SECRETARY'S REPORT

The Forty-third Annual Meeting of the New Jersey Branch of the Woman's Auxiliary to the Board of Missions was held in Asbury Park, New Jersey, May 14-15, the Diocesan Convention of the Church convening in Trinity Church, Asbury Park, on the same dates. The sessions of the Auxiliary were held in Cooper Hall. The President, Mrs. Arthur S. Phelps, presiding. One hundred and forty-two delegates, representing 60 parishes, responded to the roll-call at the opening session at 11 A. M., May 14; 150 delegates, representing 63 parishes, responding at 10:30 A. M., May 15.

Reports read from the standing committees showed good results from the year's work. The Foreign Committee reported the \$500 pledge for Woman's Department Church General Hospital, Wuchang, China, overpaid, the amount received for this work being over \$1,000.

A resolution of regret on the resignation of Mrs. John Carpender, Treasurer of the United Offering, presented by Mrs. Munroe, was unanimously adopted.

Mrs. Simons reported on amendments to the constitution; said amendments were voted on and adopted.

At 3:00 P. M. a joint meeting with the Convention was held in Trinity Church, Mrs. Phelps, the President of the Auxiliary, giving the annual report of the Auxiliary at that time.

On Wednesday, May 15, a celebration of the Holy Communion was held in Trinity Church at 7:30 A. M. At 10:30 A. M. the President called the Auxiliary to order in Cooper Hall.

Mrs. R. Bowden Shepherd, Treasurer for the United Offering, reported the amount of money received from October, 1916-May, 1918, to be \$4,315.68.

Rev. Dr. Twing, missionary in the Pines of New Jersey, read the noonday prayers for Missions and gave a most interesting account of his work.

Mrs. Hall, Chairman of Nominating Committee, read the ballot. The President appointed Mrs. Van Meter and Mrs. Hubbard tellers for the annual election of officers.

The tellers reported the ticket presented by the Nominating Committee elected, 61 ballots being cast.

Resolutions of regret were presented on the retirement from the Board of the following officers: Miss Runk, as Chairman, and Mrs. Hoe, as Vice-Chairman of Work Among Negroes, and Miss Melville, as Chairman of Domestic Missions.

In accordance with the amended constitution the President appointed the following officers for a term of 3 years: Recording Secretary, Miss Florence M. Roberts; Corresponding Secretary, Miss Zella Kelley; Treasurer, Miss H. B. Driggs.

An adjourned meeting was held at 2:30 P. M. in the sun parlor of the Hotel Metropolitan. A vote of thanks was given the rector and members of Trinity Church, Asbury Park, for the cordial hospitality extended to the Auxiliary during the annual meeting. The business was concluded by an urgent appeal from the President for co-operation in the Advent Call, the War Work of the Woman's Auxiliary, a call to every baptized woman for prayer and service. The President appointed Mrs. Paul Matthews as Diocesan Leader for this work. There being no further business the meeting adjourned.

ANNUAL REPORT OF THE PRESIDENT OF THE WOMAN'S AUXILIARY

The report of the Woman's Auxiliary in this Diocese for the first year of the war, is one of special interest, and in collecting my material for making it, I felt I was approaching an unknown quantity. The first points are not different from ordinary years. We had our regular fall meetings, one in Collingswood and the other at Long Branch, at both of which we had addresses on the work being done in Wusih, China, by Miss Hammond, of the District of Shanghai. Rev. Mr. Block spoke to us at the Lower Division Meeting about the War Work in the Diocese, and the Bishop spoke on the same subject at Long Branch. On account of the cold and the restricted train service, an unusually small number of women met at the Church of the Ascension, Atlantic City, for the winter meeting in that Division. The Rev. N. Cresson McHenry, of the Philadelphia City Mission, spoke of the work done in that city for the outcast and the suffering. At Trinity Church, Elizabeth, the Upper Division had its winter meeting, with a clerical missionary from Wyoming, as speaker. He told of the Indian work which is being done under Bishop Thomas, and Mrs. Wetmore also spoke of the work at Christ School, Arden, N. C. Rev. Mr. Conover, by special request, gave some account of his work as temporary Chaplain at Camp Vail. Bishop Matthews and the Archdeacon have honored us with their presence at our meetings and have given us their counsel and encouragement.

