EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE.

Report.

The chief event of the past year has been the Missionary Council, which assembled in Philadelphia in October, and which was marked to an unusual degree by earnestness and interest.

The Annual Meeting of our Branch of the Woman's Auxiliary was held on Friday, October 24, in the Church of the Holy Apostles, but the House of Bishops being in session, neither of our own Bishops could be present, except at the Holy Communion service, where Bishop Mackay-Smith made a most helpful address. The Rev. Nathaniel Thomas presided, and Bishop Mann spoke on Diocesan Missions, Bishop Van Buren on the work in Porto Rico, and the Rev. Philip Deloria on "The Three Things which Delivered Him from the Old Way," and on his work in South Dakota. The roll call showed 73 parishes represented by 306 members, besides many visitors who were here for the Council. Later, in the Sunday School room, Miss Sybil Carter, Miss Deane and Miss Emery made addresses, and then all adjourned to Battalion Hall for luncheon. In the afternoon, Bishop Brewer and others made earnest appeals.

A general meeting in behalf of Foreign and Domestic Missions was also held on the evening of January 29, at the Church of the Holy Trinity, with addresses by Bishop Whitaker, Bishop Wells and the Rev. Dr. Lloyd.

Believing that greater zeal will be kindled by fuller knowledge, this Committee hopes in the future, by united and systematic effort, through the holding of "Mission Study Classes," and other means, to diffuse missionary intelligence and to increase missionary activity to the spiritual uplifting of the women of this Diocese.

INDIANS' HOPE ASSOCIATION.

Thirty-seventh Annual Report.

The Indians' Hope closes its thirty-seventh year with its regular record of "aid to the Church Work in behalf of the Indians throughout the United States."

In addition to its long-continued interest in Bishop Hare's work, it has this year reached farther afield than ever, and entirely new upon its list are: Bishop Funston, of Idaho; Bishop Johnson, of Los Angeles; Bishop Morrison, of Duluth, Minn.

To the General Fund, through Mr. George C. Thomas, Treasurer, it has contributed \$2,102.10—about \$200 more than last year, and to specials, \$1,914.05. In this list of specials, whilst, among many others, its old friends the Oneidas—the Lace Workers—and the Indian newspaper, *Ampao*, are not forgotten, the chief apportionment is to the "Increase of Catechists' salaries." To this the Indians' Hope has contributed \$500. The withdrawing of Government rations obliges Bishop Hare to raise yearly the sum of \$3,900 in order to increase the stipends of his sixty-five Catechists to meet their increased living expenses.

The Indians' Hope has greatly regretted the enforced absence of its President, as Mrs. Markoe has been able to attend only one meeting. Its nine Monthly Meetings have been full of interest and addressed by some inspiring speakers. Bishop Hare has come twice; also Bishop Brooke, Mr. Ashley and Mr. Deloria, who is an Indian clergyman.

Mr. Wood, Corresponding Secretary to the Board of Missions, described his visit to the Indian Convention in South Dakota, at

which the Indians contributed \$2,400 to Foreign and Domestic Missions. Miss Stockdell, who represented Bishop Funston, gave an interesting account of her work among the Lemhi Indians.

A sale of lace made by Indian women has again been held in the Church House, which realized \$302.10, besides which bead work and other articles were sold, which amounted to \$278.15 additional.

It must be recorded with sorrow that Bishop Hare was unable to reopen two of his boarding-schools—St. John's and St. Paul's—last September. The withdrawing of Government rations greatly increased their living expenses and the Church at large did not sustain him in this additional burden.

In view of the enlarged work, which calls for larger efforts, and the desire which must be felt by all members of the Indians' Hope that Bishop Hare's declining years should be crowned with the peace which his life of noble exertion deserves, let the motto for the next year be "Go Forward!"

Twenty-ninth Annual Report.

It is time for the Annual Report. The Executive Committee has enjoined me to make it brief, being convinced that it is not seemly to spend too much money on the printer's bill. The same consideration has influenced the members of this Committee to decide against printing the list of its delegates, a list of which we are very proud, and yet in which there are such frequent changes as to make it unreliable.

