EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE REPORT.

There have been eight meetings held by the Executive Committee of the Woman's Auxiliary during the year, and three Missionary Meetings under its auspices.

The all-day Annual Meeting was held in November, in the Church of the Holy Trinity, with addresses from Bishop Whitaker, the Bishop of Brazil, the Bishop of South Dakota, the Bishop of Shanghai, the Bishop of Texas, the Rev. Henry Forrester, and the Rev. James S. Russell.

The Epiphany Meeting at St. James's Church, on the evening of January 23rd, was addressed by the Bishop of Alaska, and the Rev. Robert Kimber. The Lenten Meeting, on the afternoon of March 6th, was held in the Church of the Holy Trinity, and on this occasion the speakers were: the Rev. F. W. Merrill, the Rev. J. J. P. Perry, the Bishop of Boise, and Mr. John Wood.

The Committee will never rest satisfied until the day comes when all the Parishes and Missions in the Diocese, no matter how small and feeble they may be, have representation in every Branch of the Woman's Auxiliary.

The Committee desires to put on record its appreciation of the effective work done by one of its Members, Mrs. George C. Thomas, not only in the arduous office of Treasurer of the United Offering, but for the remarkable skill she showed in carrying to its completion the Memorial Fund in memory of Mrs. Twing—which, although “a labor of love,” necessitated much thought, time, and ability.

The Committee has had great pleasure in electing to the office of Vice President, Mrs. Alexander Mackay-Smith, whom they gladly welcome among their number, and to whom they will look for the same wisdom and zeal in Philadelphia, which have characterized her work in Washington.

Mary A. E. Twing.

Minute Adopted by a Rising Vote at the Annual Meeting of the Pennsylvania Branch Woman's Auxiliary, November 15, 1901.

WHEREAS, It has pleased our Heavenly Father to call to the rest of Paradise, our friend and fellow laborer, Mrs. Mary Abbott Emery Twing, the late Honorary Secretary of the Woman's Auxiliary.

Resolved, That the Pennsylvania Branch unites with all the others in its grateful memories of what Mrs. Twing has accomplished. She was truly the Mother of the Auxiliary, and for the thirty years of its existence, she served it, and loved it with all her heart. She had gone to San Francisco full of enthusiasm in the part that the Auxiliary was to take there. She was spared to be present at the Great Thanksgiving Service, and to rejoice at the Mighty Offering. She also had her place in all the meetings of the Auxiliary, and never forsook it, until through illness, she could no longer work. A few days of suffering followed, and then suddenly, "she was not, for God took her." She passed from her earthly service to "the rest that remaineth to the people of God." No one who attended her funeral, could have failed to have been touched, by the surpassing tribute to her sterling worth, paid by the attendance of Bishops, Clergy and laity of the Convention, and Members of the Woman's Auxiliary, representing almost every Branch of it. At no other time could such an assemblage have gathered in respectful regard. The thought in every heart must have been, "Let me die the death of the righteous, and let my last end be like hers."

Resolved, That a copy of the above be sent to her bereaved family with the assurance of the deep sympathy of this Diocesan Branch of the Auxiliary.

THIRTY-SIXTH ANNUAL REPORT
OF THE
INDIANS' HOPE ASSOCIATION.

During the past year fewer new Parishes have joined the Association than usual, yet the meetings have been larger than ever, owing to regularity in attendance on the part of delegates, and to the addition of the Junior Auxiliary. Sixty-six Parishes take part in the work of the Indians' Hope Association,—less than half of the number in the Diocese ;—a painful fact.

Annual Dues (toward expenses of the Association,—printing, postage, &c.) were given up, and Voluntary Contributions have taken their place, with the result that all expenses are paid, even leaving a surplus.

We have sent less to the Board of Missions this year than last—only deserving our name *Auxiliary to the Board of Missions* by \$685.25.

