EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE.

Report.

The Executive Committee has, as usual, three General Missionary Meetings to report.

The Annual Meeting was held on Thursday, November 18, in the Church of the Holy Trinity, beginning at 10.30, and lasting throughout the day. Bishop Whitaker presided, and celebrated the Holy Communion, making an earnest and helpful address. Service being ended, an adjournment was made to the Parish House for conference with the Clergy.

Addresses were made by Rev. Henry Anstice, D. D., Rev. R. W. Forsyth and Rev. John Dows Hills. The latter spoke most earnestly in behalf of the United Offering, and aroused much enthusiasm.

Luncheon was provided, as usual, by the friends of the Woman's Auxiliary, after which all returned to the Church for the afternoon. The speakers were Bishop Leonard, for Domestic Missions; Archdeacon Page, who told of his work in Japan; Rev. Sherman Coolidge, and Rev. A. B. Clarke, who spoke for the Indians, and Rev. W. V. Tunnell, who made a most thrilling appeal for interest in the Freedmen. The offering was \$192.45, and was divided equally among the four committees, to be used for their missionary work. The Auxiliary has now devised a plan by which all its expenses are met without touching any part of the gifts of the people made at the General Missionary Meetings. These gifts go directly to the missionary fields.

A resolution was adopted at this meeting, a copy of which was sent to Miss Emery, expressing the sense of irreparable loss felt by the Woman's Auxiliary at the death of Dr. Langford.

The Epiphany Meeting for Foreign Missions was held on the afternoon of January 27, in the Church House, Archdeacon Brady presiding. Three very inspiring addresses were made by Rev. H. L. F. Pott, who told of facts concerning

missions in China; by Mrs. A. T. Twing, who told of the missionaries throughout the Foreign Field, and by Rev. R. W. Forsyth, who urged most strongly upon each one present to be a missionary, by interest, by gifts of money, and, above all, by prayer. The offering of \$159.83, the largest ever received at an Epiphany Meeting, was given entirely to the Foreign Committee for work in the Foreign Field.

The Lent Meeting was held March 24, in the Church of the Ascension, where addresses were made by Archdeacon Page, on Missions in Japan; Bishop Wells, who told of the success of Domestic Missions; Mr. Herbert Welsh, who spoke for the Indians, and Archdeacon Russell, who appealed for the colored people. Owing to the heavy rain, the attendance was very small, and the offering was only \$50.50, which was divided among the four committees.

At the last meeting of the Executive Committee, held April 1, 1898, Bishop Whitaker met the ladies, and suggested their forming a new Committee in the interest of Diocesan Missions. The suggestion was favorably received, and a resolution was adopted that a Diocesan Committee be formed, and that Bishop Whitaker be asked to appoint the officers. The following officers were appointed, and have accepted: President, Mrs. Henry Anstice; Vice-President, Mrs. W. W. Sylvester; Secretary, Mrs. Richard N. Thomas; Treasurer, Miss Elizabeth Bodine.

This branch of the Auxiliary has sustained serious losses this year: one in the death of their oldest member and true friend, Mrs. William Welsh; the other in the removal from Philadelphia of Bishop and Miss McVickar—the one for many years a faithful officer of the Woman's Auxiliary, and her brother, by his never failing interest in missions, and his constant courtesy in allowing the meetings to be held in his Parish Church, leaving a deep impress of gratitude to him, and regret at his loss.

Mrs. William Welsh.

The Pennsylvania Branch of the Woman's Auxiliary to the Board of Missions cannot be silent amid the general lamentations at the death of their late honored and beloved associate, Mrs. William Welsh. For very many years the head of this branch of the Auxiliary, and before its existence, and until her death, the President of its oldest division, the Indians' Hope, she was always distinguished by her ability, her devotion, her zeal, and her faithfulness in every department of the work. No one who has been associated with her in the days of her activity will ever forget these qualities, or fail to recognize how great a loss she is. Even in her enforced retirement she was a power.

"Don't leave me out," she wrote, not long ago; "although I can't be with you, I love to help."

Such women are rare, and the world is poorer at their departure. We thank God for her good example, who now rests from her labors, and her works do follow her.

INDIANS' HOPE ASSOCIATION.

Thirty-second Annual Report.

In order to estimate justly the work of the Indians' Hope Association, it is well to remember that we have been gradually losing some of our oldest and most devoted workers, who have for years been faithful and generous in their gifts.

