The Holy Communion was celebrated by Bishop Matthews, Wednesday, April 25th, at 7:30 A. M., in Trinity Church; there was also a celebration at the Pro-Cathedral at the same hour. At 10 A. M. the Auxiliary re-assembled for business—263 members answered the roll call. The President's address was read. Resolutions of regret were presented on the retirement from the Board of the following officers: Mrs. White, Chairman of Foreign Work; Mrs. Taggart, Secretary; Miss Kingdon, Corresponding Secretary, and Mrs. Rich, Chairman of Devotional Committee.

Mrs. Whiteley, Chairman of Nominating Committee, read the ballot. President appointed tellers for the annual election of officers.

Mrs. White, Chairman of Foreign Missions, reported the \$500 pledge for Work Among Women and Girls in China paid in full.

Mrs. Stroud, Vice-Chairman of Foreign Work, reported the \$300 pledge for St. Agnes' School, Kyoto, Japan, overpaid, \$308 having been received.

In behalf of the Chairman of the United Offering, Mrs. Carpenter, who was absent on account of illness, the President read her report: Money received up to date, \$1,348.30. The amount presented from the Diocese of New Jersey, at the Triennial in St. Louis, October, 1916, was \$8,181.50.

The tellers reported the ticket presented by the Nominating Committee elected.

At noon Archdeacon Shepherd read prayers for Missions. Adjournment for luncheon followed. Meeting was called to order at 2 o'clock.

Miss Littell addressed the Auxiliary on the subject of the Church General Hospital in Wuchang.

Miss Agnes Morewood, of Elizabeth, was appointed special assistant to Mrs. Simons, Educational Secretary. A vote of thanks was given the rector and members of Trinity Church for their cordial hospitality. Prayers were said by the Bishop, after which the meeting adjourned.

ANNUAL REPORT OF THE PRESIDENT OF THE WOMAN'S AUXILIARY

This season's activities began somewhat later than usual, on account of the Triennial Meeting of the Woman's Auxiliary in St. Louis, which I attended. Our other New Jersey delegates were: Mrs. Shepherd, Mrs. Monroe, Miss Runk and Miss Schwartz. We tried to represent you to the best of our ability, attended all the meetings we could crowd into the days. I served as Chairman of the Committee on Miscellaneous Resolutions, and was also appointed to represent the Second Province on the Programme Committee for the next Triennial, to be held in Detroit in 1919. For the first time in many years our beloved Treasurer of the United Offering was not able to carry our United Offering to the Great Service, so it was presented by Mrs. Monroe, representing Mrs. Carpender.

The fall Division Meetings were held soon after our return. On November 2d, in Vineland, the Bishop and the delegates to the Triennial, told their stories of the many interesting things they had heard and seen. November 8th, at St. John's, New Brunswick, we had three speakers—the Rev. Mr. Snaveley, of Porto Rico; the Rev. A. B. Clark, of Rosebud, S. D., and Archdeacon Claibourne, of Tenn. The winter meetings were held at Grace Church, Haddonfield, where the Rev. Mr. Hilton, of Morganton, N. C., was the speaker, and at Holy Cross Church, North Plainfield, where Bishop Beecher, of Western Nebraska, addressed us. Archdeacon Shepherd spoke also at both meetings.

Instead of 17 parish branches visited last year, I can report having visited 29 this year. This is a great improvement, but there are still many places where I have not yet been asked to go. These 29 visits really represent many more than 29 branches, as on several occasions five or six Auxiliaries have been asked to meet me at one place. I must say here that I have been very much gratified with the work of the district officers. They have tried in every way to interest the women of the parishes where there are no branches, by inviting them to the district meetings; in a number of cases branches have been organized as a result of their efforts.

I have to report as my share of the educational work this year, two conferences on Prayer, and four classes on the same subject. The conferences were for the Monmouth County District, one at Rumson, the other at Asbury Park. The classes were at Holy Cross Church, North Plainfield; Christ Church, Elizabeth; St. Paul's, Westfield, and St. Paul's, Bound Brook.

An event of great importance to the Auxiliary at large was the resignation, in December last, of Miss Julia C. Emery, for 40 years the General Secretary of the Woman's Auxiliary. Miss Emery has for so many years been the guide and counsellor of all Auxiliary workers that it is difficult to realize that her hand is no longer at the helm. Miss Grace Lindley, who has been for some time her efficient associate, has been appointed in her place for a term of three years.

