REPORT OF SECRETARY.

The Eighteenth Annual Meeting of the Newark Branch of the Woman's Auxiliary was held in Trinity Church, Newark, on Wednesday, Nov. 2d, at 10.30. The Holy Communion was celebrated by Bishop Starkey, assisted by Rev. Louis S. Osborne, Rector of the Church. There were in the Chancel Bishop Brewer, of Montana and Bishop Leonard, of Utah, Archdeacon Jenvey and Rev. M. M. Fothergill, of the Church of the Atonement, Tenafly. After the Service, Bishop Starkey announced the addition of five Missionary Bishops over new jurisdictions. Bishop Brewer was the first speaker. He called to the remembrance of those present that this was the twenty-first Anniversary of the Auxiliary, and gave an account of the Branch in his Diocese, and also of the work done among the Chinese. Bishop Leonard, of Utah and Nevada was the next speaker. He told of two branches of the Auxiliary in his Diocese, both flourishing. He appealed for money for scholarships, money to help pay the stipends of the Missionaries, and for the support of the Hospital in his charge. All present were then invited to lunch in the Trinity rooms, where an hour or more was spent in social intercourse. The Auxiliary re-assembled in the Church, and Bishop Starkey called the meeting to order and introduced Bishop Talbot, of Wyoming and Idaho, who made a lengthy address holding the attention of his audience by a simple narration of his work and varied experiences. Archdeacon Walker made the closing address in behalf of Diocesan Missions. A Hymn and the Benediction closed one of the largest and most successful meetings ever held by the Auxiliary in Newark.

Scholarship in St. Paul's School, Yankton, So. Da., \$60.00; toward Miss Ives' salary, St. Mary's School, So. Da., \$50.00; organ for St. Elizabeth's school, \$65.00; to Rev. J. Roberts, for mission work, Shoshone, Wyoming, \$10.00; total, \$427.35.

The summary of the work done in the past year shows no diminution in the offerings, but on the contrary, an increase of over \$800.00, which is most encouraging. The same Scholarships have been supported, the contributions to the support of the same Missionaries have been given, viz.: Miss Wheeler at the South, Miss Ives in the West, and the Bible Readers in Japan. Several of the Parishes have reported new Scholarships supported by the Parish or individuals therein. Christ Church, Newark, and St. Andrew's Church, Orange, have been added to our list. It is noticeable that the latter has begun its Missionary work immediately after its incorporation as a Parish, before the completion of its church edifice, which is a rare instance and worthy of being made an example. The Comfort Club was formed at the last meeting of the Auxiliary, in May. Its work consists of the payment of twenty-five cents and the contribution of two articles or

garments which may be used as a supplement in the packing of boxes, a mite from the individual, but a considerable sum in the aggregate. At the last meeting of the Auxiliary in Baltimore the offering amounted to \$20,353.16, and was devoted to the increase of the Enrolment Fund. At the meeting of the Diocesan officers in Baltimore, 1892, it was resolved to place before the Auxiliary as the object of the United Offering to be made at the Triennial Meeting of 1895, the Endowment of the Episcopate in a Missionary jurisdiction, the jurisdiction to be selected by the Board of Missions, to which end mite boxes will be supplied to all who ask for them from the Bible House, and it is suggested :

1. That each Diocesan Officer take and use one of these boxes herself.
2. That the Officers of each Division Branch urge every Parish Officer to take a box.
3. That every person who takes a box find some other person not already actively engaged in the work of the Auxiliary and persuade her to take a box.

The Secretary informs us that one devout Churchwoman has already contributed \$1,000 to the Fund. Though very few are able to make such offerings as this, let each do according to her ability, knowing that is all which is required of any, and sure that a blessing will come with it. We enter upon our work in a season of extraordinary doubt and depression in financial circles which may tell upon many, but it is hoped that those who are laboring in God's vineyard, either at home or abroad, may not be forgotten, that the small stipend of the Missionary will be remembered, the lack of which means to him the absence of comfort, and not the cutting off of luxury. Shall we not recognize in their support a sacred trust which must be lovingly and faithfully fulfilled, esteeming it a privilege rather than a duty to minister unto their needs who go forth bravely to endure hardship because "the love of God constraineth them?"

CONSTITUTION *

OF THE

Newark Branch of the Woman's Auxiliary.

ARTICLE I. This Society shall be called the NEWARK BRANCH OF THE WOMAN'S AUXILIARY. Its object shall be to work in connection with the "Woman's Auxiliary to the Board of Missions."

ARTICLE II. Any woman may become a member by paying an annual fee of \$1.00; an Associate Member by paying \$5.00 annually, and a Life Member by the single payment of \$25.00. All members shall be entitled to vote.

ARTICLE III. The officers of this Association shall be President, Vice-President, Secretary, Corresponding Secretary, and Treasurer, who, with the Directresses, shall constitute the Board of Managers, whose duties shall be specified in the By-Laws.

