## REPORT OF SECRETARY.

The Secretary feels that in presenting this Twentieth Report of the Woman's Auxiliary of the Diocese of Newark, she has little that is new to note. The work done has been upon the old and tested lines. Our meetings have been held regularly, and our ranks have been mercifully blessed, in being almost the same as last year. Our report begins as usual with the notice of the Annual Meeting on the first Wednesday of November, in St. Luke's Church, Montclair, where we were privileged to hear Bishop Gilbert, of Minnesota, Bishop Penick and Bishop Gailor of Tennessee, together with Mrs. Twing, the Honorary Secretary and Miss Emery. I think that the benefit of attending such meetings and listening to the stirring appeals of these laborers in the missionary fields, could scarcely be more emphasized than by the fact that one member of our Auxiliary Branch, hearing the Assistant Bishop of Minnesota tell of the touching need of an Indian station, was moved to give a check so generously

large as to cover the expenses of that work for a year. The hospitality received at the hands of the good people of St. Luke's, the beautiful new church and parish rooms, will long be remembered by those who were present. The Secretary would suggest that each active member of our Auxiliary should make it part of her business to bring one other person to these meetings during the coming year, as a means of increasing our work. We greatly need individual personal effort to multiply the channels of doing good.

We are glad to record the first Report of the Junior Auxiliary, and its showing of work already accomplished is happy augury for its future. Nothing can be more important than the proper and systematic training of the young, to take the places of those who may fall by the way.

It will be observed that by an alteration of the By-laws, an Appendix has been added to this year's report, containing the amount of strictly Church Work of Women, in connection with charitable institutions. The subject of the United Offering has received an unusual amount of attention throughout the past year. It is a source of gratitude that so goodly a sum has gone out from our Diocese towards this object of endowing a permanent Episcopate for some Missionary Jurisdiction.

Our branch of the Woman's Auxiliary was gladdened by the addition to its membership of the Parish of Saint Peter's, Morristown, with its large list of delegates. They are most cordially welcomed. By the alteration of By-Law in the Constitution, which was amended by a majority vote, it will be seen than an Appendix has been added to our report of work done by women on strictly Church lines, in charitable Institutions in the Diocese. Praying that the coming year may be one of greater usefulness, and larger growth in our several departments, and above all asking the prayers of each member for increased spirituality, earnestness of purpose and personal consecration, the Secretary respectfully submits her report.

THE HOUSE OF THE GOOD SHEPHERD.

---

This home for aged and infirm persons is carried on by the united efforts of most of the parishes in the Oranges. The sources of income are: Charges for care of inmates, paid either by friends of inmates or by parishes; gifts of money or supplies, and some regular monthly contribution paid within a parish to a parish treasurer. At present every room is occupied, making a family of twenty persons whose every necessity is provided for by the management. The Purchasing Committee during the year expended the sum of \$2,764.98 for the general running expenses of the house. Besides this, bills for coal, repairs,

etc. are met directly by the Treasurer. If it were not for gifts of pound packages at Christmastide by the church Sunday schools, of canned fruits, pickles, etc., from the store closet, from the the parishes, in November, and of fresh fruits and vegetables during the summer, the money in the hands of the Treasurer would be entirely inadequate for the needs of the old people. By timely help, the management has been able to give comfort and rest to many a weary one and looks with confidence to the friends of the old and helpless for ability to continue their work.

## CONSTITUTION.\*

OF THE

## Newark Branch of the Woman's Auxiliary.

---

ARTICLE I. This Society shall be called the NEWARK BRANCH OF THE WOMAN'S AUXILIARY. Its object shall be to work in connection with the "Woman's Auxiliary to the Board of Missions."

ARTICLE II. Any woman may become a member by paying an annual fee of \$1.00; an Associate Member by paying \$5.00 annually, and a Life Member by the single payment of \$25.00. All members shall be entitled to vote.

ARTICLE III. The officers of this Association shall be President, Vice-President, Secretary, Corresponding Secretary, and Treasurer, who, with the Directresses, shall constitute the Board of Managers, whose duties shall be specified in the By-Laws.

ARTICLE IV. This Constitution shall not be altered except at an Annual Meeting, notice of proposed alteration having been given in writing at a stated meeting at least one month before the Annual Meeting.