There are four names, which we must all miss from our ballot this year. Mrs. Rich, who has filled the office of Chairman of the Devotional Committee for several years, has declined to be renominated. She will be a great loss to the Executive Board. Miss Kingdon, who has been Secretary of the Lower Division for 18 years, also declined renomination. Miss Kingdon has seen the Auxiliary grow from a small band of women to the proportions it has now attained. We owe Miss Kingdon a debt of gratitude for her constant and faithful work. Mrs. Thomas R. White has stood for Foreign Missions in the minds of our Auxiliary for 25 years. Having been herself a missionary in Japan, she could speak with authority for the foreign field; we have felt very proud to think that we had a real missionary to direct our work for missions abroad. On account of her frequent absences from home, Mrs. White feels she can no longer keep the office. Our secretary, Mrs. Taggart, has been an officer of the New Jersey Auxiliary for 28 years, and now is obliged to retire. For all these years she has filled this office with devotion and zeal; preparing our annual reports through the long hot summer days, when most of us feel we can be lazy and let our work rest for a while.

The New Jersey Auxiliary has certainly been blest in the services and example of these faithful workers. May we, who have more lately taken up the work, follow in the steps of their untiring devotion.

We stand here to-day facing a future which is absolutely unknown to us. Our President has recognized a state of war, and how much or how little that is going to mean we do not know. But one thing we do know, and that is, that whatever happens the work for the spread of the Kingdom of the Prince of Peace must go on. Our missions and our missionaries must not suffer, our institutions must not be closed. These would need the Gospel of Jesus Christ more than ever, and we have heard the call.

What if our taxes are increased, our expenses greater, the cost of living higher—we must not economize on missions. We can simplify our table, our wardrobes, our amusements, cut down everything before we reduce our offerings for Missions. Who can ever forget the brave words of Bishop Montgomery, at the United Offering Mass Meeting in St. Louis, when he told us, that in England the Venerable S. P. G. is not discouraged or disheartened, that in spite of taxes increased tenfold, and the terrible drain on their resources in every way, they had had the best year financially they had ever known. There is an example for us to follow when we are tempted to think we must hold back in our offerings for the extension of Christ's Kingdom. The commission of our Lord to His disciples was not limited to times of peace and plenty, and if we have tried to follow His leading in the past when the way was clear we must follow Him just as faithfully now.

REPORT OF EDUCATIONAL SECRETARY

The year began with an Institute for Mission Study and Conference on Auxiliary Work, held at St. Michael's Church, Trenton, on November 15th, 16th and 17th. Classes were conducted by Mrs. Charles E. Hutchison, of East Orange; Miss Elizabeth Matthews, Educational Secretary of Southern Ohio, and Miss Schwartz, our Junior Auxiliary Chairman; and a Conference each afternoon was led respectively by our President, Mrs. Phelps, the Rev. Arthur R. Gray, Educational Secretary of Latin America, and Miss Grace Lindley, Miss Emery's successor as Secretary of the Woman's Auxiliary.

The Institute was well attended—over sixty women registered for the classes, and others came in for the afternoon Conferences; yet, it can hardly be said to have been an entire success. In individual cases, doubtless there was given a spiritual impetus of which we may never know, but for the work in the Diocese, the result was distinctly disappointing. The majority of those who attended do not seem to have realized their responsibility to take a more active part in this work, for which the Institute was intended to inspire and prepare them.

Early in December a questionnaire was sent out by the Educational Secretary to all the branches of the Auxiliary as listed in the Annual Report (with the exception of five summer parishes or small missions in each division), primarily to find out where mission study classes or reading circles were wanted during Lent; and also to gain some idea of the strength and activity and plan of work of each branch.

One normal and twenty-two parochial and inter-parochial classes have been held, most of them during Lent, with twelve active leaders; but two were led by the rectors of the parishes, one by an outside leader, and one by different members in turn. The membership of all these classes was 224, the average attendance, 168. In addition to

these, eight reading circles were carried on with a membership of 100, and an average attendance of 69.

Besides these were Miss Hare's Missionary Class, at the Church of the Ascension, Atlantic City; two Conferences on Prayer, conducted by Mrs. Phelps for the Monmouth District; and some missionary readings and talks, in two or three Auxiliary branches, and in one Sunday School; and some home study of missionary books.

This shows a falling off from last year in leaders, classes and membership. The reading circles are not included in this comparison—they cannot fairly be counted with the regular classes.

