## REPORT OF SECRETARY.

---

The Nineteenth Annual Meeting of the Diocese of Newark Woman's Branch of Auxiliary was held in Trinity Church, Newark, on Wednesday, November 8th, at 10.30. The Holy Communion was celebrated by the Bishop of the Diocese, assisted by the Rev. L. S. Osborne, Rector of the parish. Rev. M. M. Fothergill, Archdeacon Jenvey and Rev. J. Kellar in the chancel. Bishop Starkey made a short address of welcome and congratulation, and then introduced the Rt. Rev. Dr. Ferguson, of Cape Palmas, Africa, who gave a history of the Missions of the Church in Africa, stated his most pressing wants, and asked for help in prosecuting his work. The offertory, amounting to \$47.40, was given to this object. The Rev. Dr. Osborne having been called upon by the Bishop made a very forcible and eloquent impromptu address upon General Missionary Work. At 1 o'clock lunch was served in the Parish House to which all were invited. An hour was spent thus and in social intercourse.

The afternoon session opened at 2 o'clock. Bishop Talbot, of Wyoming and Idaho, was the first speaker. He asked for both men and money; men of talent and education to consecrate their lives to the work; money to build churches and schools and to support scholarships and Missionaries, his vast Diocese embracing Indians as well as whites. Rev. J. W. Chapman, from Anwick, Alaska, was the next speaker. His field, he said, was trying from its remoteness, the rigor of the climate and its isolation, as well as from the repulsive nature of the habits and mode of life of the inhabitants. Men for the work and money for schools was the burden of his appeal. Rev. Dr. Langford, Secretary of the Board of Missions, was expected but did not arrive. Rev. C. B. Wilmer, of Lynchburg, Va., spoke of his work for the colored people, his Orphan Asylum and Industrial School at Lynchburg being his special ap-

peal. Bishop Starkey, for the members of the Auxiliary, thanked Trinity Parish for their hospitality. After prayer and benediction the meeting adjourned. The congregation was large and attentive, forty of the clergy being present, and all the parishes connected with the Auxiliary well represented by their delegates. The amount reported the last year was \$800 in excess of any preceding year, the sum being \$13,292.43.

The Advisory Committee  
OF THE  
NEWARK BRANCH OF THE JUNIOR AUXILIARY  
TO THE  
Clergy of the Diocese.

At its annual meeting in May, 1894, the Woman's Auxiliary of this Diocese voted to include in its work the Junior Department of the Auxiliary, and recommended the organizing of parochial branches and the binding together of existing children's missionary societies under this head. At the end of three years twenty-one parishes report Junior Branches, of which the gifts of boxes and money to Missions in the year 1896-97 amount to \$1721.57. It is a result for which we should be and are deeply grateful.

But it is not to speak of what has been done that the Advisory Committee begs leave to address the Clergy of the Diocese.

At the General Convention of 1892 the Board of Missions reported as follows: "The Junior Department of the Auxiliary has already become in parts of the Church, a distinct power in the training of the young in knowledge of and interest in missions. We are glad to know that in its practical work the Junior Auxiliary lays especial stress upon the cultivation of three good habits—the habit of Prayer for Missions, the habit of Study of Missions, and the habit of Giving to Missions." The Constitution of the Newark Branch of the Junior Auxiliary states the object of the Society to be "to increase missionary knowledge, interest and helpfulness among the children of the Diocese, and to make

all young people realize their responsibility as members by Baptism of the Missionary Society—the Church."

Practical experience in the conduct of the parochial branches has made the Junior workers realize that it is extremely difficult, not to say impossible, to accomplish the end aimed at by the Junior Auxiliary by present existing methods.

The ideal Junior Auxiliary, it is conceded, is the Missionary Sunday School. Just as the General or Diocesan Convention resolves itself at certain times into the Board of Missions, so the Sunday School may become a branch of the Junior Auxiliary, and, once a month or once in two months, instead of the regular lesson for the day, some missionary jurisdiction or some other missionary subject may be presented by one of the classes to the whole school. This method is pursued in several Dioceses with gratifying success. Why should it not be adopted in the Diocese of Newark?

In the General Convention of 1895, the Committee on the Woman's Auxiliary, referring to the Junior Department, said, "In some Dioceses many of the Sunday Schools have been organized as a whole into a branch of the Junior Auxiliary. This method has worked well, and is very successful in awakening interest in missions throughout the school. In the opinion of your Committee, the Junior Auxiliary is a most valuable agency for implanting and developing an interest in missions in the minds of the young, and we cordially recommend its organization in every congregation."

The Advisory Committee respectfully begs the earnest consideration of this subject on the part of the Clergy, with a view to introducing such a branch of the Junior Auxiliary into each parish, thereby providing for the missionary education of our young people. If this method should not seem feasible, that adopted in St. Luke's Parish, Montclair, might be chosen. In this Parish the Junior Auxiliary has a missionary meeting apart from the Sunday School on one Sunday of the month, in which the same course is followed as suggested for the Missionary Sunday School.

Sunday School Superintendents and Teachers will find ample

material for the preparation and conduct of these meetings in leaflets at the Church Missions House.

When such a branch of the Junior Auxiliary is formed, notice of its organization should be sent to the Diocesan Secretary of the Junior Auxiliary, Mrs. E. V. Z. Lane, 115 Harrison Street, East Orange, together with the names of the delegates who have been chosen and whose duty shall be to attend the quarterly meetings of the Diocesan Society.

The Rectors of St. John's Church, Jersey City Heights; St. Paul's Church, Hoboken, (Archdeacon of Jersey City); Christ Church, Bloomfield; St. Mark's Church, Orange; Calvary Church, Summit; Trinity Church, Newark; St. Stephen's Church, Newark; St. John's Church, Passaic; Church of the Atonement, Tenafly, have promised to give this suggested plan a fair trial. With the successful experience of other Dioceses to encourage us, and in the belief that if the Junior Auxiliary is to attain the object for which it was formed, it must have a recognized place in Church work, the Advisory Committee have ventured to address the Clergy.


hardly say that such an effort, wisely made, has had from the first my support and best wishes for its success.