Perhaps because of the cold, or the coal shortage which has prevented the use of many Parish houses this past winter, I have been asked to visit very few branches or district meetings—only ten this year have made use of me in this way. During Lent I conducted classes in Lakewood and Christ Church, New Brunswick.

The Institute at St. Paul's, Camden, and the Quiet Days in various places offered privileges which were not as freely used as we could have wished, but again in these cases war conditions may have kept many at home.

When the Synod of the Second Province met in New York in January, a meeting of Special Delegates of the Woman's Auxiliary was held at the Deanery and after much discussion the Woman's Auxiliary in the seven Dioceses of New York, New Jersey and Porto Rico was organized as a Provincial Branch. Later in the year the various Presidents of the Auxiliaries in these Dioceses were appointed members of the Provincial Board of Missions. In April I attended a meeting of this Board in New York.

As I had a personal knowledge of so few of the Branches this year, and as Questionnaires seem to be in high favor just now, I decided to try the plan of sending out a few simple questions to our Parish branch Secretaries and to the various Chairmen in charge of the different departments of the work. I have been very much gratified with the prompt and satisfactory answers I have received. I have received answers from 77 of the 84 Secretaries to whom I sent the questions, which is surely a very high percentage.

According to these reports, there are, approximately, 8,425 women communicants in these 77 Parishes and Missions, with an Auxiliary membership of 1,734. All but 17 of these branches have had regular meetings; 39 of them once or twice a month, 19 of them once a week, and many of the former met weekly during Lent. All but 17 report their membership either increased or holding its own, and only 28 have found that War Work had interfered with the Missionary work of the Branch. Fifty-four of the Branches have had at least one Corporate Communion—a very encouraging feature which shows that the women are realizing more the spiritual nature of their work. Somewhat less cheering is the report of only 17 Mission Study Classes. If we are learning to pray more earnestly for the coming of the Kingdom, we surely should wish to do so more intelligently, and we should also learn how our prayers are being answered, and what is the progress of the Kingdom throughout the world.

From the Diocesan officers of the Auxiliary I have also received most encouraging reports. The number and value of the missionary boxes sent has been a good deal less than in some former years, but this is easily explained by the fact that it has been almost impossible to send boxes by express or freight to many parts of the country this winter, and therefore many branches have either not attempted to send them or have sent smaller packages by Parcel Post. There have, however, been some excellent boxes sent, in spite of difficulties. The tone of all the officers' reports is noticeably cheerful and optimistic. They all report fully as much interest, and in some cases much more interest, than in other years—generous gifts from many quarters, pledges met and overpaid. The Treasurer of the United Offering—at this half-way point between Triennials—has over \$4,000, as against \$2,800 three years ago. In short, our Auxiliary has stood the test, and can venture to claim to be following, even if afar off, the Venerable Society of our Mother Church of England which declares that "this year, with all its difficulties and disappointments, its trials and sorrows, will stand out in the S. P. G. records as a period remarkable

for devotion to the great cause which the Venerable Society has for 217 years so successfully promoted. Never in any previous year have the offerings from parishes and the gifts from individuals been so large as during 1917."

The question as to what share the Woman's Auxiliary should take in War Work has been one which has puzzled us all. There has been no need to point out to the individual members of the Woman's Auxiliary their duty in this regard, but as a society what should we do? This was the question which our Bishop asked us at the opening of St. George's Chapel, at Camp Dix, and the only answer I could make was to point to the spiritual character of our society and pledge our regular and definite intercessions for the men in service and for the coming of peace. Special prayer leaflets were issued and the women of the Auxiliary were asked to use them daily.