In Scholarships, however, with \$1,290, we have done far better than last year. One Parish alone supports a promising young Indian at Seabury Divinity School, and we have a new Scholarship of \$100 for Anvik, Alaska.

All the special work we planned has been accomplished. Besides, we sent twenty-two mattresses needed at St. Paul's School (for boys), Deadwood, South Dakota ; \$100 to Miss Thackara's Hospital, among Navajo Indians, near Ft. Defiance, Arizona, toward providing a salary for a resident physician and surgeon ;—\$50 to Archdeacon Appleby, of Duluth, toward building three chapels and three small houses for Indian deacons among the heathen ;—and \$126 toward the memorial to Mrs. A. T. Twing—the addition to St. Mary's Hall, Shanghai, China.

The Box Report is several hundred dollars beyond that of last year. Bishop Hare says : "There is no better work done than sending boxes." Fourteen Catechists received them in South Dakota, and two in Alaska. The Oneida Hospital alone received \$455 worth of various supplies needed. The report is interesting throughout.

"A friend of Missions" gave \$1000 through Mrs. George C. Thomas, to be used as the Indians' Hope saw best. South Dakota and Alaska were calling for immediate help, and \$500 were sent to each.

According to suggestion, that Eastern Branches of the Women's Auxiliary on Indian work might have an annual sale for Indian lace and curios, the Indian Hope Association held such a sale on March 19th, at the Church House.

We have heard from the following speakers:—Rev. F. W. Merrill, missionary to the Oneidas, Wis., who told of the Hospital, and of a Creamery started among the Oneidas toward the Mission's future self-support,—Bishop Rowe, who needs an Operating Room and outfit for the Hospital at Skagway, and to build several chapels, and some little houses,—Miss Thackara, who spoke of her Hospital among the Navajos, near Fort Defiance, Arizona, where a resident physician-surgeon is needed,—and Dr. A. S. Lloyd, general secretary of the Board of Missions, who said that his two weeks' visit to South Dakota last November "did not begin to show but a small part of that which is almost without a parallel in Missionary work." Dr. Lloyd contrasted the Government School, with electric light and mechanical contrivances for heating, cooking, washing, etc., with Bishop Hare's Church Boarding Schools, where a thorough Christian, but simple home-training is given, and where every child is baptized. In the homes of the old pupils, he saw the results of the training.

Owing to the sudden change of interpretation of the law, the Commissioner of Indian Affairs has withdrawn all rations from pupils attending Church boarding-schools, thus necessitating the raising of \$8,000 a year additional, for their support. This is a burden which Bishop Hare is unable to bear, and unless the Church comes to his assistance, St. John's School will be closed on September 1st.

Ought the \$8,000 be too much for such a Diocese as Pennsylvania to raise?

TWENTY-EIGHTH ANNUAL REPORT.

The year of work is ended, and I must tell you what we have accomplished. In the Treasurer's Report, we miss the munificent gift made last year of \$10,000 for church buildings in Manila—but we have had some splendid donations this year also, two of \$1,000 each, and one of \$800. How they stimulate and encourage us, and how they rejoice our hearts! GOD bless the givers!

Our Treasurer has received \$5,906.47. \$869.20 has been sent direct by the Parishes, \$2,447.27 has been received at the Church Missions House, as from the Pennsylvania Branch of the Woman's Auxiliary for Domestic Work, which Miss Emery will credit to us. \$540.73 has been added to the fund (which completes it) for the Endowment of the Sarah Neilson in Memoriam Scholarship, in St. Mary's College, at Dallas, Texas—making \$9,757.94. While the added value of 135 boxes—\$13,508.35—gives a total of \$23,272.02. Of this large sum, only \$1,603 aids the Board in meeting its appropriations,

and the whole Woman's Auxiliary in the pledge made in San Francisco of \$100,000 a year. May we do better in this respect another season! The primary object in creating the Woman's Auxiliary is "to increase the funds of the Board." And my darling project that Pennsylvania may pay through us, the salary of one Missionary Bishop, still waits accomplishment. Six new ones have been made. It would seem as if our help would be most timely.

