

SECRETARY'S REPORT

The Fortieth Annual Meeting of the New Jersey Branch of the Woman's Auxiliary to the Board of Missions was held in Christ Church, Trenton, Wednesday, April 28, 1915.

At 10.30 there was a celebration of the Holy Communion by the Bishop, assisted by the Ven. R. Bowden Shepherd, the Rev. Mr. Trenbath, Rector of Christ Church, and several visiting clergymen.

The Rev. Arthur M. Sherman, of China, made a most inspiring address on the work in that wonderful country, covering conditions religious, social, and political. His account of the marvelous results of education, both to men and women, was very encouraging, and must prove a strong argument with his hearers in favor of larger gifts for schools and colleges.

The Rev. R. W. Trenbath extended a most cordial welcome to the Auxiliary, and invited all present to luncheon in the Parish House.

At 12.15 the business meeting was organized. Just before the meeting was called to order, the Bishop spoke a few words of greeting informally. He assured his hearers of his deep interest in the Auxiliary, his desire to render every help in his power toward the success of their work, and asked them to call upon him whenever his help was needed.

The meeting was then called to order, the President in the chair.

One hundred and sixty-five delegates, representing forty-eight parishes, responded to the roll-call.

The minutes of the previous Annual Meeting were read and approved. With the consent of the meeting, the minutes of the several Executive Meetings held during the past year were omitted.

The following Memorial Minute on the death of Mrs. F. S. Conover was read by the Secretary:

The members of the New Jersey Branch of the Woman's Auxiliary desire to place on record this Minute as an affectionate Memorial of one with whom they have had the privilege of fellow service for many years.

Mrs. Conover was a member of the Auxiliary from the very beginning, serving for twenty years most faithfully and efficiently, first as Corresponding Secretary of the Middle Division and afterward as Vice-president of the Missionary Lending Library.

Her love and active interest in all Missionary Endeavor will be greatly missed both in the Parish and Diocesan work of the Woman's Auxiliary, and this tribute is offered in recognition and appreciation of her devotion to its highest ideals, and to the enduring influence of her Christian character.

For her it is most fitting that in this Advent Season she has put upon her the Armour of Light, and is clothed in immortality.
Friday, December 4, 1914.

A motion that the above memorial resolution be placed upon the minutes was approved.

The President's address which followed reviewed the work of the year.

In the absence of Miss Tweedy, the Treasurer's report was read by Mrs. Monroe and accepted.

Archdeacon Shepherd made a strong plea for his Diocesan work, thanked the women for help given him in the past; and placed before them several worthy objects for their gifts in the coming year.

The report of Mrs. Carpender, who was unable to be present, was read by the President. The amount already in hand toward the United Offering of 1916, is \$2,864.00, an unusually good start for the first half of the three years.

Meeting adjourned for luncheon.

On reassembling, the report of the tellers appointed by the President to collect and count the ballot was presented. The ticket offered by the Nominating Committee was unanimously elected.

Mr. Sherman then responded to a request of the meeting to give some further information about his work in China, especially concerning the new building for St. Mary's School. An interesting fact in connection with the latter, mentioned by Mr. Sherman, was, that while St. Mary's School represented American womanhood, the Chinese women and girls are having built, on the opposite side of the Campus, a very large building to represent Chinese womanhood and girlhood.

ANNUAL REPORT OF THE PRESIDENT

There are two events which will make this year of the Woman's Auxiliary in N. J. a memorable one. The first and most intimate one is the Consecration of our Bishop on January 25th at St. Mary's, Burlington. The Committee of Arrangements was particularly kind in giving cards to the officers of the Auxiliary, so that we all had the privilege of witnessing the impressive ceremony. Bishop Matthews has attended our two Winter Division Meetings, and has addressed us in a most helpful way. We hope he realized that we look to him as our leader in our work in and out of the Diocese, and that we shall always welcome him at our meetings, and be grateful for his advice and counsel.

The other event which will mark the season of 1914-15 in the New Jersey Auxiliary is the war in Europe. You may ask what the war in Europe has to do with the New Jersey Auxiliary, but I assure you it has a great deal to do with it. The effects of the war in our State, have been, as in practically all other places, to increase a hundred-fold the want and suffering of the poor, and to bring reduced incomes to those in more comfortable circumstances. The calls for help of all kinds have been constant, and those to whom Social Service has been but a name, have discovered how closely their lives are bound up with those

of their fellows. We have not been able to limit our sympathies to our fellow countrymen, for from across the Ocean the bitter cry of suffering and starvation has rung in our ears every day. At first we heard suggestions that the work of Missions would be hampered, must be cut down, but they were only suggestions, and soon they ceased, for a wonderful thing was happening. Instead of the members of the local Auxiliaries turning away from their legitimate work to respond to the new appeals, they found they could do both, and the more they worked for the Red Cross or their neighbors at home, the more their hearts were warmed and their enthusiasm stirred for the Missions of the Church.

Everywhere I have found both in the large and in the small Branches, the members of the Woman's Auxiliary acting as leaders in the Red Cross, the Belgian Relief, and in local charities.

