EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE.

Report.

During the past winter the Executive Committee of the Pennsylvania Branch of the Woman's Auxiliary arranged for two public meetings and a Conference. As a further development of its work a Missions Study Class was formed.

The Annual Meeting was held on November 13 in the Church of St. Luke and the Epiphany. Bishop Mackay-Smith presided and made the opening address. The Bishop of Honolulu sketched the history of missions in Hawaii and the present needs of the work. The roll call showed 78 parishes were represented by 279 members. A conference was held at noon in the Chapel, when urgent appeals were made by the Rev. Mr. Goodheart, Miss Thacher and Miss Mahony. In the afternoon the Rev. Nathaniel Thomas spoke on "Diocesan Missions," Archdeacon Pollard on "Colored Missions," the Bishop of Olympia on "Domestic Missions," the Rev. Dr. Pott on "Educational Work in China" and the Rev. Sherman Coolidge on "Indian Missions." The day was marked throughout by a spirit of earnestness and consecration.

The Epiphany Meeting was held in St. Luke's Church, Germantown, on January 29, when Bishop Mackay-Smith made a strong and eloquent appeal for Foreign Missions, and the Rev. Dr. Joshua Kimber spoke in detail of our work in other lands.

On February 16 a Conference of Parish Officers was held in the Church House, in order to increase missionary interest and discuss methods of work. Miss Emery was present and made helpful suggestions. The attendance was large and the meeting interesting.

In the belief that nothing is more conducive to missionary zeal than a thorough knowledge of the mission field, a Missions Study Class was organized and met for a course of eight lessons under the leadership of Miss Shearman. The members of the class found the subject of Japan most absorbing and inspiring. In several parishes similar classes were formed, and in three instances they are planning to continue their pleasant work next winter. The more we study the conditions of spiritual ignorance, indifference and darkness in our own land and throughout the world, the more diligently will we strive to spread the knowledge of Christianity, which has been and shall ever be "the path of a shining light which shineth more and more unto the perfect day."

INDIANS' HOPE ASSOCIATION.

Thirty-eighth Annual Report.

The Indians' Hope opened its work for 1903-1904 with a variation in its method of sending notices; it having been determined to send out but one set of postals, giving dates of all the meetings, it was decided later to send additional postals and to publish notices in the papers whenever visiting Bishops or speakers were to be present, and this calls our attention to the important subject of attendance. Our roll numbers 72 parishes, sending 145 delegates, and our attendance at the nine monthly meetings has varied from 22 at the May meeting (which occurred unfortunately on Decoration Day) to 78, the average having been 52. This cannot be considered large enough; it is several years since our Treasurer pointed out that money and interest flow in exact proportion to our knowledge

of each subject, let us therefore make an earnest effort to have a large and regular attendance next year.

Our work accomplished has been up to our standard, though the money raised is a little behind what we raised last year, the difference is chiefly due to the loss of several large individual gifts. We have raised \$3,518.26. Part of which goes to the Board of Missions in New York for salaries of missionaries, and \$1,588.85 to our sixteen "special" objects, all of which have been fulfilled, and the money apportioned between Bishop Hare, the Oneidas, Bishop Leonard (whose sudden death the Church has such reason to deplore), Bishop Brooke, of Oklahoma; Bishop Gray, of Southern Florida; Bishop Rowe, of Alaska; Bishop Funston, of Boise, and Bishop Moreland, of Sacramento.

The Box Committee report twenty-eight excellent boxes sent out, value \$3,415.59.

The Indians' Hope records with sorrow the long and severe illness of Bishop Hare, in whose field its chief interest has long been centered, and who has visited us at two meetings during the season. We have also had interesting addresses from Mrs. Coolidge and Bishop Funston. It is encouraging to consider the general progress of the Indians. Bishop Hare said that the pioneer work in his field was over, and our duty is now, chiefly, the strengthening and upholding of those already started in the right way.

Their noble and generous offerings at their convocation, and the organized work and special offerings of the Indian women, cannot be too highly praised.