Although the actual list of membership is growing steadily, it is hardly to be expected that new and young delegates can immediately supply the places thus left vacant.

In the death of our President, Mrs. William Welsh, we have sustained a real loss.

The Indians' Hope Association was started as early as 1865, and owed its existence entirely to the interest and influence of Mr. William Welsh. At that time Dr. Howe was its President, until 1871, when the Rev. Dr. Watson succeeded him. About five years later Mrs. Welsh became President, when, for the first time, all the officers elected were women. She continued in that capacity until her death. For more than twenty years her interest and devotion in the work never failed, and it is difficult to estimate the far-reaching results of her noble efforts.

The removal from the Diocese of our Treasurer, Miss McVickar, is also a fact, much to be regretted, but we are very fortunate in the choice of her successor.

The meetings have been well attended, and we have enjoyed the usual number of speakers from the various fields.

As Rosebud Agency is under our special charge, the visit of the Rev. A. B. Clark, Missionary of that jurisdiction, was of great interest to us. It is pleasant to see face to face those for whom one has worked for years, and hearing from Mr. Clark all the particulars of his work among the Indians at Rosebud was the next best thing to seeing them ourselves. No one could hear his hopeful and devoted words without feeling a renewed zeal to help him and his brave wife accomplish the work which they so faithfully carry on. Mr. Clark says the Indian children love the schools, as demonstrated by their regular attendance, and that the women make every effort to contribute their mite to the Church. Mr. Clark said further, that the Indian Agents at Rosebud during the last ten years had been good men. This is entirely due to the efforts of the Indian Rights Association. It is good to know that we are all working hand in hand towards the same end.

We have, as usual, supplied all the Catechists' boxes for Rosebud, and by means of Mrs. Graff's \$5000 legacy a Chapel and Rectory will be erected there.

Bishop Hare visited the Association several times. He said that the era of Church-building in his jurisdiction is practically over, there being now 55 Churches; but the work spreads in many different directions. Scholarships should be maintained, and wells at the Boarding Schools are dire necessities. Bishop Hare has just completed his twenty-five years of work among the Indians, which the Association remembered by a fitting resolution.

Miss Carter's visit was most interesting. Her work among the Indian women is not only Christianizing, but admirable in its civilizing influence. She teaches them to make beautiful lace, which always finds a market in the East, and this leads inevitably to cleanliness and neatness. Much good work is done by these Bible women, who, in teaching Christianity, can also teach the Indian women to be clean, thrifty and self-respecting. It may interest those who contributed to St. Elisabeth's School to know that it is an accomplished fact, and that many gifts were received to make it in every way complete. We have to report two legacies—one of \$25 from Mrs. R. T. Stockman, and the other of \$1250 from Mrs. Graff. Also a donation by Miss Dixon of a collection of Indian curios, which are placed in the Diocesan Library. The \$25 were appropriated to help to pay the salaries of Missionaries at Flandreau, and Mrs. Graff's legacy is to be invested, the interest to be used for Missionary work, as the Association deems best.

As to our special gifts, we are constantly widening our sympathies, and this year we have contributed to more outside interests than ever before. This is encouraging, but we must not neglect our old claims.

Twenty-fourth Annual Report.

The report I bring to you to-day, of our year's work, gives the very good news that five more Parishes have joined our ranks, and we are thus encouraged to believe that our list will soon embrace the whole number in the Diocese; then will our usefulness be largely increased, and we shall be the banner Branch of the Woman's Auxiliary.

We have, during the year, received our first legacy. Our dear friend and benefactor, the late Mrs. Elizabeth M. Graff, bequeathed to the Pennsylvania Branch of the Auxiliary the sum of \$5000, one-fourth part of which, by the terms of her will, came to our share. It was a great satisfaction to me that, by a unanimous vote, it was decided to invest

the same, and to ask of Mr. George C. Thomas to receive the sum and invest it at his discretion. The fund will be known as "the Elizabeth M. Graff Memorial Fund," so that "she being dead, yet speaketh." In accepting the office of custodian of the fund, Mr. Thomas could not omit the opportunity for a generous act.

We have sent outside the Diocese 160 boxes, valued at \$13,564.87, and within the Diocese 42 have been sent, valued at \$1716.39. These latter will not again appear in our Reports, for a new department of the Pennsylvania Branch has recently been created, the Diocesan Committee, which, as its name implies, will directly serve the Diocese.