It can never be said again that the women of the Auxiliary are so absorbed in work in Africa and China that they neglect the needs nearer home. Whatever our money reports may show, I shall always believe that the experiences of this sad winter have been most helpful to the members of the Woman's Auxiliary in showing them the possibilities of their own sympathies, and in teaching them the joy of giving and of helping in a real spirit of brotherly love.

The President of the Long Island Branch of the Woman's Auxiliary extended a most cordial invitation to the other Diocesan Branches in the Second Province to meet in Brooklyn at the time of the Synod, and discuss the advisability of forming a Provincial Branch of the Woman's Auxiliary. It was decided that this plan was not expedient at that time.

Meetings have been held as usual in both Divisions during the past season. In the fall, the meetings were at Mt. Holly and at Princeton, and the speakers were Rev. Stuart L. Tyson of Sewanee, and Miss Clarke of Alaska, Bishop Funsten of Idaho, Miss Heywood of Tokyo, Mrs. Wetmore of Arden, and our Nurse in the Pines of New Jersey.

In the winter we met at Riverton when Bishop Matthews spoke, also Mrs. Pancoast and Miss Bassett from the Tennessee Mountains. At Westfield we had addresses from Bishop Matthews, Rev. A. B. Hunter of Raleigh, and Deaconess Sabine of Alaska.

The Quiet Days for the Diocese were held at Burlington by Father Officer and at St. John's, Elizabeth, by Rev. Mr. Conover.

This record of work attempted and accomplished seems very small compared to the greatness of the need, but I am reporting it, fully conscious of its many shortcomings, and only thankful that I have been allowed to have even this little share in the great and blessed work of Missions.

As spokesman for the Junior Executive Board, I think I can safely report that we all feel that the work has made a step forward, both in organization and in a higher ideal and aim.

Now we have the three sections:—for children up to eight; from eight to sixteen, and from then until they are prepared to enter the Woman's Auxiliary.

In January Miss Elita Smith took charge of the Little Helpers which had been very much neglected. She started three new branches and hopes that wherever there is a Woman's or Junior Auxiliary they will ask for the "Little Helpers" the first step in missionary work.

In section two there are six new branches, and in section three two. This last division prepares the girl to enter the Woman's Auxiliary and also trains her for future work in the Auxiliary or the mission field.

Our Annual Conference was held at Trinity Church, Trenton, in December. Delegates were sent from numerous branches, and also from a near-by G. F. S.

After the business session, Miss Pennywell, the district nurse of the Pines, addressed the children and also our old and dear friend Mrs. Wetmore. Later the girls of St. James, Trenton, gave us a short Christmas play.

Neighborhood meetings have been held at Camden, Shrewsbury, and Elizabeth; and an inter-diocesan meeting in Newark. The chairman has visited Gladstone, Bernardsville and Sea

Girt—addressing the Juniors and in one instance the Seniors as well. During Lent she conducted two study classes in her own town, and began and ended one in New Brunswick.

Last spring we elected two new officers, a secretary and an educational secretary, who took up their new work this fall; Miss Blatchford and Mrs. Senseman who by their effective work during the winter have made themselves known to all. Mrs. Senseman sent out a course on the "Social Aspects," for use in Section III; and also slips asking the leaders to reply as to what sort of missionary instruction they were using. Seventeen branches answered that they had used one of the following textbooks or pamphlets:

The "Social Aspects"

The Cross Goes Forward

Spirit of Missions

The Lessons in the Young Churchman

All reported an awakened interest and keener enthusiasm for the Church and its missions

Miss Wood's report is that with the exception of our pledge to the Pines, which is but eight dollars short, all our Junior obligations have been met.

For the summer three of our leaders are volunteering for Virginia, Wyoming and Tennessee, and one of our older Juniors is to go to the Pines for a few weeks to do Social Service work under the direction of Miss Hughes. Promises of help have come from other quarters, so the place may be supplied until the fall. Several are going to the Summer Conferences—those great sources of instruction and inspiration for the local worker.

In Atlantic City, early in December will be held our annual conference for leaders and older girls.

At present our branches stand as follows:

18 in Sec. I.

37 in Sec. II.

8 in Sec. III.

7 affiliated societies doing mission work.

70 in all.

The children have done well and the leaders have worked patiently and bravely; but let us not rest upon what we have done, but look forward to what we may do for bigger and greater things lie before the laborer in "the Kingdom" and its extension.

REPORT OF THE MISSION STUDY DEPARTMENT

During the past year four successful Normal Study Classes have been held. At Elizabeth, Plainfield and New Brunswick Mrs. Arthur Phelps was the leader, while at Trenton a condensed Normal Class was given by Mrs. Henry Pilsby.

Sixty-three persons from a number of Parishes attended these classes.

Thirteen Parish Classes were held under various leaders, reporting a membership of one hundred and forty-four, and, in addition, two Neighborhood Classes, one held by Mrs. Jennings and another by Mrs. Simons, with a membership of twenty-eight.

Another Parish Class was started at Haddonfield, but sickness prevented Mrs. Stevenson from finishing it.

These have been regular Mission Study Classes, each having one leader for the entire course of from six to nine lessons. At the Church of the Ascension, Atlantic City, a quiet day was held under the auspices of the class.

