EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE.

Report.

The Executive Committee has to report three meetings held during the year. The annual meeting was held on November 19, at the Church of the Holy Trinity, and lasted all day. The Holy Communion was celebrated in the church at 10 a. m., after which adjournment was made to the Parish House for a conference with the Clergy. Very interesting addresses were made by Reverend Messrs. Olmsted, Hills and Bunting, and a letter was read from Rev. Mr. Haughton, describing methods of Missionary work in his Parish. Luncheon was kindly provided by friends of the Auxiliary and was much enjoyed by all.

The afternoon session followed and was held in the church, when the speakers were Bishop Millspaugh for the Domestic Committee, Rev. Mr. Ambler of Japan for the Foreign Committee, Bishop Johnston for the Freedmen's Committee, and Rev. Mr. Edson of Alaska for the Indians' Hope. The offerings were \$154, which were equally divided among the four committees. The meeting was largely attended and was delightful as well as profitable. The Epiphany meeting was at the Church House on the afternoon of January 21, and as usual was devoted to Foreign Missions. Archdeacon Brady presided, and Rev. Mr. Kinsolving's account of his work in Brazil was listened to with great interest, and Bishop Hare spoke most earnestly for Japan.

The offering of \$100 was given to the Foreign Committee. The third and last meeting was held in Lent on the afternoon of April 1, in the Church of the Holy Trinity. The addresses were made by Dean Bartlett on behalf of the Jews, by Bishop Thompson on the "Negro Question," by Bishop Brooke for Domestic Missions, and by Bishop Talbot on behalf of the Indians. The meeting was most inspiring and the speakers were listened to with deep attention and sympathy. The offering was equally divided among the four committees

and amounted to \$161. The Executive Committee wish to express their thanks to Mr. Frank McDowell, of St. Peter's Church, Germantown, to whose liberality they have been indebted for the last eighteen years for the paper on which the reports are printed.

The Committee earnestly beg the support of their fellow churchmen through their gifts and interest, but, above all, through their prayers for the Missions of the Church.

INDIANS' HOPE ASSOCIATION.

Thirty-first Annual Report.

In reviewing the work of the past year we have every reason to feel encouraged; especially when we consider the removal by death and otherwise of several of our most devoted and generous members.

Although we deeply regretted the absence of our Vice-President, Mrs. Markoe, we may well congratulate ourselves in securing the services of Mrs. Patterson, whose unselfish and enthusiastic devotion to the cause has been most inspiring.

As usual, our main efforts have been for Rosebud Agency, under the Rev. A. B. Clark in Bishop Hare's jurisdiction in South Dakota. The Bishop at his annual visit to the Association gave a most encouraging account of the work, as shown by the Statistical Table of South Dakota: Baptisms during the year, 642; confirmed, 38; making the total number of confirmed 2885. It is very touching to hear of the wonderful efforts the Indian congregations make to help themselves by raising money for Churches and Chapels—their small savings representing more real self-sacrifice than we are apt to make. The Bishop has raised a fund of \$700 to distribute among seven Missionaries to commemorate the twenty-fifth anniversary of their faithful services in the field, to which we contributed \$229.50.

It is very sad to have to report the loss by fire of St. Elisabeth's Boarding School on Standing Rock Reserve, which has been in operation for about ten years. One lady writes, "Miss Frances has made it one of the best Indian schools that I have seen, and it can be ill spared." Its whole history has been marked by self-denial and heroic enterprise. In spite of every effort to extinguish the flames, the residence part of the school and the school house adjoining were entirely swept out of existence. It seems that

nothing is so popular as a great fire. A month after it occurred the Bishop reported that he had received sufficient money to rebuild St. Elisabeth's and the adjoining building, and pledges have been made from all sides towards refurnishing. We contributed \$205.60, besides articles for refurnishing.

One of the most interesting of our Specials this year has been the erection of a Mission building in Oklahoma in Bishop Brooke's jurisdiction under the Rev. Mr. Sanford. This is the first missionary effort made for the Indians in Oklahoma, where whites and Indians are alike destitute of all religious instruction. The Mission house, costing \$500, is already built, and a chapel adjoining, which will cost \$200 more. It was most gratifying to have Bishop Brooke at one of the meetings, giving a most interesting account of this much needed work. The school will be opened in September.

We also had an interesting address from Bishop Gilbert, giving us an account of the Chippewa Indians in Minnesota, who belong to the same family of Indians that met our forefathers at Plymouth Rock. The missionary work accomplished among them under the Rev. Mr. Gilfillen is wonderful. We contributed \$100 towards a Mission house for Birch Coole.