Miss Carter's ten schools for teaching lace making are doing a splendid work. The Indian women are doing marvelously beautiful work, the best of which will be sent to the World's Fair at St. Louis, and be exhibited in the Industries Building. Fifty orders were received at a sale in New York, the value of which will amount to over \$2,300. This covers the materials and wages to the Indian women, but does not include the teachers' salaries. Those are appealed for from the generosity of church women, and all money for "lace workers" should be sent to Miss Sybil Carter, Church Missions House, New York.

With such encouragement in the present let us "go forward" with renewed zeal in the future.

Twenty-ninth Annual Report.

I come to you to-day, with the Annual Report, with a heavy heart, for must I say it? our summary is far less than usual. I hope that this may be accounted for in the increase in the other committees and then it will be well, for the work is to the one end. I could never endure the thought that Pennsylvania had forgotten her proud place among the Dioceses.

I have only the report of 102 boxes, valued at \$9,786.84. The Treasurer has received \$6,291.31. Parishes have sent direct \$286 and to the treasury in New York \$1,246.45, making a total of \$17,610.70; a goodly sum, truly, but over \$3,000 less than last year's gifts in money and boxes.

It is very hard for me to tell this, but as it is true, I must not shrink from saying it. I do not grieve over our giving fewer missionary boxes, because I have each year rejoiced over the increase in gifts in money, but we have even in this fallen below last season. May we do better another year. One aim I long to keep ever before us, and that is direct aid to the Board in its appropriations. Since 1892 I have been trying to have this committee relieve it of the salary of one Missionary Bishop, with the sorrowful result of our paying about one-half of it. Of course, I do not know now how far the other branches are helping, nor what the other Pennsylvania committees have done, but *we* have given less than \$1,800 toward the \$100,000 expected from the Woman's Auxiliary. It does not seem to me to be our full share.

We have heard during the season from Bishop Keator and Bishop Restarick at the annual meeting; from Bishop Wells and Bishop Brown, from Archdeacons Hughson and Appleby, the Rev. T. C. Wetmore and Mrs. Hughson at the monthly meetings, all of whom must have stirred our zeal and enhanced our interest in Domestic Missions. Truly, "the harvest is great and the laborers are few."

We have filled our various pledges, have scattered help over many fields and sent cheer to many homes. The splendid liberality of some of the parishes and individuals among us has been a stimulus and delight, not only to their beneficiaries, but to us, in passing; for all this your President begs you to receive her grateful thanks, as she submits this Report.

FOREIGN COMMITTEE.

Report for the Year.

During the past year the nine regular meetings of the Foreign Branch of the Woman's Auxiliary have been most encouraging and inspiring. There has seemed to breathe through the meetings a feeling of oneness in the deep and intensely earnest interest manifested.

Over seventy-two parishes have been represented, and on an average there have been seventy delegates present.

All our pledges are paid, and we have not only sent \$50 over and above our pledges to the Board of Missions toward the

insurance fund of our foreign missionaries, but have also given another \$50 for the Rev. Fleming James' insurance. We can rejoice that our portion was added to the amount raised for the Foreign Insurance Fund, and that Bishop Ingle heard before his death that his clergy, too, should receive their insurance, that thus he need not give up his own insurance as he proposed; and so one of the many harassing worries pressing on him was lifted. We have also sent, amongst other specials, \$100 to furnish a room in St. Luke's Hospital, Shanghai, as a memorial to Bishop Ingle. Our donations toward the \$100,000 that Miss Emery hopes the whole Auxiliary will give yearly to the Board of Missions was \$1,764.

We have been fortunate in hearing several most interesting accounts of the work in the field. Dr. and Mrs. Pott each telling in their own way of the work in China, and the great need of the new building for St. John's College. Mrs. Pott delightfully quaint and naive in the way she described Chinese characteristics, and asked our financial aid in order that Dr. Pott, who traveled incessantly to tell the story and collect the funds, might have at least one week with his aged father before returning to China. Miss Mahony, who has now returned to her beautiful work at Cape Mount to labor alone, "and yet not alone, but with Christ," as she herself said. Mr. Wood who spoke of the great need of hospitals in China, of how there are at present over fifty thousand patients treated in our hospitals and dispensaries there, of the war in the East, which we all deplore, but which if Japan wins makes her the leader of China, the power of the whole East, and so all the more we should try to win Japan for Christ. (Two of the strongest appeals from Japan have been Mr. Ishii's school for feeble-minded children, so heartily endorsed by Bishop McKim, and St. Luke's Hospital, Tokyo.) Dr. Darlington told of the crying need of our work in Cuba, and that the American Church Missionary Society had \$11,000 last year and only \$1,000 this year, and were having in consequence to close up important work begun. "Our help is needed for the poor, superstitious Cubans themselves, for the sake of our own boys crowding there for good business openings, for the sake of the Roman Catholic Church to help her do her best." Bishop Kinsolving, of Brazil, spoke most interestingly of his work, telling us that we now have twenty mission stations in Brazil, ten clergy and five church buildings. He especially pleaded for scholarships for the education of his native clergy.