ARTICLE IV. This Constitution shall not be altered except at an Annual Meeting, notice of proposed alteration having been given in writing at a stated meeting at least one month before the Annual Meeting.

BY-LAWS.

I.—DUTIES OF OFFICERS.

It shall be the duty of the President to preside at all meetings of the Association and Board of Managers, to call special meetings, to arrange for the organization of new Parochial Branches, and to have a general supervision of the work.

In the absence of the President, her duties shall devolve on the Vice-President, who shall call special meetings of the Association and Board of Managers only when requested to do so by the President or five members of the latter body.

It shall be the duty of the Secretary to keep the minutes of the proceedings of the Association and Board of Managers, to send out notices of stated and special meetings of the same, and to prepare an Annual Report.

It shall be the duty of the Corresponding Secretary to conduct the correspondence of the Association and Board of Managers, to keep a list of the clergy of the Diocese and Parish Secretaries, with their addresses, which list shall be printed in the Annual Report. She shall receive from each Parish Branch by May 15th a full report of the year's work, to be inserted in the Annual Report.

It shall be the duty of the Treasurer to receive and keep all money contributed, to present a monthly report of all receipts and disbursements, and also balance on hand subject to order of the Association. She shall disburse all money given for specified purposes on order of the Directress to whose department of work it belongs, and all other money as directed by the Association.

She shall present a detailed report, to be incorporated in the Annual Report.

It shall be her duty to notify Parish Branches, or delegates who have not paid their annual dues by Jan. 1st, and request payment of the same.

II.—MEETINGS.

There shall be a meeting of the Association the first Wednesday of each month excepting June, July, August and September, hour and place to be determined by the Board of Managers.

The Monthly Meeting in May shall be the Annual Meeting for the election of officers.

In addition to the Monthly and Annual Meetings there shall be in the Fall of the year a Public Missionary Meeting, with addresses, at which time a collection shall be made for such Mission Work as shall be announced.

Special meetings shall be called by the President at the request of a majority of the Board of Managers.

The Board of Managers shall hold at least three meetings during the year, one to be held before the first meeting of the Association in October.

At all meetings of the Board of Managers six shall constitute a quorum.

III.—DIRECTRESSES.

There shall be elected at each Annual Meeting a Directress for each of the departments of work, viz.: Diocesan, Foreign, Domestic, Colored, Indian, Mexican, Church Periodical Society, and The Comfort Club.

It shall be the duty of each Directress to give all the information in her power concerning her department of work, in order to arouse the Parochial Branches to such efforts as may result in larger and more systematic gifts of time and money, and more earnest and united prayers for the work of the Auxiliary.

At the Monthly Meetings each Directress shall give to the Treasurer the money collected by her (except what is intended for immediate use), and receive a receipt for the same; which money the Treasurer shall pay on order of the Directress towards the object for which it was contributed.

IV.—ELECTION OF OFFICERS.

The election of officers shall take place at the Annual Meeting in May. Election shall be by ballot, but balloting may be dispensed with by unanimous consent.

Nominations may be made in writing and handed to the Secretary. All officers shall continue in office for one year, or until their successors are elected.

In case of vacancy in any office by death or removal of its occupant, the same may be filled at any meeting of the Association, and any one so elected shall continue in office until the next Annual Meeting.

V.—COMMITTEES.

A committee of two shall be appointed at the Annual Meeting to audit the accounts of the Treasurer, and certify to their correctness.

All committees shall be appointed by the President.

VI.—PARISH BRANCHES.

Any Parish may become a member of this Branch of the Auxiliary by the payment of an annual assessment of \$2.00 and an annual fee or \$1.00 for each Delegate. A Parish may send any number of Delegates it desires, and each Delegate shall be entitled to vote.

The officers of the Parish Branches will correspond with the Directress of the department of work in which they wish to engage, and not with the General Secretary of the Woman's Auxiliary. Before January first of each year they shall send to the Treasurer all the Membership Fees and Parish Assessments, and shall give to the several Directresses the money contributed for the various departments of work.

The Branches are desired to have their election of officers in the Spring, in order that by May 15th they may be able to furnish the Corresponding Secretary with the name and address of the Secretary of the Parish Branch and the Delegates for the ensuing year, to be inserted in the Annual Report.

At the same time they shall send to the Corresponding Secretary a detailed report of the year's work, consisting of the number and value of boxes sent, with their destination, and the amount of money, with the objects for which it was contributed, including the Parish Assessment and Delegates' Fees.

No contributions towards Diocesan or local Institutions are to be reported through this Branch of the Woman's Auxiliary.

ALTERATIONS.

These By-Laws may be altered at any meeting of the Association by a majority vote of members present, provided notice of the alteration has been given in writing at a previous meeting.