The Educational Department of the Church Missions House this year suggested reading circles for parishes which were not willing or ready for a regular Mission Study Class, and brought out a pamphlet of suggestions for these, using the text book of the year, "The New World," giving topics for discussion and subjects for papers, &c. Conducted in this way they are very interesting and instructive, but a reading circle cannot take the place of the Mission Study Class, the aim for which is to deepen the spiritual life of its members and so strengthen the parish, and to result in active missionary endeavor, and is counted a failure if it does no more than interest and instruct.

There is practically no financial report. The expenses of the Institute were only partly covered by the registration fees, but the deficiency was made up by two or three persons, and the balance in the treasury remains \$16.95.

The time has come when the educational work can no longer be regarded as a side issue. We must be recognized as of equal importance with, if not greater, than any other part of the work of the Woman's Auxiliary.

The main reason Miss Emery gave for her resignation was that the educational work has come to be of such vital importance that she realized that the leadership of the Auxiliary should be in the hands of a younger woman than herself, trained in modern educational methods. In all the progressive dioceses it is being more and more stressed, and surely we in New Jersey are not willing to lag behind—here where we have more advantages and fewer difficulties (outside of ourselves!) than many of our western sisters whose enterprise puts us to shame.

We must have a fuller and more complete organization in this department, a strong central point from which lines reach out to each district, to spread the interest and responsibility throughout the diocese as has not hitherto been done, and *we must all take part in it*. The educational work is much more than Mission Study Classes—it should permeate every branch of effort. We must work with hearts and hands, but with our heads, too. If we do not *know* what we are about we shall never be able to convince others of its importance—and it is "Our Father's business."

How much more interesting our regular parish branch meetings would be, both to us and to the women we want to join us, if we were all well-informed as to the Church's Missions, with some knowledge of their needs, hopes and plans, at least of those towards whose support we give our mite. We are familiar with the complaint "we cannot

get the women of our parish to take any interest in the Auxiliary." Can we not realize why? The trouble is with us, the regular members, who are content to go on in our old humdrum, ignorant way, so that in our hearts we cannot wonder that our prosy meetings do not appeal to the woman outside. If we can only make ourselves more interesting, our meetings are sure to be.

We are daily thrilled by instances of splendid physical courage in this frightful war of destruction and death; shall we Christian soldiers in the great battles for human welfare and eternal life be less courageous under our great Leader, and lack the spiritual pluck and bravery to take up the work that needs us?

REPORT OF THE JUNIOR AUXILIARY

The year has brought us many changes in parish branches and in our Executive Board. Our Vice-Chairman, Miss Roberts, has resigned. Miss Roberts has been one of the sponsors for the Auxiliary for many years, and it will seem strange not to have her with us in our meetings, though as secretary of the dioceses we will have the pleasure of meeting her once in awhile. Miss Elita Smith also resigned, feeling that her time was already too full to do the work of the Little Helpers. We are happy to announce that we have with us as Vice-Chairman, Miss Nancy Stokes, and Miss Brower, as Little Helpers' Secretary. As yet there is no Educational Secretary, but we hope that soon we will be able to fill this most important place.

The year has brought us twelve new branches, two being classes that have graduated into section three, and two are branches that have been revived. We have lost three branches, however, and in the death of Mrs. Daw, of Spotswood, a faithful and devoted worker.

The fall conference that was held at Trinity, Elizabeth, was considered the most successful and helpful that we have held thus far. It was well attended, and from it have come excellent results. These conferences are held so that the parish leaders may benefit by the experience of others and gain knowledge, courage and enthusiasm for their winter's work. The normal classes were pronounced to be helpful, also, as the leaders can discuss their failures and successes more freely in a small group than in a large one.

At all but one of the Division meetings I have spoken of the new Junior and Sunday School plan. So far I regret to say that the plan has not been generally adopted in our dioceses, though several of our branches have taken the matter up and are working it out in their own way. The theory of it is so very fine that it is to be hoped that next year we may find a practical plan for the co-operation of the two branches of children's missionary endeavor, the Sunday School and the Junior Auxiliary.

I would also like to speak of the Magazine, a new venture. It is by the children and for the children. There will be many mistakes, as this is our first year, but next year we hope to do better.

The Board is very happy over the income for the fiscal year. Not only have the Juniors paid the extra pledge of \$200 for St. Agnes' School, Kyoto, but they more than met their other obligations, over-paying all other pledges.

