With the consent of the meeting the minutes of the several Executive Meetings held during the year were omitted.

The President made a short but stimulating address, touching upon every part of the work for the year past, and congratulating the New Jersey Branch on the hopeful outlook for the year just opening.

The Treasurer's report was read and approved.

A memorial minute on the death of our late Bishop was read by Miss Tweedy, which echoed the heart-felt sorrow in the mind of every one present. It was the sense of the meeting that the said minute be placed upon the records. The inspiring presence of our beloved Bishop has been removed from us, but the stimulating influence of his deep interest in, and love for our work from its beginnings, must ever be an impelling force to command our best efforts in the years to come.

The report on Neighborhood Meetings was very encouraging; especially was this noticeable among the shore parishes. Owing to the inconvenient train service in winter, these parishes are often unable to attend meetings, and it was found necessary to have separate meetings for them. Mrs. Dale, of Rumson, reported some most encouraging results of this experiment.

Tellers were appointed to collect and count the ballots and report at the afternoon session.

Adjourned for luncheon.

At 2.15 the business meeting was resumed. The report of the tellers was announced; the ticket as presented by the Nominating Committee was unanimously elected.

Mrs. Carpender, treasurer of the United Offering, reported on the offering presented at the Triennial Meeting last October, over \$6,000.00. The amount collected from November 1, 1913, to July 1, 1914, \$955.56, is a remarkable showing for the first quarter of the three years until our next offering will be made.

## ANNUAL ADDRESS OF THE PRESIDENT

Since we last met in Trenton a year ago, the work of the Woman's Auxiliary in New Jersey has gone on steadily and quietly in spite of several events which will long make this year of our work a memorable one.

At the Executive Meeting held in May the following officers were elected to represent the Diocese of New Jersey at the Triennial Meeting of the Woman's Auxiliary in October: Mrs. J. N. Carpender, Mrs. R. Bowden Shepherd, Mrs. A. S. Phelps, Miss K. G. Melville, and Miss Roberts. At the same meeting Miss Schwartz of Lakewood was elected Chairman of the Junior Auxiliary. Among other matters discussed was the question brought up at the last Annual Meeting as to the valuation of Missionary boxes. The Executive Board decided the boxes should be valued at the market value of the garments and other articles therein contained.

New Jersey was represented by many of you in New York at the United Offering Service, at the meetings at Carnegie Hall, and at the meetings and conferences at St. Michael's, and you doubtless treasure, as I do, the little faded purple badge, with the washed out New Jersey on it, which is associated with all such memorable occasions.

As your delegate, I must report that I was appointed on two committees: the Committee on the Woman's Auxiliary, and the Committee on Rules of Order for the next Triennial. Miss Roberts was appointed on the Junior Auxiliary Committee.

Our fall Division Meeting in the Southern part of the Diocese was held in October at Burlington. Little did we think we should never again be greeted by the kind and genial Rector of the historic old parish, the Rev. J. F. Olmsted, who so soon after closed his earthly life among us.

The meeting was a very large one, and we had fine addresses from Bishop Scadding of Oregon, Rev. W. B. Allen of North Carolina, and from our own Archdeacon. The next week the Northern Division met in Somerville, with addresses by Miss Sarah Reid, of Shanghai, and Dr. Brown of Brazil.

At Merchantville in January, the Southern Division Meeting was addressed by Dr. Jeffries, and by Rev. Mr. Kobayashi of Japan.

At Elizabeth an unusually large meeting was held on February 4th in St. John's Church; and seldom, if ever, have we been more stirred than we were by the three wonderful addresses by Dr. Tyson on the Tennessee Mountaineers, by Rev. Mr. Bostwick on the Pines of New Jersey, and by Mrs. John Ely on St. Mary's School, Shanghai.

I have left for the end of my report the event which will always mark this year as the saddest in the annals of the New

Jersey Auxiliary; the year when we lost our Bishop. Those of us who for so many years have come to these meetings, know what the greeting, the encouragement, the interest of our Bishop has always been. When we did well, he praised us, when we lagged behind he cheered us on.

He brought us the latest news from the Board of Missions for so many years, confided to us its difficulties and its hopes, kept us in touch with the work at home and abroad. Best of all, the interest he took in each one of us, and in our individual work, was a help and support which we shall sorely miss. Surely the best tribute we can pay to the life of our beloved Bishop is to go on with more enthusiasm, more self-denial than ever in the path in which he always led us, and to make the Woman's Auxiliary of the Diocese of New Jersey more worthy of its good and generous Bishop.

The members of the New Jersey Branch of the Woman's Auxiliary offer this tribute of love and appreciation as to one whom they will ever hold in lasting remembrance.

## REPORT OF THE MISSION STUDY DEPARTMENT

During the past year three most successful normal study classes have been held. At Elizabeth and Plainfield Mrs. Arthur S. Phelps was the leader, and at Trenton Mrs. Henry A. Pillsbury. Fifty-seven persons from a number of different parishes attended these classes, and most of them have used the knowledge thus gained in some branch of Mission work in their own parishes. The text-book was "The Emergency in China."

Twelve parish classes have been held under various leaders, who report an attendance of 136 persons.

All these have been regular Mission Study Classes, each having one leader for the entire course of from six to nine lessons. The interest in these classes has been great and the results effective.

One parish had a number of classes with different leaders and an attendance of from thirty-five to forty. The book studied in every class save one was the "Emergency in China"; this other class studied "The Conquest of the Continent."