The relation of the Woman's Auxiliary to War Work has come as a problem not only to our Diocesan branch, but to the whole national society. After long deliberation a suggestion was presented to the April Officers' Conference in New York, which was earnestly considered and finally enthusiastically accepted by the representatives of about fifteen Dioceses there assembled. The plan is to mobilize the spiritual forces of the women of the Church. With the approval of our Bishops and clergy we are to undertake to train in each parish a band of women who shall be formally commissioned to do this work according to a definite plan which is being worked out. Our material and financial resources have been freely offered in this great crisis, but we feel that the Woman's Auxiliary has something far more precious to offer, and it is for this that we propose to enlist the women of the Church. When the final plan is presented to the Bishops and clergy of the Church we shall depend on their advice, their prayers and their co-operation.

Two of our officers have resigned during the year. Mrs. Augustus Trowbridge discovered a very few weeks after her election as Chairman of the Foreign Work that she would not be able to undertake the office on account of her duties at the Princeton Red Cross Headquarters which were constantly becoming more exacting and to which she was pledged before accepting the nomination of the Auxiliary. The Executive Committee elected Mrs. Samuel G. Welles to fill the vacancy and the work has prospered wonderfully in her hands.

Mrs. John N. Carpender has for years been our inspiration as Treasurer of the United Offering. Last October she found herself unable to bear the responsibility of the work any longer, and asked to be relieved of it. We deeply sympathize with her in her ill-health

and we earnestly hope for her recovery, but we cannot be too thankful that we had the great privilege of her services all these years. Wherever she went she brought a blessing, and the United Offering and Mrs. Carpender were synonymous to the women of the Diocese. The Board elected as her successor one whose whole heart has been in the work for a long time, and we feel that we can give her no greater praise than to say that Mrs. Shepherd is worthy to take up the work Mrs. Carpender has laid down.

Thanking God for the share we have been allowed to have in His work and looking forward with hope and faith to the future, we stand at the beginning of this new year of service, trusting that He will be with us and that we being ready both in body and soul may cheerfully accomplish those things which He commands.

REPORT OF THE UNITED OFFERING TREASURER

It is the great regret, I am sure, of every member of the Woman's Auxiliary of the Diocese that Mrs. John N. Carpender last Fall resigned her office as Diocesan Treasurer of the United Offering. Mrs. Carpender gave her indefatigable services to this work for many years and laid strong foundations—by her energy and efforts greatly increasing the offerings every triennium.

It was with much timidity that at the call of the Executive Com-

mittee of the Woman's Auxiliary I accepted the office of Dioecesan Treasurer of the United Offering until this annual meeting.

Since October I have visited the following Auxiliaries in the interest of the work: Christ Church, Elizabeth; St. Luke's Church, Metuchen; Church of the Good Shepherd, Pitman; Christ Church, South Amboy; St. Uriel's Church, Sea Girt; St. Michael's Church, Trenton; Trinity Church, Trenton; St. Paul's Church, Westfield, and St. Peter's Church, Woodbury Heights. I have also addressed the four Division Meetings held at Collingswood, Long Branch, Atlantic City and Elizabeth, and two District Meetings—the Trenton and Plainfield Districts.

I have distributed 350 Blue boxes and many leaflets.

Seventy-one Auxiliaries and some Juniors have sent offerings since October, 1916, making a total of \$4,315.68 received to date, and deposited in the Trenton Banking Company to the credit of the United Offering Fund, drawing three per cent. interest.

Only eight Auxiliaries who contributed during the last triennium have failed so far to send any gift, and some of these have promised to make a collection soon.

There are 90 Auxiliary Branches, and in eight or ten of these, so far as I can find out, have never contributed to the United Offering. These I want to reach, and also those Parishes and Missions where no Auxiliary has yet been formed. In these latter I would like to appoint someone to act as Treasurer of the United Offering who would try and interest the women of her Parish in this blessed work. This would also be an entering wedge for the formation of a Woman's Auxiliary Branch in that particular place. I would be glad to receive the name of any woman in any Parish where there is no Auxiliary, who might be interested in the United Offering and who would help me in reaching the women of that Parish.