We accepted the resignation of our valuable Assistant Secretary, Miss Downs, with great regret to lose her from our midst, yet rejoicing for and with her in her happy marriage, and elected Miss Anne M. Hubbard in her place.

In his sermon on "The Heroism of Foreign Missions," Bishop Brooks tells us "The foreign missionary idea is the necessary completion of the Christian life. It is the apex to which all the lines of the pyramid lead up. The Christian life without it is a mangled and imperfect thing. The glory and heroism of Christianity lie in its missionary life." And how can we fail to feel the inspiration of our dying church hero at the front, "who died praying for all, for the Christians in China, for his fellow-workers, for this home church of ours, that it might be filled with a more true missionary spirit." For as Dr. Pott truly puts it, We here at home are entrusted just as much as they are with the extension of Christ's Kingdom in this world. Do we believe it, do we live it? Are we being faithful stewards, "that I may receive mine own with interest?" Can He say to you and me, when called to our eternal home, as surely Bishop Ingle heard, "Well done, good and faithful servant; enter thou into the joy of thy Lord."

Report for the Year.

At the close of this, the nineteenth year of the existence of the Cuban Guild, although we have met with many discouragements, we can feel that much good has been, and still is, being accomplished. At Bolondron, under the care of the Rev. Mr. Moreno, excellent work is being done. At Matanzas, Mr. Planas reports thirty-nine scholars in his school, a number which would, he thought, soon be increased to fifty. This school has become not only self-supporting, but Mr. Planas has been enabled to send a small amount of money to the Treasurer of the Mission at Havana. At Jesus del Monte the work is also in a flourishing condition. The property we have occupied so long as chapel and school can now be purchased, and \$500 of the present balance in the Guild treasury is a recent gift toward this object. After careful consideration as to the best plan for continuing the care of the little girls of the Orphanage, we hope to keep them under the care of Miss Reed for at least another year. Want of means impedes the growth of this most important work. With added means we feel that we would have every encouragement to hope for the rapid growth of God's Kingdom in the Island of Cuba.

The Diocesan Committee reports nine meetings held, as usual, this year, with the average attendance much increased. We are sorry, however, that the attendance of the Juniors has been so small and trust that the coming year they may try to be more regular, as we shall hope to make the meetings of greater interest.

It was with regret that we were obliged to accept the resignation of our President, Mrs. Henry Anstice, and our Secretary, Mrs. James Cheston, they both having served so faithfully in their respective offices. The Bishop appointed our former Vice-President, Mrs. W. W. Sylvester, President, and Mrs. Nathaniel S. Thomas, Secretary, in their places.

Again this year our pledge for the salary of the lay helper at Kensington has been paid, but it grieves us so much that we are now obliged to discontinue it, inasmuch as we have had our work more fully defined, as consisting only of assistance granted to missions and missionaries all the work must now be reported under the head of specials.

We have assumed the support of a woman helper at St. George's Mission, located at the corner of Venango and Edgemont Streets. Most interesting addresses have been delivered by Bishop Mackay-Smith, Miss Esther Kelly, Miss Hamilton, Rev. Mr. Arkin, Rev. Herbert Cook, Rev. N. S. Thomas, Rev. Mr. Burk and Rev. Edgar Cope.

The Treasurer's report shows \$1,074.51 given to various objects, outside of "specials," and the value of boxes \$1,344.66. We have now fifty-three parishes represented in the Diocesan Committee. Cannot each delegate feel a personal responsibility to fill up the membership of this Committee, so that it may be represented by every parish in the Diocese?