Forty talks by missionaries, auxiliary leaders and others have been given in fourteen parishes; while seven parishes report one or more program meetings—a total of eighteen.

While the actual number of Mission Study Classes is no larger than last year, we believe that the interest has increased, and that in this way the work has made a decided advance.

Besides the two Normal leaders the reports show that there have been twelve parish leaders.

The text-book for next year is promised early in June, with two of the books recommended for side reading. The subject will be "The Social Results of Missions in the Orient."

The number of text-books and other missionary material sold from the distributing center, "The Diocesan House," has increased. Twenty sets of the China material, and two hundred and fifteen copies of the Emergency, twenty-five copies of the Junior book, and other literature have been disposed of, while free leaflets on China and Japan have been widely distributed.

The Educational Department in New York has urged the appointment of parochial Educational Secretaries, and we have advocated this strongly, but as yet few have been appointed in this Diocese. I hope that the parochial branches will consider this matter seriously, and notify me at once of the appointment of such secretaries.

Bishop Ingle's life is very strongly recommended to be read by individuals or Auxiliaries, and we take this opportunity of urging this upon the Missionary Societies.

Your prayers and your interest are again asked in behalf of this most important work of giving systematic information to the women of the Church.

## NEW JERSEY BRANCH OF THE WOMAN'S AUXILIARY

### Diocesan Constitution

#### ARTICLE I.—*Name.*

The name of this Society shall be, "THE NEW JERSEY BRANCH OF THE WOMAN'S AUXILIARY TO THE BOARD OF MISSIONS."

#### ARTICLE II.—*Object.*

The object of this Society is to interest all women in the general missionary work of the church, to communicate missionary intelligence, and to secure increased contributions and prayers for the spread of the Gospel of Christ.

#### ARTICLE III.—*Officers.*

The officers of this Society shall be a president, two vice-presidents, one for the Upper and one for the Lower Division, a chairman and vice-chairman to represent each branch of the work, a secretary, treasurer, treasurer of the United Offering, Division corresponding secretaries and a secretary of the "Spirit of Missions," to be elected at the Annual Meeting to serve for one year. The election of officers shall be by ballot, nominations to be made by a nominating committee appointed by the president, and sent to each parish secretary one month before an Annual Meeting. The Diocesan Correspondent of the Church Periodical Club shall be appointed by the Bishop of the Diocese.

#### ARTICLE IV.—*Executive Board.*

The Executive Board shall be composed of the above officers; it shall meet twice or more each year, these meetings to be arranged by the president. Nine members shall constitute a quorum.

The Right Rev. Bishop of the Diocese shall be a member ex-officio of the Executive Board.

## ARTICLE V.—*Representation.*

Any parish may become a member of this Society by appointing a secretary and notifying the president.

A membership fee of ten cents shall be paid annually by each member toward a general missionary fund. This fund is to be known as the Ten Cent Assessment Fund, to be used for the contingent fund of the Auxiliary and sent to the treasurer. Each parish shall send to the annual meeting two or more delegates.

## ARTICLE VI.—*Meetings and Collections.*

The annual meeting shall be held in the spring before the convention. There shall be meetings in the Upper and Lower Divisions in the autumn and winter, to enable the officers to present their several branches of work. The offerings at the Division meetings shall be used for missionary purposes at the discretion of the president and two other officers.

## ARTICLE VII.—*Amendments.*

The Constitution may be amended by a two-thirds vote at any annual meeting, when such amendments have previously been submitted in writing to and approved by the Executive Board, and read at an Upper and a Lower Division meeting.

The By-laws may be amended by a two-thirds vote at any meeting of the Executive Board, a copy of the proposed amendment having been sent to each member beforehand.

## BY-LAWS.

### I.—*Duties of Officers.*

1. The president shall preside at all meetings, have a general oversight of all branches of the work, and perform such other duties as usually appertain to that office.
2. The vice-presidents shall assist the president in arranging for, and conducting meetings, and in the absence of the president, preside at meetings in their respective divisions.
3. A committee, having a chairman and vice-chairman, shall have charge of each of the several branches of Mission work, respectively.—Domestic, Foreign, Diocesan, Indian and Negro Missions, the Junior Auxiliary, Educational and Devotional,—shall receive and forward all moneys contributed for the same, and make full report to the secretary at the annual meeting.
4. The secretary shall call the roll at the annual meeting, and prepare and read the minutes, performing all duties belonging to the office.
5. The treasurer shall take charge of all moneys appropriated to the incidental expenses of the Society, and the Ten Cent Assessment Fund.
6. The treasurer of the United Offering shall take charge of all moneys contributed for that object.
7. The corresponding secretaries shall send to the Rectors, Diocesan officers and parochial secretaries, notices of each Division meeting, keep the minutes of said meetings, make an annual report of the same, and diffuse among the parishes intelligence concerning the missionary work of the Church.
8. The chairman of the Educational Committee shall have charge of Mission Study, and of the Missionary Lending Library, which is for the use of all members of the Woman's Auxiliary in the Diocese.
9. The chairman of the Devotional Committee shall make arrangements for the days of devotion.

### II.—*Meetings.*

Days of devotion shall be observed each year, at such time and place as shall be deemed advisable by the committee. Any other meetings which may be desirable can be held at times proposed by the parish or corresponding secretaries and concurred in by the president.