Our Annual Meeting was held on November 15, from which, alas! our dear Bishop was carried, overcome by his labors. The Bishop of Texas was our chosen speaker. By the courtesy of the Foreign Committee, the Bishop of Alaska was given the opportunity to make an address at the Epiphany Meeting, and at the Lenten one, the Bishop of Boise made many friends by his forcible presentation of his work.

Our Monthly Meetings have been visited by many friends. Miss Coles came to tell us of the Memorial proposed to the lamented Mrs. Twing. As there was a Special Treasurer for this fund, the Members of the Committee were urged to contribute, through her, and a reference to that Special Report will show that many of them did so generously. The Rev. Andreas Bard came to us to present the need of help in Educational Work in Olympia. The Rev. Octavius Parker came in the interest of the district of Sacramento. The Bishop of Los Angeles and the Bishop of Arkansas spread before us splendid opportunities in their Dioceses, and Miss Sabine has told us of the joys of her work in Alaska. Every one of them have received substantial aid. The crowning delight of our year, however, has been the completion of the Endowment Fund of the In Memoriam Scholarship in St. Mary's College, Dallas, Texas, the yearly fees of which (\$300) had been so faithfully paid for nine years. Last October I wrote to the Bishop of Dallas that we had in hand \$2,500 of the needed \$3,000. He quickly replied to ask our permission to invest it in building a Cottage Infirmary for the College, saying that its largely increased number of pupils had quite overrun the space allotted to invalids, so that he had been obliged to rent a cottage outside for them. He said that "he would gladly wait for the balance," (which, however, was soon sent to him), adding: "The College would also always most

gladly take a pupil, the daughter of a poor Missionary, on that foundation, thus making the investment pay double interest." To make a perfect gift, one dear friend sent a check of \$800 to furnish the building, and the Members of this Committee gave \$130 to buy the blankets, spreads and house linen, so that as soon as the builders had completed their task, the Infirmary was fitted for use, and very soon after, patients were in it.

Many an invalid will there find quiet and comfort, and have reason to bless you, who have helped to provide it. A brass tablet in the hall of the building records the fact that a Scholarship in Saint Mary's College is endowed to the glory of God, and in loving memory of Sarah Neilson.

It is impossible for me to find words to tell you of my happiness that this has been accomplished, nor of my deep and lasting gratitude to all of you who have done it. I can never repay you, but your compensation will be a constant rejoicing with me, that GOD has so blessed our efforts that one of the daughters of our poorly-paid Missionaries is, through you, enjoying the blessings of a Christian education.

The great event of the year to the Church was the meeting of the General Convention on the borders of the Pacific, and wonderful to say, the attendance upon it and the meetings of the Woman's Auxiliary surpassed in numbers all former records. Had you been present at the great Triennial Meeting which followed the Thanksgiving Service, waiting to hear what was the sum of the Women's Thank Offering, you would not have wondered, when the Treasurer had said \$104,000, at the high key struck, in singing the Doxology—not waiting to hear of anything so small as hundreds! (Tardy ones have swelled the sum to \$107,027.23). This was the occasion when we were asked to give, annually, \$100,000 to help the Board meet its appropriations, and, flushed with success, we said: "We will do it!" Six months have gone of the gathering time for the next Thank Offering. Pennsylvania gave last year \$16,576.10. Let us do better in 1904. We have carried the banner too long to yield it. What a high privilege was mine to have gone to San Francisco! Had I never loved Missions before, I must love them now, or be insensate. Passing through ten of the Missionary Districts and many

Dioceses, almost as destitute as they are, I had object lessons enough to make me more eager to help than I had ever been before. How great is the need for Church Boarding Schools, where from the scattered hamlets and villages, and the wild ranches, the children of the natives could be gathered and trained as Christian men and women, and how soon in their turn, to train their children—and the little churches too widely distant from each other. What untold blessings must they be to the poor souls, far away from home and people, perhaps. What would they do without the light of the everlasting Gospel? Dear friends, let us think of them in their isolation and struggles and help them when we can. It was a joy to me to remember that five little churches had been built from the means sent by this Committee.

