EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE.

Report.

The Executive Committee reports six meetings preceding and following the usual Missionary meetings of the Woman's Auxiliary in the Diocese of Pennsylvania.

The Annual Meeting was held at the Church of the Holy Trinity on November 9. In the morning Bishop Partridge of Kyoto made an inspiring address. At noon the Auxiliary adjourned to the Parish House for Noonday Prayers followed by a Conference with the Clergy on the distinction between the Sunday School Auxiliary to the Board of Missions and the Junior Department of the Woman's Auxiliary. Miss Lucy Jarvis opened the Conference by defining very clearly the distinction between them, and many questions of interest were asked and answered.

At the afternoon session the Rev. Mr. Butler spoke about "The Work of the Church in Shaping the Growing Life of New Communities" and Bishop Nelson on "Missions the Vocation of the Church."

"The Epiphany Meeting" was held on the evening of January 28, in the Church of the Holy Trinity, when a large and earnest congregation listened to the addresses of the Bishops of New York and Albany. Their subject was "The Missions of the Church," Bishop Potter speaking of "Opportunities," and Bishop Doane on the "Demands."

During Lent a Conference with the clergy was held at the Church House. Mrs. Neilson spoke of the work and aim of the Woman's Auxiliary, and an interesting discussion followed concerning the best means of forming Parish branches. Miss Emery made an earnest address about the United Offering to be presented at the General Convention in October.

Miss Morris explained the work of the Junior Department of the Woman's Auxiliary in this Diocese, and the desire to have a branch in every Parish.

Dr. Duhring spoke of the good work of the Sunday School Auxiliary and the methods employed in gaining the interest of the children.

During the past year several new branches of the Woman's Auxiliary have been formed, but there is much to be done and the ideal can only be attained by the co-operation and interest of every member of the Church.

INDIANS' HOPE ASSOCIATION.

Thirty-fifth Annual Report.

Another year has come to its close, and in looking back upon the work of the Indians' Hope Association with a feeling of thankfulness for good results achieved, we cannot for-

bear wishing that the work might grow more steadily and abundantly. The needs are growing more and more urgent, and as it seems that every year a greater burden falls upon the church and the faithful workers in the field, it becomes the positive duty of the workers at home to increase their gifts accordingly.

We have had excellent meetings, well attended and full of interest, although not as many speakers as in previous years. We have heard from Mr. Prevost whose work is in Alaska, among Indians, whites and Esquimaux; from Bishop Leonard, in Utah, and our usual visits from Bishop Hare.

Owing to the withdrawal of government rations in the Church Boarding Schools, a special burden has fallen upon the Bishop this year. The whole amount to be raised for the extra food supply for the schools was \$2,000, of which the Indians' Hope contributed \$447. The time has not yet come when these church schools can be handed over to become ordinary Government Boarding Schools; the good work which they have accomplished in the past must be continued for some time to come, even if they must be partially maintained by extra efforts and contributions from friends in the East. Anyone who knows the self-sacrificing, devoted labors of the principals of these schools, can understand that such work ought not to be abandoned.

Every speaker who has come to us direct from the field has given us a most encouraging and inspiring account of the steady progress of the Indians. Bishop Leonard said that the statistics proved that the Indians are steadily improving rather than decreasing. In South Dakota alone there are 10,000 baptized persons, out of a population of 25,000. Over six thousand have been confirmed. Contributions of the Indians make a remarkable showing, beginning in 1884 with \$1,050, and ending up in 1900 with the sum of \$8,492. It ought to be inspiring to workers at home that most of this money is contributed by Indian women. Our general contributions this year show an increase of \$385.20 over last year, although our special contributions are a little less.

Our list of specials is most interesting and shows the

generous response which meets these various appeals. The total amount of specials for Bishop Hare's work is \$1,037.50, including the \$447 for the food supply, \$100 for insurance, \$100 for salaries at Flandreau, and \$85 for Miss Dixon's lace workers; while \$964 was distributed among nine other outside demands, beginning with Bishop Rowe, \$230; Arch-deacon Appleby, \$140; Bishops Leonard, Gray and Brooke, over \$100 each.

