SECRETARY'S REPORT.

The Secretary comes before the members of the Auxiliary in her report for the year '96 and '97 with a feeling of regret that more progress and larger gifts are not to be noted. Thirty-one dollars less in the total than that of last year, but if carefully examined it will be found that more has been done for the Diocesan Missions and less for both Colored and Domestic. The number of parishes represented is not increased as it ought to be. The average attendance of members is just about the same. May we not hope that with the revival of business prosperity our branch of work may find itself both able and willing to do a great deal more in the coming year? Surely if we could realize individually our responsibility in this matter of Missions the report of the deficit, which comes to us so often from the Board of Missions, need never be made. The last appeal of our much loved and deeply mourned General Secretary ought to inspire us with greater zeal and urge us to more earnest effort.

Our report begins as usual with the minutes of the annual meeting, held in St. Paul's Church, Englewood, on Wednesday, November 4th. Holy Communion was celebrated by the Bishop of the Diocese, assisted by the Rector, the Rev. Mr. Flichtner and the Rev. William Hughes, of Morristown. There was a most gratifying attendance of the clergy and the members of the Auxiliary. The cordial welcome of the Bishop, together with his words of appreciation of the work of the Auxiliary, were an inspiring commencement of the occasion. He regretted his failure to secure any Bishops from the missionary fields, and the absence of Bishop Holly, of Hayti, who was expected, was apologized for. The Rev. Dr. Hughes gave an

admirable address upon Missions. He was followed by the Rev. Mr. Flichtner, who spoke particularly of Mexican Missions. He gave a full and most interesting account of the work in Mexico and begged that some to whom he spoke might be moved to pay the very small salary of one of those devoted priests, who are laboring there under such unusual difficulties.

An adjournment was made for luncheon, which was served in the new parish house, where every arrangement was made for the refreshment of the guests. A vote of thanks to the ladies of the Parish was offered and accepted and all present seemed to be glad that they had made a special effort to be there. In the afternoon the Bishop asked the Rev. Mr. Christian to tell something of what had been done at the late Missionary Council. He was followed by the Rev. Mr. Hills, of Westchester, who spoke in the interests of the Junior Auxiliary, giving a most instructive account of his methods concerning it in his own parish. The benediction pronounced by the Bishop closed the exercises of a most successful day.

CONSTITUTION
OF THE
JUNIOR DEPARTMENT
OF THE

Newark Branch of the Woman's Auxiliary to the
Board of Missions.

ARTICLE I.—AUTHORITY AND NAME.

Authorized by the Woman's Auxiliary of the Diocese of Newark, this Society shall be the Junior Department of the Newark Branch of the Woman's Auxiliary to the Board of Missions.

ARTICLE II.—OBJECT.

The object of the Junior Department shall be to increase missionary knowledge, interest and helpfulness among the children and young people of the Diocese, to train the girls to become intelligent and useful members of the Woman's Auxiliary and to make all young people realize their responsibilities as members by baptism of the Missionary Society—the Church.

ARTICLE III.—MEMBERS.

All Sunday-schools and societies of young people which report annually money given or work done for other than parish needs may be members of this society.

ARTICLE IV.—OFFICERS.

The officers of the Junior Department shall be a Directress, a Second Directress, a Secretary a Treasurer and a Secretary of the Babies' Branch.

ARTICLE V.—AMENDMENTS.

This Constitution may be altered or amended, with the consent of the Newark Branch of the Woman's Auxiliary, only at an annual meeting, and when notice of proposed alteration or amendment has been given at a preceding regular meeting.

BY-LAWS.

I.—DUTIES OF OFFICERS.

It shall be the duty of the Directress to preside at all meetings of the Junior Department and Advisory Committee, and represent the Junior Department in the Board of Managers of the Woman's Auxiliary. In the absence of the Directress her duties shall devolve on the Second Directress.