In these and a number of other Parishes, Missionary Talks were given by returned missionaries and others.

All these classes used the text-book for this year, "The Social Aspects of Foreign Missions." Twenty-one sets of the special library, two hundred and thirty text-books, thirty-five copies of the "Then and Now," and other literature were sold and distributed from the Diocesan House. This is the first year that this department has paid its expenses, the Board of Missions making such a reduction to our distributing centre, that we were enabled to pay the express and postal charges.

We are enabled therefore to turn over to the new Educational Secretary the amount which was voted to this department last year: \$20.00.

The text-book for the next year is a new edition of the "Why and How of Foreign Missions."

The lending library has not been used this year, inasmuch as the special library for the course covered the whole subject of study.

In turning over this department to the new Educational Secretary, Mrs. Paul Matthews, I desire to thank all those who have so cordially co-operated with me for the past six years, and to ask them to give this same co-operation to my successor, whom I am sure can do much more efficient and aggressive work in this systematic effort to give carefully prepared information to the women of the Church.

NEW JERSEY BRANCH OF THE WOMAN'S AUXILIARY

Diocesan Constitution

ARTICLE I.—*Name.*

The name of this Society shall be, "THE NEW JERSEY BRANCH OF THE WOMAN'S AUXILIARY TO THE BOARD OF MISSIONS."

ARTICLE II.—*Object.*

The object of this Society is to interest all women in the general missionary work of the church, to communicate missionary intelligence, and to secure increased contributions and prayers for the spread of the Gospel of Christ.

ARTICLE III.—*Officers.*

The officers of this Society shall be a president, two vice-presidents, one for the Upper and one for the Lower Division, a chairman and vice-chairman to represent each branch of the work, a secretary, treasurer, treasurer of the United Offering, Division corresponding secretaries and a secretary of the "Spirit of Missions," to be elected at the Annual Meeting to serve for one year. The election of officers shall be by ballot, nominations to be made by a nominating committee appointed by the president, and sent to each parish secretary one month before an Annual Meeting. The Diocesan Correspondent of the Church Periodical Club shall be appointed by the Bishop of the Diocese.

ARTICLE IV.—*Executive Board.*

The Executive Board shall be composed of the above officers; it shall meet twice or more each year, these meetings to be arranged by the president. Nine members shall constitute a quorum.

The Right Rev. Bishop of the Diocese shall be a member ex-officio of the Executive Board.

ARTICLE V.—*Representation.*

Any parish may become a member of this Society by appointing a secretary and notifying the president.

A membership fee of ten cents shall be paid annually by each member toward a general fund. This fund is to be known as the Ten Cent Assessment Fund, to be used for the contingent fund of the Auxiliary and sent to the Diocesan treasurer. Each parish shall send to the annual meeting two or more delegates.

ARTICLE VI.—*Meetings and Collections.*

The annual meeting shall be held in the spring before the convention. There shall be meetings in the Upper and Lower Divisions in the autumn and winter, to enable the officers to present their several branches of work. The offerings at the Division meetings shall be used for missionary purposes at the discretion of the president and two other officers.

ARTICLE VII.—*Amendments.*

The Constitution may be amended by a two-thirds vote at any annual meeting, when such amendments have previously been submitted in writing to and approved by the Executive Board, and read at an Upper and a Lower Division meeting.

The By-laws may be amended by a two-thirds vote at any meeting of the Executive Board, a copy of the proposed amendment having been sent to each member beforehand.

BY-LAWS.

I.—*Duties of Officers.*

1. The president shall preside at all meetings, have a general oversight of all branches of the work, and perform such other duties as usually appertain to that office.

2. The vice-presidents shall assist the president in arranging for, and conducting meetings, and in the absence of the president, preside at meetings in their respective divisions.

3. A committee, having a chairman and vice-chairman, shall have charge of each of the several branches of Mission work, respectively,—Domestic, Foreign, Diocesan, Indian and Negro Missions, the Junior Auxiliary, Educational and Devotional,—shall receive and forward all moneys contributed for the same, and make full report to the secretary at the annual meeting.

4. The secretary shall call the roll at the annual meeting, and prepare and read the minutes, performing all duties belonging to the office.

5. The treasurer shall take charge of all moneys appropriated to the incidental expenses of the Society, and the Ten Cent Assessment Fund.

6. The treasurer of the United Offering shall take charge of all moneys contributed for that object.

7. The corresponding secretaries shall send to the Rectors, Diocesan officers and parochial secretaries, notices of each Division meeting, keep the minutes of said meetings, make an annual report of the same, and diffuse among the parishes intelligence concerning the missionary work of the Church.

8. The chairman of the Educational Committee shall have charge of Mission Study, and of the Missionary Lending Library, which is for the use of all members of the Woman's Auxiliary in the Diocese.

9. The chairman of the Devotional Committee shall make arrangements for the days of devotion.

II.—*Meetings.*

Days of devotion shall be observed each year, at such time and place as shall be deemed advisable by the committee. Any other meetings which may be desirable can be held at times proposed by the parish or corresponding secretaries and concurred in by the president.