The regular supporters of the work among the Indians ought to bear in mind, that some money must be spent annually in relieving tired workers from the strain of their incessant labors. If we would keep them at their best, we must supply them with the means to obtain it. People do not realize the amount of actual and permanent good the sum of \$25 or \$50 can achieve, by contributing, for instance, to such indispensable needs as windmills, stoves, stationary tubs in Boarding Schools, repairs on dilapidated houses and roofs, and so lightening the burden of those who are giving so much more than mere money, who are giving their lives to the work.

In looking at the work as a whole, it seems to have reached a point of wonderful interest and promise. The period of church building and forming of congregations is practically over in Dakota, the school system is in a prosperous condition, and the time steadily drawing nigh when the government will withdraw the ration system altogether from these people and throw them on their own resources. It is just in this crisis, when suddenly deprived of their usual means of support, that the church must stand by the Indian with every possible aid and encouragement, until they feel strong enough to stand alone, and it is through the channels of the Indians' Hope that this work can most effectually be accomplished. Let us hope that each year we may increase our number of subscribers and special contributors.

Twenty-seventh Annual Report.

We bring to you our Annual Report in the earnest hope that we "have done what we could." Of many we know that this is true; may it come to be true of all, some day. We are happy to say that several new branches have been added to our list. Why is it that any Parish exists without one? We are ready and anxious to welcome them all. I have heard it said that some are too poor to belong to us. Are they too poor to pray? Until that is the case we cannot accept their excuse. Nothing can be given more precious than their prayers.

The meetings of the working season have been held as usual. At the annual one, on the ninth of November, we had the great privilege of hearing some of the speakers from the Missionary Council at Louisville, and it was surely an inspiring occasion. At our monthly meetings we have had addresses from Bishops Hare, Leonard and Wells; from the Rev. R. N. Forsyth, representing the needs of Bishop Brown's Diocese; from Archdeacon Watkins on Bishop Millspaugh's behalf; from Miss Tannatt to plead the cause of Christian training for the girls in Olympia, and from the Rev. C. M. Becwith charged with the thanks of the Bishop of Texas for Pennsylvania's timely and generous aid to the sufferers by the Galveston flood.

Our pledges have all been paid, and there has been no change in them. One hundred and fifty-six Missionary boxes have been sent away, the value of one hundred and fifty-one of which has been reported to us at \$15,611.22. Our Treasurer has received \$14,935.70. The Parishes have sent direct to their beneficiaries \$829. I find acknowledged in *The Spirit of Missions*, through the Woman's Auxiliary for Domestic Missions, the large sum of \$2,499, and \$780.85 has been added during the year to the Endowment Fund of the Memorial Scholarship; our total is \$34,655.77. The magnificent gift from a member of the Committee "for Church building purposes in Manila" has swelled our total by \$10,000. Never before in our history has such grand liberality fallen upon us, and we can only "rejoice and give thanks." All honor to such Christian liberality! One must be blessed to be able to do such great things for the Church of God, but alas! how many could do them whose hearts are filled with no such desire? There are many givers too, who either forget or do not care to encourage this organized body of helpers to the Board of Missions, as is shown by the above record, taken from *The Spirit of Missions*, and when the Reports of the Missionary Bishops are published we shall find that they have received direct from our Churchwomen many thousands besides. The donors might increase the happiness they make, taking us into their confidence, that we might add the amounts of their gifts to our list.

We are grateful for the added \$780.85 to the fund for the Endowment of the Memorial Scholarship, which is now \$2,445.85, \$3,000 being the sum needed. We hope that in another year this may be filled, and at once relieve the Committee from the annual payment of \$300 for its beneficiary, and make perpetual provision for the education of the daughter of a Missionary. I am very sure that this is help to our poorly-paid Missionaries that is highly appreciated by them, and of inestimable value to the daughters of the Republic. Our gifts during the past year have been so diversified that after having sent money to a young Deaconess, for harness and wagon; carpets to a Galveston Rector, whose home had been flooded; a Baby organ to a Missionary in Indian Territory, whose work was among small mining towns. Miss Emery wrote, how would you like to add a mule to your benefactions? A suggestion of a need to this Committee is to supply it, so money was sent to buy the mule. A bicycle was also sent to a Missionary who craved one; money for stoves to one who declared his to be quite worn out; a typewriter, to one who had been obliged to sacrifice his to his needs.