In our pride of success and our interest of the work, let us not forget that our real purpose is to make known the gentle, gracious Saviour, that worked daily, ceaselessly amongst the hills and cities of Judea, that rich and poor alike might know the Kingdom of God.

NEW JERSEY BRANCH OF THE WOMAN'S AUXILIARY

Diocesan Constitution

ARTICLE I.—*Name.*

The name of this Society shall be, "THE NEW JERSEY BRANCH OF THE WOMAN'S AUXILIARY TO THE BOARD OF MISSIONS."

ARTICLE II.—*Object.*

The object of this Society is to interest all women in the general missionary work of the church, to communicate missionary intelligence, and to secure increased contributions and prayers for the spread of the Gospel of Christ.

ARTICLE III.—*Officers.*

The officers of this Society shall be a president, two vice-presidents, one for the Upper and one for the Lower Division, a chairman and vice-chairman to represent each branch of the work, a secretary, treasurer, a treasurer of the United Offering, Division corresponding secretaries and a secretary of the "Spirit of Missions," to be elected at the Annual Meeting to serve for one year. The election of officers shall be by ballot, nominations to be made by a nominating committee appointed by the president, and sent to each parish secretary one month before an Annual Meeting. The Diocesan Correspondent of the Church Periodical Club shall be appointed by the Bishop of the Diocese.

ARTICLE IV.—*Executive Board.*

The Executive Board shall be composed of the above officers; it shall meet twice or more each year, these meetings to be arranged by the president. Nine members shall constitute a quorum.

The Right Rev. Bishop of the Diocese shall be a member ex-officio of the Executive Board.

ARTICLE V.—*Representation.*

Any parish may become a member of this Society by appointing a secretary and notifying the president.

A membership fee of ten cents shall be paid annually by each member toward a general fund. This fund is to be known as the Ten Cent Assessment Fund, to be used for the contingent fund of the Auxiliary and sent to the Diocesan treasurer. Each parish shall send to the annual meeting two or more delegates.

ARTICLE VI.—*Meetings and Collections.*

The annual meeting shall be held in the spring before the convention. There shall be meetings in the Upper and Lower Divisions in the autumn and winter, to enable the officers to present their several branches of work. The offerings at the Division meetings shall be used for missionary purposes at the discretion of the president and two other officers.

ARTICLE VII.—*Amendments.*

The Constitution may be amended by a two-thirds vote at any annual meeting, when such amendments have previously been submitted in writing to, and approved by the Executive Board, and read at an Upper and a Lower Division meeting.

The By-laws may be amended by a two-thirds vote at any meeting of the Executive Board, a copy of the proposed amendment having been sent to each member beforehand.

BY-LAWS.

I.—*Duties of Officers.*

1. The president shall preside at all meetings, have a general oversight of all branches of the work, and perform such other duties as usually appertain to that office.

2. The vice-presidents shall assist the president in arranging for, and conducting meetings, and in the absence of the president, preside at meetings in their respective divisions.

3. A committee, having a chairman and vice-chairman, shall have charge of each of the several branches of Mission work, respectively,—Domestic, Foreign, Diocesan, Indian and Negro Missions, the Junior Auxiliary, Educational and Devotional,—shall receive and forward all moneys contributed for the same, and make full report to the secretary at the annual meeting.

4. The secretary shall call the roll at the annual meeting, and prepare and read the minutes, performing all duties belonging to the office.

5. The treasurer shall take charge of all moneys appropriated to the incidental expenses of the Society, and the Ten Cent Assessment Fund.

6. The treasurer of the United Offering shall take charge of all moneys contributed for that object.

7. The corresponding secretaries shall send to the Rectors, Diocesan officers and parochial secretaries, notices of each Division meeting, keep the minutes of said meetings, make an annual report of the same, and diffuse among the parishes intelligence concerning the missionary work of the Church.

8. The chairman of the Educational Committee shall have charge of Mission Study, and of the Missionary Lending Library, which is for the use of all members of the Woman's Auxiliary in the Diocese.

9. The chairman of the Devotional Committee shall make arrangements for the days of devotion.

II.—*Meetings.*

Days of devotion shall be observed each year, at such time and place as shall be deemed advisable by the committee. Any other meetings which may be desirable can be held at times proposed by the parish or corresponding secretaries and concurred in by the president.