Although we do not generally report boxes separately, I feel that I must say a word about our special box sent to Miss Dixon, field matron at Rosebud Agency. Her charming letter was read at our September meeting, and within two weeks the box was sent, containing carpets, house linen, blankets, dress stuffs, curtains, and a large number of household articles, which helped to make her empty bare rooms comfortable and homelike. The value of the box was \$156.

It has been our earnest wish, while not neglecting our pledges to support the work at Rosebud, to extend our interest more and more to the various noble efforts that are being made in other fields, and we have sent contributions to Bishop Gray in Florida, to Miss Sybil Carter, and to Bishop Leonard.

Before closing we must express our deep regret at the loss of a most valuable member of the Association, Miss Katherine R. Hawley, whose constancy and devotion to the work had been an influence and example to the Association for many years.

Three new Parishes had representatives in the Association this winter : St. Stephen's ; St. Philip's, West Philadelphia ; and St. John the Evangelist, Lansdowne.

We again owe our thanks to Mr. Frank McDowell, for the paper for the Reports, and to the Pennsylvania Railroad for transportation of boxes so far as Chicago.

DOMESTIC COMMITTEE.

Twenty-third Annual Report.

The record of another year's work must be given to you to-day. I wish that it were the best we have ever had, but alas! I fear that the wave of financial distress has at last reached us, for we have fallen behind in our gifts. A great deal of good work has been done, some of the Parishes have surpassed themselves, many special cases of need have been promptly relieved, and generous gifts in money and boxes have been sent. Our total is 189 boxes valued at \$15,039.93; of these, forty-two, valued at \$2061.39, have been given within the Diocese. Parishes report money gifts of \$1879.77, and the Treasurer shows that \$3325.99 has been received by her, making \$19,245.69. All of the Pennsylvania boxes are good and helpful ones, even those sent by the weaker Parishes, who not being able to supply the Clerical suit, filled with supplies for our schools and orphanages and hospitals, are sources of great comfort and relief; and I beg the Parishes who make them to be assured that they are doing valuable work in the good cause. Our pledges for the year have all been met, as our Treasurer's Report will show; our work is divided into three branches: The Evangelistic, the Educational, and the Charitable. Under the first we class the effort to pay the salary, at least in part, of one Missionary

Bishop. It seems to me that the great Diocese of Pennsylvania ought to do that. I have said it before and now repeat it, that if there were just one woman in each Parish who was interested to do this, it certainly could be done. As a Committee, we are educating one daughter of a poor Missionary, and it is not without effort that this \$300 is collected. I do not believe that there is a mother here present who fails to realize the value of a Christian education of highest grade, to any girl. We do not want the boys neglected, but if we must choose, we take the girl, for says Herbert Spencer, "Educate a woman, and you educate a race." Our help to Bishop Morris in keeping his valuable matron in the Good Samaritan Hospital, at Portland, Oregon, is what we are doing, as a body, in the charitable line, at an outlay of \$250 a year. It seems a small sum for so great an end. Many Parishes have most faithfully paid, for all these years, generous sums to this fund. To them comes home the benediction of their Gracious Lord. My poor thanks for their helpfulness are as "idle words" in comparison.

We try also to lift a burden from the heart of one Missionary Bishop, by paying the premium on his life insurance, which the stringency of the times had almost forced him to relinquish.

Much loving service has been rendered besides these larger pledges. Comfort and cheer have entered homes that were in sad need of both. How many a good woman, who in the words of one of them, "had patched, until the original garment was hardly visible," has welcomed the box as a very Fairy in her home! How the voice of the Missionary has been strengthened, as gladness filled his heart with thanksgiving! The little Mission Chapels, too, have been thought of, and the Lord's Table has been reverently cared for, with the Altar linen and sacred vessels supplied, which had been lacking. The annual meeting held last November at Holy Trinity, was the best one we have ever had. Its new feature was the presence of the Clergy, by invitation, at the conference, and it has proved its benefits. It seems to me that these meetings are too helpful to be forgotten. I wish that each delegate would make it a duty to bring with her a goodly

company from her Parish. We have seventy working with us, and one hundred and seventy-eight delegates. Fancy what a meeting it would be if each one brought a dozen.