It came to pass that in the height of our jubilation in the beautiful city, at the Golden Gate, the mother of the Woman's Auxiliary, Mrs. Mary Abbott Emery Twing, after a few days of illness, entered into that "rest that remaineth to the people of God." The outpouring of sorrow was universal. Her funeral, the most wonderful one ever seen, was attended by the whole Convention, and the Woman's Auxiliary as chief mourners. She will never be forgotten. With grateful hearts that we are spared, let us work heartily "while it is day, for the night cometh when no man can work."

Pennsylvania Branch of Woman's Auxiliary.

1901—1902.

Amid shadow and sunshine has the last year swiftly glided by.

In October we were all saddened by hearing the news of the death of our warm friend, the Honorary Secretary of the Woman's Auxiliary, Mrs. Mary Twing, who, in the midst of her unceasing efforts for the spread of Christ's Kingdom on Earth, was called to His Kingdom in Heaven, but the love and appreciation of her beautiful life was shown by the ready response made by nearly all our Parish Branches to help raise our share of the fifteen thousand dollars, (\$15,000) which is being used to erect a Memorial Building at St. Mary's School, Shanghai, China.

Our President has, as usual, made our nine monthly meetings most interesting by giving us the opportunity of hearing not only many letters, but also many laborers, directly from the foreign field, and surely never before have we had such encouraging reports to spur us on to renewed efforts to help those who are bearing "the burden and heat of the day."

What could be more inspiring than Bishop McKim's account of the work of the native Woman's Auxiliary in Japan, and of their support of a foreign missionary in Formosa, their own former Vice-President, or to hear Miss Bull tell of the seventy young girls at St. Agnes' School, Kyoto, who are asking to be baptised, or again to hear Rev. Mr. Forrester tell of the wonderful progress made by the Mexican girls in Mrs. Hooker's School, and the power for good that each graduate from that school is in the community in which she lives ; and again from Miss Higgins and Mrs. Moort, of the adaptability of the African boy and girl, and what can be accomplished by Industrial and Manual Schools in the Dark Continent.

On the other, the shadow side, our consciences were

touched when Miss Higgins told us of the sad time it was in her school when word came from New York that twenty-five scholarships had not been paid and thus twenty-five boys had to be sent back to their heathen homes ; or when Dr. Powers told us that Mr. Duarte would probably have to close his school at Matanzas, because the Church at home could not send the \$4,500 a year necessary to educate and Christianize the fifty-eight little Cuban orphan girls under his care ; and last month rumors reached us that Mrs. Hooker's school may have to be closed for the same reason.

On the sunshine part of our report comes the good news that all our pledges have been paid and we have relieved the Bishop's mind by paying off the indebtedness for church furniture for Bolondron, Cuba, also by the generosity of an anonymous donor of a \$1000 check, we have been enabled to send substantial help to Japan, Africa, Mexico and Brazil.

We have also been fortunate in securing an Assistant Treasurer, Miss Blackiston, who will greatly relieve our most faithful and efficient treasurer, whose clear business-like statements often prevent our appropriating the sums, large or small, entrusted to us by our Parish Branches to specials, so dear to our hearts, before fulfilling our part in the pledges which not only help the Auxiliary, but the Board of Missions, and in a circular sent forth by Miss Emery, we are asked to give more and more for specified objects, such as the salaries of women workers, foreign scholarships, etc.