The monthly meetings have been held as usual. At first the change of day seemed to affect the attendance, but by this time we have become accustomed to it.

We have had very many messages from the field, from the lips and the letters of the Missionaries, and the Committee has made very generous response to them.

One hundred and forty-four boxes have been sent away, valued at \$12,590.39. Parishes have reported, also, gifts in money to the amount of \$549.42. Five thousand eight hundred and twenty-nine dollars and thirteen cents has passed through our Treasurer's hands, which added to what the donors sent to New York direct, \$2,521.50, makes a grand total of \$21,490.44, including the valuation of the boxes. This is less than it was last year, when the endowment of the Memorial Scholarship added \$3,000 to it, but if we have all done what we could, the dear Lord will bless us.

Of one thing I become more and more anxious, as the needs of the Board increase with the work, and that is that we grow to be more truly the Auxiliary to it. Since 1892 I have tried to have the Committee give the salary of one Missionary Bishop, but so far I have failed each year. We have several times had munificent gifts of \$1,000 towards this object, and this year, one also of \$200, but we are still nearly \$1,000 short of the whole sum. Will not the delegates endeavor next season to secure the co-operation of their Parishes in this effort? I must not omit to thank those who have faithfully contributed all these years. I honor them for their patient continuance in well doing, and I deeply appreciate their help.

The Girls' Friendly Society is proving itself a valuable ally, and we desire to express our satisfaction at counting among our helpers such a noble body of young people. May they grow in grace.

With loving greetings I submit this report, grateful for what we have been permitted to do, and looking hopefully to the future.

FOREIGN COMMITTEE.

Report for the Year 1902-1903.

During the past year the Foreign Branch of the Woman's Auxiliary has held its nine regular meetings with large and interested attendance.

What formerly were called annual dues towards the Foreign Insurance and Contingent Funds, having been discontinued, we were able to urge every Parish in the Diocese to join us, and the few new branches added are most valuable; for what we greatly need is the "up-lift" that can only come from united interest and prayer.

There have been present at our meetings, delegates from over eighty Parishes.

All our pledges are paid, but little new or outside work has been done, owing to the thought presented to us constantly by our faithful President and Vice-President, and by an inspiring talk from Miss Emery in February, that we must bear our part in the effort being made by the whole Auxiliary to contribute \$100,000 towards the appropriations of the Board of Missions. This year Pennsylvania's share is \$15,339; and in May we hope to report a large contribution as having been sent by our branch.

The question whether secular or Christian civilization shall enter China, was discussed by Rev. Mr. Ridgley and Mr. Cooper, and conclusively answered by their showing how much better the latter is, and what can be done by the Church, if only men and means are sent. The same crying need of helpers came to us in the cheering talks from Mrs. Cooper and Miss Dodson, of work at Shanghai, in college, orphanage and dispensary.

Dr. Powers testified to the fine work being done at the church at Bolendron, Cuba, and thanked us again for the chancel furniture which we sent last year. Miss Schott told us encouraging news of Mexico, and our own especial missionary, Miss Babcock, for whose support we are largely responsible, closed our year in April by telling of her five years' work in Japan, and of that interesting and receptive people.

With great regret were we obliged to accept the resignation of our faithful Treasurer, Miss Riegel, who for eight years has

served us so efficiently; Miss Blakiston, her assistant, takes her place, with Mrs. Pancoast as assistant.

To all of us, we think, the meetings have been helpful, but do we daily work for our branch of the Auxiliary?

Do we try to interest other Parishes and help them to form new branches? Will we not, each of us, resolve, not only to pray to the Lord of the vineyard to send forth more laborers, but to *work* for that result? In this age of woman's work, is not this, and much more expected of us?

So let us go forth remembering to *be strong*.

"We are not here to play, to dream, to drift.

We have hard work to do and loads to lift.

Shun not the struggle: face it—"Tis God's gift."

Report for the Year 1902-1903.