I am making two definite suggestions to all of the Branches having United Offering Treasurers:

1. I am asking for a semi-annual offering from the Blue boxes and the return to me of this offering in March and September of each year. Wherever this method has been adopted the interest has been greatly increased, the luke-warm have been reminded of their duty and new givers have been secured.

2. I am suggesting that the presentation of this semi-annual offering be made at a Parochial Celebration of the Holy Communion with prayers and intercessions for the United Offering workers and for Missions. We find that this service emphasizes the spiritual character of the work which is most important, for if the women of the

Church once begin to pray for this work we are sure that there will be no limit to their gifts.

I hold myself in readiness to visit any Auxiliary or Parish or Mission where I am invited to present this subject, and I will be glad to send Blue boxes or leaflets whenever called upon by the Parish treasurers.

I acknowledge with gratefulness the splendid support I have received from the local treasurers of the United Offering, and ask a continuance of this help so that the coming eighteen months of the present triennium we may, as workers together, greatly increase the gift from the Diocese for the United Offering over the gift of 1916. Then the women of the Diocese gave \$8,181.50. We want to try and raise at least \$10,700. Let us hope for more!

REPORT OF EDUCATIONAL SECRETARY, APRIL, 1917-
MAY 14th, 1918

Our first effort on taking over the Educational Work of this Woman's Auxiliary was to endeavor to follow the good example of Massachusetts and begin a card index of the work of the various Parochial Branches in order to really know the amount and kind of educational work being accomplished in this Diocese. Miss Morewood began work on this card index during the Summer of 1917 and labored faithfully making the list of Parishes, etc. In the Fall we sent out a Questionnaire to each Parish Branch hoping in this way to gain information about what the Branches were planning to do for the Winter's work and also to let them know that the Educational Department was ready to help in any way it could. We also asked for the names and addresses of the Parish Educational Secretaries. Ninety-six of these Questionnaires were sent out. Twenty-one were returned with the questions answered, 14 returned with the blank space unfilled and notes of explanation accompanying them, while 61 were not answered in any way.

The Missionary Institute was held in Camden in St. Paul's Church on November 21st, 22d and 23d. The courses in Mission Study were given by Miss Tillotson for the Woman's Auxiliary, and Miss Schwartz, Miss Blatchford and Miss Stokes for the Junior Auxiliary, which held its Conference at the same time. Mrs. Phelps gave two Conferences on "Some Study-Class Problems" on the first afternoon of the session, and Dr. Elmendorf held three Conferences on the Church in Social Service. Mr. Lewis, of St. Mary's, Burlington, also gave three classes on the work of Diocesan Missions for the Sunday School teachers and members of the Junior Auxiliary. Twenty-three persons registered for all the classes and conferences.

All the Study-Class leaders whose names appeared on the list given us by the former Educational Secretary were asked to conduct classes

before the beginning of Lent. None of these failed to reply, even if it was impossible for some to take up the Study-Class work.

The last Questionnaire of the season was sent to all the Parishes in April asking the Branches to report on any educational activities they had carried on during the Winter. These were specified. Of the 96 sent out 46 were answered, 50 unanswered. From these most inadequate returns, less than half the Diocese, it appears that during the past year there have been held 12 Study-Classes with an attendance of 178 persons, 8 Reading-Circles, 92 Program Meetings and 35 Special Services. Eleven Auxiliaries have reported Parish Educational Secretaries. Weather and traffic conditions seriously interfered with Study-Class work. Some of our best classes were reduced in numbers and attendance by unavoidable conditions.

It may easily be seen from this report that as the Questionnaires have been answered by such a small proportion of the Parish Auxiliaries that it has been quite impossible to advance very far with our card index. We should like therefore for each delegate who is present to ask the Secretary of her Branch to send this information of the work of her Branch as soon as possible to Miss Agnes Morewood, 135 Westfield Avenue, Elizabeth, or to me. Miss Morewood would like to hand to her successor in office the beginnings at least of a systematic index. How important this is, any officer of the Auxiliary realizes. We must know the ground in order to begin to cultivate it properly. The Educational Work of the Auxiliary in the Diocese of New Jersey is in a rudimentary stage and it is vital to the life of this Auxiliary that the Educational Work shall be greatly extended in order to keep pace with the great need of the world. The need for intelligent Mission Study was never so great as now. Let us try to rise to this great occasion.