Such in brief is our report for the last year, and now at this blessed Ascensiontide, as we remember that our Lord's last wish on earth was a Missionary wish, should it not be the first wish of us His children ? And if it be even so, should we not each of us make this Missionary effort of ours more of a spiritual idea, pray more for it both individually and in united prayer and resolve :—

To put it first 'Twill draw us close,
To put it first The rest will follow,
To put it first 'Twill bless our life,
To put it first Where Jesus put it,
To put it first 'Tis God's own plan,
To put it first And no surrender,
To put it first Put Christ's Missions in the van.

Report for 1901-1902.

During the past year we have had reason for encouragement with regard to our work in Cuba. A small stone Church seating about two hundred persons has been built at Bolondron, the lot and material and part of the labor having been given by the people. This Church is under the charge of the Rev. Mr. Moreno.

In Havana, a Mission under the charge of the Rev. Mr. McGee, is at present holding services in a warehouse. A lot has been purchased in the Vedado, on which it is hoped a chapel can soon be built. At Jesus del Monte, a suburb of Havana, a small but flourishing Mission is under the charge of the Rev. Mr. Pena; the Sunday school has thirty-two members. A day school is also under the same supervision.

In Matanzas, the Rev. Mr. Duarte is still doing good work. An Orphanage with fifty-eight little girls is connected with this Mission. Five of the older girls have entered a Nurses' Training School, thus, for this year, solving the question as to what is to become of them on leaving school. A day school under the same supervision numbers about one hun-

dred and seventy scholars, all of whom attend the Sunday school. In all we have five clergymen, five women workers, five stations, (including the prospective one in the Vedada,) two schools, one orphanage, and about three hundred communicants.

Report for the Year 1901—1902.

Another year has passed, and again it is time for your Secretary to make her report. It is a satisfaction to feel that there is ground for encouragement in the Committee, which is the youngest in the Auxiliary.

The number of delegates has increased, four more parishes being represented this year over last, and we have had a much better attendance at the meetings. With regard to the work done, the salary of the lay helper, who took the place of the Deaconess, at Kensington, has been pledged for the year by the Committee, and the same missions assisted as heretofore, with the addition of the Deaf Mutes' Mission and St. George's Mission, under the care of the Rev. A. J. Arkin. The last named mission seemed to arouse widespread interest among the delegates, which was shown by substantial aid, both in the way of money and boxes.

According to our Treasurer's report, the amount of money given in the Diocese this year has been \$3124.12, which amounts to \$965.91 more than last year, and is due to a donation from a kind friend of missions, who sent to the Committee anonymously the gift of \$1000. The value of boxes sent is \$1768.35.

The sad loss by fire of the Church of the Crucifixion has called forth the sympathy and efforts of the Committee on

its behalf, and we trust that other aid will be forthcoming to enable the parish to shortly rebuild its church, which was doing such a splendid work for the colored population of the city.

It has seemed this year as though our assistance had been given in and about the city, rather than to country parishes, but the reason is not far to seek, and lies in these few words of our Saviour, "Ask and it shall be given unto you," for the appeals from country parishes have been few this year, and either there is little need, or the work of our Committee is not understood to be for the assistance of weak country parishes, as well as for that of missions in the city.

We are not content to do a little for our Master, but we want to increase yet more and more, and be His faithful, earnest servants in spreading His kingdom.

Second Annual Report.

It is impossible to give a correct report of the work of the Junior Department during the past year as only about half of the Branches have sent in reports.

About seven new Branches have been added during the year, making a total of forty.

An enthusiastic attendance at the Second Annual Conference in the Church House, on April 29th, in spite of rain, was most encouraging. Miss Jarvis spoke delightfully, and was good enough to answer many questions which had been puzzling some Branches. Those present at the Conference voted to raise two scholarships from Pennsylvania Juniors, one for Alaska and one for Africa.

A fund has been started for purchasing a magic lantern and slides, to belong to Pennsylvania Juniors, which we hope will arouse interest in Missions throughout the Diocese, and that all Parishes will take advantage of the opportunity of having a share in the ownership.

It is hoped that Branches will send their contributions for these three objects early in the season.