It shall be the duty of the Secretary to send out notices of meetings and keep minutes of same; to carry on the correspondence relating to the work of the Parochial Branches and to make an annual report to the Newark Branch of the Woman's Auxiliary.

It shall be the duty of the Treasurer to receive and disburse all money given either to meet the expenses of the society or for Missions, also to make an annual report of the same to the Newark Branch of the Woman's Auxiliary. She shall include in her annual report an account of the sums which have been reported to her by Parochial Treasurers as sent direct to the General Missionary Treasury or to the Mission field.

It shall be the duty of the Secretary of the Babies' Branch to enroll the babies of the Diocese upon their baptism, whose names shall be sent to her for that purpose, to furnish boxes and books to the members of the Babies' Branch, to receive and disburse the returns and make an annual report to the Treasurer of the Junior Department.

II.—MEETINGS.

With the consent of the Rector of the Parish, the meetings of the Junior Department shall be held in different parishes of the Diocese on the third Saturday of the months of October, January, April and May. The meeting in April shall be a public missionary meeting with addresses to which all the Sunday Schools and young people of the Diocese shall be invited. The meeting in May shall be the annual meeting for the election of officers.

III.—ELECTION OF OFFICERS.

With the exception of the Directress, who shall be appointed by the Newark Branch of the Woman's Auxiliary, the officers of the Junior Department shall be elected at the annual meeting in May. Election shall be by ballot, but balloting may be dispensed with by unanimous consent. All officers shall continue in office for one year, or until their successors are elected. In case of vacancy in any office, caused by resignation or death, the same shall be filled at any meeting of the Advisory Committee, and any one so appointed shall continue in office until the next annual meeting.

IV.—COMMITTEES.

An Advisory Committee, consisting of four members from each Archdeaconry of the Diocese, shall be appointed, who, together with the officers already named, shall plan to increase the number of parochial branches and of individual members of the Junior Department, and by visiting and distributing missionary information to increase interest in Missions.

The Board of Managers of the Newark Branch of the Woman's Auxiliary shall be regarded, *ex-officio*, as members of the Advisory Committee, but they shall be exempt from all rules of the Committee.

All Committees shall be appointed by the Directress.

V.—PAROCHIAL BRANCHES.

Any parochial branch may become a member of this Society by the payment of an annual assessment of fifty cents (\$.50) and an annual fee of twenty-five cents (\$.25) for each delegate. A parochial branch may send any number of delegates. Delegates and Parish officers shall be entitled to a vote.

VI.—QUORUM.

At all regular meetings of the Junior Department seven shall constitute a quorum. At all meetings of the Advisory Committee five shall constitute a quorum.

CONSTITUTION.*

OF THE

Newark Branch of the Woman's Auxiliary.

ARTICLE I. This Society shall be called the NEWARK BRANCH OF THE WOMAN'S AUXILIARY. Its object shall be to work in connection with the "Woman's Auxiliary to the Board of Missions."

ARTICLE II. Any woman may become a member by paying an annual fee of \$1.00; an Associate Member by paying \$5.00 annually, and a Life Member by the single payment of \$25.00. All members shall be entitled to vote.

ARTICLE III. The officers of this Association shall be President, Vice-President, Secretary, Corresponding Secretary, and Treasurer, who, with the Directresses, shall constitute the Board of Managers, whose duties shall be specified in the By-Laws.

ARTICLE IV. This constitution shall not be altered except at an Annual Meeting, notice of proposed alteration having been given in writing at a stated meeting at least one month before the Annual Meeting.

BY-LAWS.

I.—DUTIES OF OFFICERS.

It shall be the duty of the President to preside at all meetings of the Association and Board of Managers, to call special meetings, to arrange for the organization of new Parochial Branches and to have a general supervision of the work.

In the absence of the President her duties shall devolve on the Vice-President, who shall call special meetings of the Association and Board of Managers only when requested to do so by the President or five members of the latter body.