REPORT OF THE DIOCESAN WOMAN'S WAR COUNCIL

The Woman's War Council was organized by Bishop Matthews in January to act in connection with the Diocesan War Council to carry on such work as could best be forwarded by women. This refers to assistance in social and other forms of service at Camp Dix, Wissahickon Barracks, Camp Vail and Fort Hancock. The Committee has been in constant touch with Chaplain Flock at Camp Dix, and have had charge of certain details of management.

Mrs. A. S. Phelps was appointed Chairman of the Council; Mrs. F. W. Iredell, Secretary, and Mrs. J. S. Morgan, Treasurer. The work of the Council is apportioned among the following Committees: The Organization Committee, Mrs. Paul Matthews, Chairman, has in charge the enlargement of the membership of the Woman's War Council. The work is being energetically carried on and good results are being obtained. Twenty-one Parishes have each a local member of this Committee who are enlisting members.

The Equipment Committee, Mrs. Isaac Wheaton, Chairman, has

expended thus far \$734.24 in furnishings for St. George's Club House at Camp Dix.

The Calendar Committee, Mrs. George N. Tidd, Chairman, has arranged for a succession of workers in the Canteen at St. George's at Camp Dix. The selection of willing and suitable volunteers is a task requiring much tact and skill.

Miss Elsie Edwards was elected Chairman of the Committee on Girls, but owing to illness Mrs. S. M. Lewis, of the Girls' Friendly Society, is Chairman pro tem.

In connection with the Church Mission of Help we have a salaried worker who is doing excellent work in Monmouth County, and a second worker is greatly desired at, or near Camp Dix, and funds for the purpose are badly needed.

The Finance Committee, Chairman, Mrs. F. L. Katzenbach, Jr., has in charge the raising of funds for the Council. The work is going well but the needs are great, as the Council requires \$160 a month for salaried workers, besides its regular administration expenses.

The Monmouth County Committee is composed of the shore Parishes, which Mrs. W. D. Dale, Chairman, has grouped under this name, and has three objectives: First, To assist the Civilian Chaplain at Camp Vail and Fort Hancock; Second, The Soldiers' Recreation Work, and Third, The Girls and Women. The Committee have secured and equipped a Recreation House for Soldiers and Sailors at Highlands. The rent has been promised by one member of the Committee, and a monthly allowance assured by monthly contributions from the Monmouth County people. The house was opened early in June and is much appreciated by the men. The Executive Committee of the W. W. C. were lunching there recently and heard cheering outside. It proved to be a party of soldiers who were passing and cheering the Recreation House. "What's the matter with the Recreation House. She's all right." A spontaneous appreciation which was very pleasing. In regard to the Girls and Women, our trained worker, Mrs. Powell, has been in this vicinity some months, and will remain there for the Summer. She has won the confidence of the town officials and leading citizens, and is doing valuable protective work.

CONSTITUTION OF THE WOMAN'S AUXILIARY OF THE DIOCESE OF NEW JERSEY

ARTICLE I.—*Name.*

The name of this Society shall be, "THE NEW JERSEY BRANCH OF THE WOMAN'S AUXILIARY TO THE BOARD OF MISSIONS."

ARTICLE II.—*Object.*

The object of this Society is to interest all women in the general missionary work of the Church, to communicate missionary intelligence, and to secure increased contributions and prayers for the spread of the Gospel of Christ.

ARTICLE III.—*Officers.*

The officers of this Society shall be a President, two Vice-Presidents, one for the Upper and one for the Lower Division of the Diocese, a Recording Secretary, a Corresponding Secretary, a Treasurer, a United Offering Treasurer, an Educational Secretary, and a Chairman for each department of the work. The President, the two Vice-Presidents, the United Offering Treasurer, the Educational Secretary and the Chairmen shall be elected triennially to serve for a term of three years and shall not be eligible for more than two full consecutive terms.