During the past year, although, in regard to a portion of our work, cares and perplexities have harassed us, we have now reason to believe that it is established on a firmer basis than ever before, and that we may look forward hopefully to satisfactory results.

The orphanage has been moved from Matanzas to Havana, where fifteen little girls are established in a comfortable home under the supervision of a Board of Ladies, of which Mrs. Farres is President. Mr. Sharpe is now teaching in the orphanage, but it is hoped soon to have a permanent teacher. Mr. Planas has charge of the Mission in Matanzas. The work of Rev. Mr. McGee in Havana is very successful, the attendance at his services averaging about one hundred and fifty, which is larger than that of any other congregation in the city. A church building is much needed here, the congregation now meeting in a large room on the third floor of a warehouse.

Mr. Pena's health has been seriously affected, and it was

feared that he would not be able to continue the good work which he has done at Jesus del Monte, but improved health gives good reason to hope that he will soon be able to resume the care of that Mission. The Mission at Bolondròn, under the charge of the Rev. Mr. Moreno, is doing excellent work.

We have every reason to believe that the prospects of the Mission are most encouraging, and that want of means alone can prevent our accomplishing great results.

Report for the Year 1902-1903.

Once more we are called upon to render an account of our stewardship, and of what we have accomplished in the past year, in aid of our colored brethren in the South—for they are our brethren and most especially entitled to our help, in fighting the hard battle which the once burning zeal of the white man made inevitable, when he set the negro free. How much of this zeal remains? How much of this help has been given? These are questions which it behooves us to ask ourselves, "lest we forget" and heedless of our responsibility, leave them to the acquisition of that little knowledge which is a dangerous thing, for them and for us.

Our work which is not popular, even among good people, has been steadily progressing. We have sent boxes to the families of Missionaries working in the colored field; we have helped individuals in many ways; we have sent sums of money according to our means, always limited, to aid different Missions.

We have also paid scholarships in our Church schools, St. Augustine's, Raleigh, N. C., and St. Paul's, Lawrenceville, Va. I must say here a word for those excellent Church schools, struggling and striving, working and accomplishing much, but alas, far less than would be accomplished, were all Church people to give their gifts to them, rather than to the large, flourishing and more interesting schools at Hampton and Tuskegee. They and their noble founders are worthy of all praise, it is true, but let it be remembered that our comparatively small and struggling schools might attain the same eminence and usefulness had they the same support, which they surely have a right to claim from our own Church people.

In regard to the sum total of our receipts, I would call attention to an apparent falling off of \$1,000 this year, and state that it is only because of the generous anonymous gift of last year, which was sent to Bishop Brown, of Arkansas, who made good use of it in establishing two Mission Chapels for his colored people.

And now in conclusion, let me remind you that our field is

"the South," a wide area, and we can only hope to do lasting good by recognizing the necessity for zealous labor, and untiring efforts and by resolutely, as good citizens, no less than good Christians, setting ourselves to accomplish the same.

DIOCESAN COMMITTEE.

Report for the Year 1902-1903.

Much to our regret, early in the winter the Diocesan Committee was deprived of the valuable assistance of its Secretary, Mrs. James Cheston, who through illness was prevented from attending the meetings. She was greatly missed.

The Secretary *pro-tem*, appointed by the President, feels that she has but imperfectly filled the Secretary's place. She reports with pleasure the growth of interest in the Committee's undertakings. The outlook for increased zeal and usefulness is encouraging.

All the work begun last year has been continued, and the salary of Miss Kelly's helper has been pledged for another year, as well as a small sum as a beginning, towards enlarging the quarters of the Day Nursery under Miss Hamilton's care. Material aid has been given towards a Summer Home for poor colored people under the charge of the Rev. H. L. Phillips, of the Church of the Crucifixion.

The Committee's aid has been chiefly given to work within the city limits, although it holds itself in readiness gladly to answer, in so far as it is able, any appeals from country Parishes in the Diocese of Pennsylvania.

The Treasurer reports money contributed, \$1,983.31; value of boxes and parcels sent, \$1,942.05.
