HINTS TO PAROCHIAL OFFICERS.

Impress upon the women of your parish that they are, by virtue of their baptism, members of the Woman's Auxiliary. Urge them to recognize this claim by working along the appointed lines and giving such dues as your parish branch may settle upon.

Every branch is expected to give to the Apportionment Fund and the United Offering and to do its share of any work planned by Diocesan Officers.

Take *The Oregon Churchman* and read to your branch the Auxiliary page, which is the official organ of the Auxiliary. Keep ready for reference the last report of your diocesan branch, Miss Emery's last report and the "Spirit of Missions."

When you begin a box advise the recipient and diocesan Secretary. When it is shipped advise again, giving date and mode of shipment. Prepay all expenses.

Report changes of address, and any changes in your list of officers to the Secretary.

MINUTES.

The annual meeting of the Woman's Auxiliary was held May 14th, the opening service beginning at 10:30. Chaplain Lloyd of Vancouver Barracks, preached the sermon. The offering was \$19. At 12 o'clock about 150 were served with a delicious luncheon by the women of St. Mark's.

At 2 o'clock the business meeting was called to order with the President, Mrs. Scadding, in the chair. The hymn "Oh, Zion, Haste," was sung and prayer offered by Bishop Scadding. Mrs. Scadding welcomed the Delegates. Reports of the Diocesan Secretaries were read and approved, and the Diocesan Treasurer's report read and accepted. This report will be found in full on another page.

Treasurer of United Offering report, which is incomplete, shows \$168.90 received this year. Balance on hand from last year, \$158.21. A gift of \$35 from this annual meeting makes a total of \$362.11 to date.

Mrs. Hallam, recently of Minneapolis, and now of St. David's Parish, stated clearly the uses of the United Offering Fund.

The attendance in 1911 was 152. An offering was then taken amounting to \$20.30. Reports of Secretaries and

Treasurers of Junior branches were read. Moneys included in the Treasurer's annual report, as are also the gifts from the Babies' branches.

The report of the nominating committee resulted in the re-election of the present incumbents with the exception of Mrs. A. M. Oakes, who was elected Recording Secretary, vice Mrs. Talbot, who resigned to become educational secretary, a newly created office. A short interesting address was given by Chaplain Lloyd on church conditions in the Philippines.

Time and places of general meetings for the coming year are as follows: October, St. Michael and All Angels; January, St. David's; March, Trinity.

It was voted by the Convention to send \$15.00 to the famine sufferers in China and \$35.00 to be added to the United Offering. After a short address by Archdeacon Horsfall, the meeting, which was one of the most earnest and helpful, adjourned.

There was a general discussion on "the election of Diocesan officers by the Juniors" but all agreed that next year would be a better time to start as all were not prepared for it this year.