The Treasurer's report shows that nine of the Missionary Bishops, besides several needy Dioceans, have been aided in greater or less degree.

In looking over the Secretary's Roll-Book, one is struck with the utter faithfulness shown by a large majority of the delegates who month by month, and year by year, are sure to be in their places. They can never know how we appreciate this, nor how much they encourage us. On the other hand, there are delegates, not a few, who rarely if ever come; what an injustice to their Parishes! Some of them have not been represented this whole season. How much better it would be for them to resign their places to those who could come, unless, indeed, they would once make the effort to be present, and find so much of interest, that they could not stay away.

Once more I call the attention of all those who do not subscribe to *The Spirit of Missions*, to that invaluable monthly. The readers of it will endorse what I say in its praise. We cannot afford to be ignorant of what its pages contain.

The ever hospitable Holy Trinity Parish will, on November 15, once more open its doors to the Pennsylvania Branch of the Woman's Auxiliary for its annual meeting. Let me beg the members of this Committee to make it a duty to attend it, and to make it widely known. The meeting was larger than usual last year, but I shall not rest satisfied until the Church is as full as it can be.

Thankful for what we have been permitted to do, and for the constant aid and support of the members of the Committee, I submit this Report,

FOREIGN COMMITTEE.

Report for the Year 1900-1901.

As we glance back over the twelve months past, we realize how eventful they have been, especially for our branch of the Auxiliary. Months full of anxiety for our faithful laborers in the field, and of thankfulness for their preservation and for the spread of God's truth spite of the persecutions and

bloodshed in China. Our own monthly meetings, nine in number, have been of especial interest and have been largely attended, although out of eighty-three Parishes represented by one hundred and forty-three delegates about fifteen Parishes have sent no one to our meetings. We wish that the clergy would help us more by appointing delegates who will attend. Our largest meeting was in February, when one hundred and five persons were present. We have welcomed several new branches, amongst them two Junior Branches, and wish sincerely that the many Parishes in our Diocese who are not represented would join us, and with their prayers and presence help us in our work, for "in unity there is strength."

At our annual meeting held in November, Bishop Partridge's sermon on "World Problems and What the Church is Doing to Solve them," made a deep impression, and Epiphany-tide was made memorable by a large evening gathering at Holy Trinity, when addresses were made by Bishop Potter on the opportunities, and by Bishop Doane on the demands of the Church for Missions. We also held a conference with the clergy in April.

It was with sincere regret that we were forced to accept the resignation of our Secretary, Mrs. J. N. Blanchard, who had so faithfully and beautifully filled her office. Mrs. J. Nicholas Mitchell and Miss Downs were unanimously elected to fill her place.

Our Chairman and Treasurer have never failed us, and for their ability, wisdom and tact we are most grateful.

Our enthusiasm for Missions has been increased and nourished by addresses from laborers direct from the field.

Mr. McGee told us of the work under Mr. Duarte, in Cuba; Bishop Holly, of his twenty-six years in Haiti; Mr. Rees, of the Church work in China; Miss Mann, of school and evangelical work in Japan; Dr. Gates, of the great need of a well-equipped women's hospital at Shanghai; Rev. W. Cabell Brown begs our support for Brazil, and Miss Schott for Mexico.

Many letters have been read and many appeals answered, and the amount contributed was about the same as last year

minus the large individual gift for boat for Bishop Ferguson, aggregating \$4,050, of which the Junior Department contributed \$411.01.