It shall be the duty of the Secretary to keep the minutes of the proceedings of the Association and Board of Managers, to send out notices of stated and special meetings of the same and to prepare an Annual Report.

It shall be the duty of the Corresponding Secretary to conduct the correspondence of the Association and Board of Managers, to keep a list of the clergy of the Diocese and Parish Secretaries, with their addresses, which list shall be printed in the Annual Report. She shall receive from each Parish Branch by May 15th a full report of the year's work, to be inserted in the Annual Report.

It shall be the duty of the Treasurer to receive and keep all money contributed, to present a monthly report of all receipts and disbursements, and also balance on hand subject to order of the Association. She shall disburse all money given for specified purposes on order of the Directress to whose department of work it belongs, and all other money as directed by the Association.

She shall present a detailed report, to be incorporated in the Annual Report.

It shall be her duty to notify Parish Branches, or delegates who have not paid their annual dues by January 1st, and request payment of the same.

II.—MEETINGS.

There shall be a meeting of the Association the first Wednesday of each month excepting June, July, August and September, hour and place to be determined by the Board of Managers.

The Monthly Meeting in May shall be the Annual Meeting for the election of officers.

In addition to the Monthly and Annual Meetings there shall be in the Fall of the year a Public Missionary Meeting, with addresses, at which time a collection shall be made for such Mission Work as shall be announced.

Special meetings shall be called by the President at the request of a majority of the Board of Managers.

At all meetings of the Board of Managers six shall constitute a quorum.

III.—DIRECTRESSES.

There shall be elected at each Annual Meeting a Directress for each of the departments of work, viz.: Diocesan, Foreign, Domestic, Colored, Indian, Mexican, Church Periodical Society, Comfort Club and Junior Auxiliary.

It shall be the duty of each Directress to give all the information in her power concerning her department of work, in order to arouse the Parochial Branches of such efforts as may result in large and more systematic gifts of time and money, and more earnest and united prayers for the work of the Auxiliary.

At the Monthly Meetings each Directress shall give to the Treasurer the money collected by her (except what is intended for immediate use), and receive a receipt for the same; which money the Treasurer shall pay on order of the Directress toward the object for which it was contributed.

IV.—ELECTION OF OFFICERS.

The election of officers shall take place at the Annual Meeting in May. Election shall be by ballot, but balloting may be dispensed with by unanimous consent.

Nominations may be made in writing and handed to the Secretary. All officers shall continue in office for one year, or until their successors are elected.

In case of vacancy in any office, by death or removal of its occupant, the same may be filled at any meeting of the Association, and any one so elected shall continue in office until the next Annual Meeting.

V.—COMMITTEE.

A committee of two shall be appointed at the Annual Meeting to audit the accounts of the Treasurer and certify to their correctness.

All committees shall be appointed by the President.

VI.—PARISH BRANCHES.

Any Parish may become a member of this Branch of the Auxiliary by the payment of an annual assessment of \$2.00 and an annual fee of \$1.00 for each Delegate. A Parish may send any number of Delegates it desires, and each Delegate shall be entitled to vote.

The officers of the Parish Branches will correspond with the Directress of the department of work in which they wish to engage, and not with the General Secretary of the Woman's Auxiliary. Before January first of each year they shall send to the Treasurer all the Membership Fees and Parish Assessments, and shall give to the several Directresses the money contributed for the various departments of work.

The Branches are desired to have their election of officers in the Spring in order that by May 15th they may be able to furnish the Corresponding Secretary with the name and address of the Secretary of the Parish Branch Annual and the Delegates for the ensuing year, to be inserted in the Annual Report.

At the same time they shall send to the Corresponding Secretary a detailed report of the year's work, consisting of the number and value of boxes sent, with their destination, and the amount of money, with the objects for which it was contributed, including the Parish Assessment and Delegates' Fees.

Contributions toward Diocesan or local Institutions are to be reported through this Branch of the Woman's Auxiliary on strictly Church lines.