## BY-LAWS.

---

### I.—DUTIES OF OFFICERS.

It shall be the duty of the President to preside at all meetings of the Association and Board of Managers, to call special meetings, to arrange for the organization of new Parochial Branches, and to have a general supervision of the work.

In the absence of the President her duties shall devolve on the Vice-President, who shall call special meetings of the Association and Board of Managers only when requested to do so by the President or five members of the latter body.

It shall be the duty of the Secretary to keep the minutes of the proceedings of the Association and Board of Managers, to send out notices of stated and special meetings of the same, and to prepare an Annual Report.

It shall be the duty of the Corresponding Secretary to conduct the correspondence of the Association and Board of Managers, to keep a list of the clergy of the Diocese and Parish Secretaries, with their addresses, which list shall be printed in the Annual Report. She shall receive from each Parish Branch by May 15th a full report of the year's work, to be inserted in the Annual Report.

It shall be the duty of the Treasurer to receive and keep all money contributed, to present a monthly report of all receipts and disbursements, and also balance on hand subjected to order of the Association. She shall disburse all money given for specified purposes on order of the Directress to whose department of work it belongs, and all other money as directed by the Association.

She shall present a detailed report, to be incorporated in the Annual Report.

It shall be her duty to notify Parish Branches, or delegates who have not paid their annual dues by January 1st, and request payment of the same.

### II.—MEETINGS.

There shall be a meeting of the Association the first Wednesday of each month excepting June, July, August and September, hour and place to be determined by the Board of Managers.

The Monthly Meeting in May shall be the Annual Meeting for the election of officers.

In addition to the Monthly and Annual Meetings there shall be in the Fall of the year a Public Missionary Meeting, with addresses, at which time a collection shall be made for such Mission Work as shall be announced.

Special meetings shall be called by the President at the request of a majority of the Board of Managers.

At all meetings of the Board of Managers six shall constitute a quorum.

### III.—DIRECTRESSES.

There shall be elected at each Annual Meeting a Directress for each of the departments of work, viz.: Diocesan, Foreign, Domestic, Colored, Indian, Mexican, Church Periodical Society and The Comfort Club.

It shall be the duty of each Directress to give all the information in her power concerning her department of work, in order to arouse the Parochial Branches to such efforts as may result in larger and more systematic gifts of time and money, and more earnest and united prayers for the work of the Auxiliary.

At the Monthly Meetings each Directress shall give to the Treasurer the money collected by her (except what is intended for immediate use), and receive a receipt for the same; which money the Treasurer shall pay on order of the Directress towards the object for which it was contributed.

### IV.—ELECTION OF OFFICERS.

The election of officers shall take place at the Annual Meeting in May. Election shall be by ballot, but balloting may be dispensed with by unanimous consent.

Nominations may be made in writing and handed to the Secretary. All officers shall continue in office for one year, or until their successors are elected.

In case of vacancy in any office, by death or removal of its occupant, the same may be filled at any meeting of the Association, and any one so elected shall continue in office until the next Annual Meeting.

### V.—COMMITTEES.

A committee of two shall be appointed at the Annual Meeting to audit the accounts of the Treasurer and certify to their correctness.

All committees shall be appointed by the President.

### VI.—PARISH BRANCHES.

Any Parish may become a member of this Branch of the Auxiliary by the payment of an annual assessment of \$2.00 and an annual fee of \$1.00 for each Delegate. A Parish may send any number of Delegates it desires, and each Delegate shall be entitled to vote.

The officers of the Parish Branches will correspond with the Directress of the department of work in which they wish to engage, and not with the General Secretary of the Woman's Auxiliary. Before January first of each year they shall send to the Treasurer all the

Membership Fees and Parish Assessments, and shall give to the seven Directresses the money contributed for the various departments of work.

The Branches are desired to have their election of officers in the spring in order that by May 15th they may be able to furnish the Corresponding Secretary with the name and address of the Secretary of the Parish Branch Annual and the Delegates for the ensuing year, to be inserted in the Annual Report.

At the same time they shall send to the Corresponding Secretary a detailed report of the year's work, consisting of the number and value of boxes sent, with their destination, and the amount of money, with the objects for which it was contributed, including the Parish Assessment and Delegates' Fees.

Contributions towards Diocesan or local Institutions are to be reported through this Branch of the Woman's Auxiliary on strictly Church lines.