In a far-off land of the East, it is said four things never come back: the spoken word, the sped arrow, the past life and the neglected opportunity. The old century with its many failings and its lost opportunities lies back of us, and the new century has opened out to us. Shall we not resolve in the years to come that we will give as never before, and, as we cannot go ourselves to serve our Lord and Master in these far-off lands, that we will send our substitutes and gladly, thankfully support not only our present list of scholarships and missionaries, but add to their number, so that we may be able to feel on that great day when Jesus comes to reign on earth, thankful to God for the inspiration that led us and for the opportunities thus embraced by us, even though feebly, to do our part in the coming of that kingdom.

FREEDMEN'S COMMITTEE.

Report for the Year 1900-1901.

As we look over the records of the year, we realize that there is little that is new to report in the work of the Freedmen's Committee. It is much the same from year to year,—money given to aid in building schools, hospitals and churches; missionaries' and teachers' salaries paid; old people and children cared for, and boxes sent to the families of missionaries.

This seems prosaic enough, but the interest of it lies in the fact that in every direction one sees good results.

The missionaries themselves, in spite of the many difficulties they have to contend with, nearly always speak with encouragement of their labors, and can often tell us of remarkable success. If ever a minor key is struck, it is only from a sense of their own unworthiness, and the realization of the vast work to be done, for which the means are so inadequate.

Some of these good results are the establishing of hospitals and the consequent forming of a body of trained nurses who are doing admirable work; the multiplying of industrial schools and the better tone of those schools; the improved condition of the people in neighborhoods where churches and schools have been built; the larger congregations, and the increased number of communicants; also in the excellent teachers which such schools as St. Augustine's and St. Paul's are now sending out—teachers well fitted for the training of boys and girls in the various parochial and industrial schools, which are growing up all through the South.

The young women teachers, in particular, thoroughly instructed in church schools, make the very best missionaries, as they have access to the homes, and can do an immense amount of good, especially on the plantations and in rural districts, where these schools are more important than in the cities.

So, although Mr. Joyner has said, "The colored problem is simply whether we go to make disciples, not whether we succeed," it is also pleasant sometimes to record success, which we do with very thankful hearts, never forgetting that this should only be an incentive to renewed efforts in a work which surely is a duty and a responsibility resting upon each one of us.

DIOCESAN COMMITTEE.

Report for the Year 1900-1901.

The Diocesan Committee has in its third year to regret deeply the resignation of its most efficient Secretary, Mrs. Richard N. Thomas, who acted in that capacity for the two years of its existence with great fidelity and devotion, and whose services have been highly appreciated by all of her fellow-members.

The list of Parishes represented now number forty, an increase of eight over the past year, and it is to be hoped that next year may show a still greater improvement in the number of Parishes represented, and in a fuller attendance at the meetings. This non-attendance at the meetings is much deplored by those who are faithful, as it shows a want of interest among the delegates and consequently a financial loss to the Committee.

The salary of the Deaconess employed at Kensington has again been pledged by the Committee, and assistance been rendered in many directions including the Italian Mission, the French Mission, the Seamen's Mission, the Colored Mission and the City Mission.

Several interesting addresses were made to the delegates and among the speakers were Rev. T. W. Davidson, of St. Stephen's Church, Norwood; Rev. J. P. Tyler, of the Church of the Advent; Rev. M. Zara, of the Italian Mission; Rev. H. L. Duhring, of the City Mission; Rev. R. H. Wright, of St. Anna's Church, Fifty-sixth and Market streets, and Major Moses Veale, Treasurer of the Colored League.

According to our Treasurer's report the amount of money received this year and given to various objects within the Diocese, both in the city and the country, was \$1,591.92; that sent directly by the Parishes, \$566.29, and the value of the boxes sent, \$1,110.57, which is \$363 more than last year.

This is encouraging as it shows an ever widening circle of good accomplished.

Earnestly trusting that the coming year may bring forth an increased interest in the Mission field at home, and that God's blessing may be with us in our work undertaken in His name.

It would also help greatly if the blank forms sent to the branches to report on were strictly followed and filled out.

The Secretary has visited four branches during the year and is always glad of an opportunity to meet and talk with the members.