At the election of 1918, the President, the Vice-Presidents and the Educational Secretary shall be elected for three years, four officers for two years, four for one year. At each succeeding election the four officers whose terms expire shall be elected for three years.

The Recording Secretary, the Corresponding Secretary and the Treasurer shall be appointed by the President for the duration of her term. The Diocesan Correspondent for the C. P. C. shall be appointed by the Bishop. The Secretary for the Spirit of Missions shall be appointed by the Educational Secretary.

ARTICLE IV.—*Executive Board.*

Seven members shall constitute a quorum. Vacancies on the Board shall be filled by appointment by the President for the unexpired term. No officer shall at any time hold more than one office.

ARTICLE V.—*Representation.*

Any parish organizing a branch of this Society shall notify both Recording and Corresponding Secretaries of the names and addresses of their officers, and shall make a report of their work to the Recording Secretary each year before the Annual Meeting.

ARTICLE VI.—*Amendments.*

The Constitution may be amended by a two-thirds vote at any Annual Meeting, when such amendments have previously been submitted in writing and approved by the Executive Board and read at both an Upper and Lower Division Meeting.

The By-Laws may be amended by a two-thirds vote at any Annual Meeting or at both an Upper and Lower Division Meeting.

BY-LAWS.

I. *Duties of Officers.*

1. The President shall preside at all meetings, have a general oversight of all branches of the work, and perform such other duties as usually appertain to that office.

2. The Vice-Presidents shall assist the President in arranging for and conducting meetings and in the absence of the President shall preside at meetings in their respective Divisions. They shall be responsible for the organization of the Districts in their Divisions.

3. A Chairman shall have charge of each of the Branches of Mission Work, respectively, Domestic, Foreign, Diocesan, Indian and Negro Missions, the Junior Auxiliary, Educational and Devotional Work; shall receive and forward all moneys contributed for the same, and make a full report to the Recording Secretary before the Annual Meeting.
4. The Recording Secretary shall call the roll at all meetings, prepare and read the Minutes, prepare the Annual Report, and perform all duties belonging to the office.
5. The Corresponding Secretary shall send to the Rectors, Diocesan Officers and Parochial Secretaries notices of each Division Meeting and to the Officers notices of Executive Board Meetings. She shall make an annual report of the same.
6. The Treasurer shall take charge of all moneys appropriated to the expenses of the Society and the Ten Cent Assessment Fund and collections at Diocesan Meetings.
7. The Treasurer of the United Offering shall take charge of all moneys contributed for that object.
8. The Educational Secretary shall have charge of Mission Study and of the Missionary Lending Library, which is for the use of all members of the Woman's Auxiliary in the Diocese.
9. The Chairman of the Devotional Committee shall make arrangements for Corporate Communions and the Days of Devotion for the Auxiliary throughout the Diocese.

II. *Vice-Chairmen.*

The Chairman of each department may appoint a Vice-Chairman or other assistant, who shall have a seat on the Executive Board.

III. *Meetings and Collections.*

The Annual Meeting of this Society shall be held in the Spring before the Diocesan Convention. There shall be meetings in the Upper and Lower Divisions in the Autumn and Winter to enable the officers to present their several branches of the work. The offerings at the Division Meetings shall be used for missionary purposes at the discretion of the President and two other officers.

IV. *Finances.*

The finances of this Society shall be administered by a Committee consisting of five members of the Board to be elected by the Executive Board, the President and Treasurer being members *ex officio*. This Committee shall each year prepare a budget of the expenses of the Society covering all pledges and expenses and submit the same at the Annual Meeting for the approval of the delegates. The adoption of the budget shall be by ballot.

Every member of each Parish Branch shall pay annually ten cents to the Branch Treasurer, who shall forward these dues to the Diocesan Treasurer of the Woman's Auxiliary.