The Lent meeting was unusually interesting, but it was not as large as it should have been. I love to see the throngs of happy children that attend the meetings of the Junior Auxiliary, but I do not want their interest to surpass ours. People cannot care for anything of which they know nothing. The love of missions will not grow in the heart unless it be planted and nourished there; these meetings are the fertilizers. Time hastens on, the United Offering must not be forgotten. We are assured that many more Parishes are gathering for it than ever before. May Pennsylvania surpass herself in her gift in 1898! There remaineth much ground to be possessed. We appeal to all to help.

There are two matters of which I desire to speak: One is to beg the Parishes not to send to Miss Emery for their Missionary letters. It no doubt seems a trifling thing for each one, as its letter is written, that its request should at once be heeded; but when one remembers that 2128 Parishes are working branches of the Auxiliary, each one with an equal privilege to write, it is easy to see that if each one availed itself of it, an army of clerks would be needed that would make heavy demands on the Missionary treasury. To avoid this, about six hundred Diocesan officers stand ready as volunteer helpers, and in each Diocese there are among them, those who receive direct from the General Secretary, budgets of letters for distribution. The heads of the various committees in Pennsylvania will answer all inquiries for work and supply letters for selection. I can always furnish Domestic work.

The other matter to which I desire to call your attention is on the subject of Reports. If the branches would only realize that the whole Diocesan report rests with them, and can only be made up from the Parish ones, there would not be an annual delay of several months, before it could be ready for the printer. The next thing to do after a box is sent is to report it, unless the Parish prefers to wait for the whole season's work to be ended. In that case there should be no de-

lay, as the General Report stands waiting, and your President is most eager to have it as large as possible—and as correct too.

We are again confronted with the prospect of a deficiency in the Treasury of the Board of Missions to meet its pledges. What can it mean? Is the Church so heedless of the Divine command, or are its members so poor that they cannot measure the very moderate sum asked for? We only know that each year we are startled by the cry, "give us money enough to meet our pledges." There are hosts of good men and women on every side who are giving all that they can. It seems to me that it is our plain duty to bring in those who are not, and I would place it before us as a special object for next year's work, to increase our numbers. Let every woman who is interested, seek to find one who is not, in that way the givers will increase, and there will be no more anxiety. Think what it must be to the men in the field and to their wives. And "while we have time, let us do good unto all men, and especially unto them that are of the household of faith."

FOREIGN COMMITTEE.

Report for the Year 1896-97.

The Foreign Committee has held its regular meetings during 1896 and 1897. Twenty-one new members have been added to the list, representing four new Parishes among them. The officers feel that much more could be accomplished if the delegates would seriously take into consideration the necessity of begging larger contributions from their respective Parishes. All work for Christ and His Kingdom requires a sacrifice, and personal feelings must be set aside. There are Parishes, with regularly appointed delegates, from whom we receive no contributions for Foreign Missionary work. Therefore, renewed efforts for the next year are earnestly desired. All pledges and scholarships are paid, and two new objects have been helped. The attendance at the meetings has been good, not only in the number of regular delegates, about fifty present each month, but we have been greatly encouraged in having many visitors with us, which shows a growing interest in the work of Foreign Missions. The Junior Auxiliary Branches send their delegates regularly, and in this way our young women are learning the lessons needed for their life work. Very interesting addresses have been made, and many letters read from Missionaries in the field. The death of Miss Mailes was announced at the October meeting, she had been faithfully working in Japan for ten years, and only laid down her work when ill health compelled her. Expressions of sympathy were offered, and a letter sent to Mrs. Mailes, her mother, telling the action of the committee. At the November meeting a most stirring address was made by the Rev. Lucien L. Kinsolving, of Brazil, and the heart of each listener was touched, and immediately a sum of money pledged, which was sent to him for his work in Brazil.

Mrs. Thomas Neilson gave an interesting and graphic account of the Missionary Council held in Cincinnati, in October, especially of the Twenty-fifth Anniversary of the

Woman's Auxiliary, and of Dr. Walrath, telling of her work at Cape Mount, Africa. Mrs. Walrath, M. D., was present at this council. A letter was read from Miss Emery appealing for contributions towards the purchase of bedsteads for the new school building at Cape Mount, which is now completed and occupied, and must be furnished. This school is under the charge of Dr. Walrath and her Assistants. A new teacher, Miss Higgins, has gone with Mrs. Walrath to the school at Cape Mount. All good wishes and prayers follow them from the members of the Auxiliary. Miss Emery was present at the January meeting and her inspiring words were gladly heard, she pleaded especially for a typewriter to be given to Mr. Smalley, the business manager of St. John's College, Shanghai, China; \$36.75 was immediately pledged and afterwards sent for this purpose. The meeting in February was a most instructive as well as interesting one, many subjects were discussed, and the new members heard a clear statement of the ways and means of collecting and sending the funds brought by the delegates. The tax for the Foreign Insurance Fund, and Current Expenses, was explained as coming from the Parish, not the individual necessarily, but at the will of the delegate if she chooses to give it.