Our Treasurer has received, besides the legacy above named, \$3837.30, and the Parishes have sent direct \$549.64. This makes \$4386.49 in money to be added to the valuation of the 160 boxes (\$13,564.87), a total of \$17,951.81, to which we add for the moment the Diocesan Report, as of old, lest we be too much discouraged, and the year's record amounts to \$20,245.61. This is a goodly sum; but, alas! it is less than we have had, and that is what we do not like to see. We must go forward with an ever-increasing ratio. There is always a demand for our activity, and while we are gathering new recruits in Parish Branches, we cannot let the old ones fall behind. Bishop Talbot's idea of the army in which we are all enlisted is the true one: the success or failure of the battle may depend upon any soldier in the ranks.

I must speak to-day of a custom—not an unusual one in some quarters—of sending what I would term "volunteer boxes." This produces a species of waste and overlapping. In this way one missionary—a widower with one child—has this year, while receiving in the regular way his box, valued at \$125, had a second one (a volunteer), valued at \$135. Another man received his regular box, valued at \$249.27, and gets another valued at \$45. Far be it from me to say that two new clerical suits and three new overcoats—two heavy ones and one light-weight one—a dozen and a half of shirts, and other things in proportion, are too much for one man; but I will say that it is rather hard that some should receive so

much and others nothing at all,—and this happens every year. Of course, we may all have our tastes and preferences, but we must not forget that, like our great Nation, we, too, are ministering to an army; ours is doing field duty in the Master's cause, and we dare not neglect any one in it. What would we think of the Government if it followed our plan of picking and choosing where to help? "The whole number of Domestic Missionaries, clerical and lay, male and female, receiving salaries or stipends this year" is 1007, and 4737 missionary boxes were reported to have been sent last season, of which but a small number were for the Foreign field. One can see at a glance that only by great care and perfect system can injustice be avoided. I would, therefore, appeal to the Rectors and their good women to desist from impromptu work. There is need enough to afford ample scope for our efforts and our money; pray do not let us waste either.

The review of the general meetings during the year has been so well given by the Secretary of the Executive Committee that I refer you to her report. Our own monthly meetings have been well attended by my faithful Delegates, than whom a goodlier company cannot be found. We have had the pleasure of hearing Bishops Leonard and Wells, Archdeacon Johnson of Wyoming and Idaho, Rev. W. F. B. Taylor of Los Angeles, Cal., and Archdeacon Walton of Georgia. While each one of them has given us knowledge of his special work, and pleasure in hearing "news from the front," we have cheered and helped them by sympathy and substantial aid. It is pleasant to know how eagerly coveted is a visit to this Committee. One Missionary Bishop says: "I would rather address it than an Annual Meeting in the Church." Another says: "It is a real gold mine." Let us see to it that we sustain our reputation.

Before our October meeting the United Offering of the Woman's Auxiliary will have been made. How vividly I recall the one of 1895; how, amid the enthusiasm of delight over the vast sum given, I felt a pity for those who had given nothing, because I knew that they must be sad and remorseful. Time is yet permitted to any in that class to make some amends now. Suppose that each one who has offered noth-

ing towards "the training of women workers in the Missionary fields, and sending them out," should send to the Treasurer of the United Offering one dollar, I believe that the sum would astonish even Pennsylvania. You do not know what wholesome emulation is stirred at these meetings, nor what pardonable pride is felt when we do well.

While it is our blessed privilege to be laboring for "peace and good-will on earth," the whole undertone of our lives to-day is of war. More than 200,000 of our fellow-citizens have already gone forth at their country's call. "May the Fatherly Hand of the Almighty and Everliving God ever be over them." "To Him we make our address in this our necessity." While we feel sure that nothing that woman can do will be left undone in this hour of our country's need, we beseech them not to forget the armies of the Prince of Peace; don't let anything called patriotism turn us away from them. Some note of warning must be sounded on behalf of missions. We may not neglect them, for "righteousness exalteth a nation."

I most heartily thank all our fellow-laborers, and pray that we may not grow weary in well-doing.

FOREIGN COMMITTEE.

Report for the Year 1897-98.

This Annual Report is a chapter from modern history. History to-day is more than a collection of facts; it is the story of the life of a people. Our story, to be sure, is but a small part of a people's life. It touches upon the relation of our nation to the work of Foreign Missions. It only presents a fragment of that—what our own Communion has to do with it; and it contains but a fragment of this fragment—the work of the Foreign Committee of the Diocese of Pennsylvania. But it is important.