Miss Cummings, of South Africa, a teacher of a school in the Transvaal, was present, and gave an extremely interesting account of the work done there, in educating the native girls, daughters of the descendants of the Huguenot, Dutch and English settlers. These girls are sent as teachers and Missionaries to the Interior, and being already acclimated, also knowing the language, are much better fitted for their work than foreigners. Two of the graduates of this school are now in England, receiving special instruction, and will be sent out by the Church of England Missionary Society. We have no Missions in the Transvaal, so the address was peculiarly interesting as giving something entirely new as well as instructive.

At the March meeting it was announced that a young woman, now being trained at the Church Deaconess House, in Philadelphia, had offered herself as a teacher in Japan, to take Miss Mailes' place. Miss Babcock expects to sail either in

August or October for her home in the Mission field. As the Pennsylvania Branch is responsible for \$500 of the salary of this teacher, she will be of special interest to us, and the daily prayers of each member are asked for her welfare and success.

The death of one of our members was announced at the May meeting, that of Mrs. D. Murray Cheston, who had been untiring in her interest, and devotion to the cause, and who had, even in her long and painful illness, not been forgetful of her duties in collecting subscriptions from her friends and helpers, among the Parishioners of Holy Trinity Church, of which she was a delegate.

We note with pleasure the movement this past Lenten-tide, for holding parlor Missionary meetings at the houses of some of our earnest Church women; these meetings were productive of much good as new interest was aroused in many hearts, and the substantial result, in the way of contributions, was most gratifying, the Foreign Committee receiving a generous share. The amount contributed during the year was \$5676.80, including \$2500 for an endowed scholarship in Africa. We beg our committee never to be satisfied, until our prayers have besieged the Throne, and our hearts have been melted by the crying needs of the Foreign field, resulting in increased numbers and magnified offerings. During the summer months the Mite-Boxes whether for the United Offering, or other Missionary needs, should always accompany each member on her travels or sojourns, and so placed that when the eye of any one reads, "O Lord, without whom our labor is but lost, and with whom Thy little ones go forth as the mighty, we humbly beseech Thee to prosper all works in Thy Church," the heart may be prompted to place an offering in the box, no matter how small. It is to be hoped most earnestly that the Woman's Auxiliary will be able so to help the General Board of Missions, that a deficit will be a thing of the past.

The usual boxes of dolls for Christmas gifts were sent to Africa and Japan, also special contributions of money to be expended in Japan for Christmas Festivals. A box of groceries and medicines was also sent to Africa for Mrs. Walrath's use.

Let us thank God for past mercies and take courage for the future.

FREEDMEN'S COMMITTEE.

Report for the Year 1896-97.

The Freedmen's Committee has continued its meetings for the past year with larger numbers, better attendance, and, we think, an increased interest in the work.

Money has been given in many directions, for scholarships, for teachers' salaries, and in aid of hospitals, orphanages and other worthy objects. Many really valuable boxes, too, have been sent to different parts of the South, gladdening the hearts of those who received them.

And yet, we must always regret that more has not been done, especially when, as sometimes occurs, we read a letter, six months or a year old, from some hard-working priest,

telling of the needs of his family, which perhaps are still unsupplied, or from another, saying, "Our children had no box, and consequently no Christmas festival this year."

Those who have read the Spirit of Missions for the month of May, scarcely need any additional words on the subject of the work of the Church among the colored people. All who have not read it should not fail to do so. There, may be found, from the pens of Bishops, Priests and Laymen, all deeply interested in the work, eloquent, practical and stirring words, setting forth the needs, difficulties, discouragements and dangers of this most urgent and most difficult problem.

The necessity for industrial education, the importance of teaching these people to give according to their ability, to the support of the Church, and the advantages that would come from a well-educated, thoroughly trained body of colored clergymen, to lead and teach the people, are among the subjects earnestly dwelt upon in these papers. For this whole work is needed, as has lately been said, "Money, friends to speak and to pray for it, sympathy and patience, but above all else hearts stirred by the Divine Spirit, men and women going forth in the name and power of the Lord Christ, convinced that they are sent and daunted by no difficulties."