If we are intensely eager to get the latest report of our war with Spain, ought we not to be as much interested in the story—however meagre and fragmentary it may be—of the endeavor of some of us to make peace reign in the world through the building up of the Kingdom of Christ? We are a Committee representing that Kingdom, appointed from the great Diocese of Pennsylvania to look after our woman's work abroad.

What have we done in the past year? We have held ten

monthly meetings, the average attendance 53; the largest, 75, in December, and the smallest, 33 in June. Letters have been read to us from Africa, China, Japan and Greece. We have heard from Bishop Whipple upon the great subject of the Lambeth Conference. The Rev. Mr. Pott has spoken to us about the work of his College in Shanghai. The Rev. L. B. Ridgeley has outlined the needs of China, where he soon goes as a missionary. We have been greatly interested in the reading of Miss Higgins' diary, giving her experience as a worker in Cape Mount, Africa.

An interesting event of the year was the receiving of the legacy of the late Mrs. Frederic Graff, of St. James's Church, Philadelphia. Mrs. Graff had given \$5000, to be divided among the Domestic, Foreign, Indian and Freedmen Committees. We unanimously resolved that our portion (\$1250) of the generous gift should be invested, and the income only used for such objects as the Committee from time to time determine. This was thought to be the most fitting way in which we could perpetuate each year among us the gracious memory of one whose unselfish and untiring interest in all good work has been so helpful to every one of her friends and associates. May her gifts be an inspiring example to others. During the year we have made contributions aggregating \$4476.99.

At our November meeting an appreciative minute upon the death of dear Dr. Langford, the late General Secretary, was read by Mrs. Bodine, and adopted as an expression of our share in the loss of the whole Church.

The Foreign Committee has held one public meeting at which our work has been presented. A careful review of our monthly minutes discloses a great amount of thought bestowed by our officers and the delegates upon every interest touching the work entrusted to us. It is not too much to say that this has been an education for each one, and in this regard for the Parishes we represent. Viewed in that light, may we not hope for even a larger average attendance than that of the past year—53 out of 140 delegates?

How valuable these meetings are may be seen from citing as an additional item of our work the fact that we are help-

ing to educate, at the instance of Mrs. Brewer, of Montana, a Japanese, who is to return as a Missionary to his own people again.

On Friday, June 24, our President attended the farewell services in New York for the Rev. and Mrs. Sweet, who sail for Tokyo, Japan, June 29, and was delighted with their cheerful spirit in prospect of their Missionary life. Mr. Sweet goes to the Theological School there for the present.

Bearing, then, in mind what we are trying to accomplish, can we not increase the number of non-delegates, or visitors, at our monthly meetings? Every woman coming here must prove a force for the cause of Foreign Missions in her Parish. At a time when the United States counts it a small thing to spend \$3,000,000 for a battleship, let us not be content with the little we give to this greater work. We love our country. We believe it aims at noble ends in the nations, in the progress of humanity. But we give a greater love to the Kingdom of Jesus Christ, because its aim is "Peace on earth, goodwill to men," and its work is for eternity.

FREEDMEN'S COMMITTEE.

Report for the Year 1897-98.

The work of the Freedmen's Committee is always most interesting, but it is difficult in a short report to give the details of that work. Each year more of the Parishes in the Diocese are represented on the Committee, and the meetings this winter have been unusually well attended.

Addresses have been made by a number of clergymen actively engaged in Missionary Work among the colored people in different parts of the country, and in many instances generous response has been made to their appeals.

We have to record, very gratefully, the bequest of Mrs. Frederic Graff of \$1250 for the work of the Committee. After much consideration, it was decided to devote the money to some much-needed buildings, namely, an Infirmary at St. Paul's School, Lawrenceville, Va.; a Laundry at St. Augustine's School, Raleigh, N. C., and a Kindergarten at the Orphanage, Lynchburg, Va., to be permanent memorials to Mrs. Graff. It was thought best for the advancement of the cause to do this rather than to pay out year by year the small amount of interest that would accrue from this sum, if invested.

We are very glad of what has been accomplished, and earnestly pray for a wider interest in this branch of the Church's Missions.

"The American Church is singularly fitted to grasp the unique difficulties of this undertaking. We began first with this race; its people love, and rarely forsake, our Communion, once admitted to its membership. The opportunities are splendid; we are by no means neglecting them, and a good deal has been done that will last," but we are always looking and hoping for more.
