## REPORT.

---

The Fourth Annual Report of the Pittsburgh Branch of the Women's Auxiliary to the Board of Missions, though it may not record a greater number of parishes responding, nor larger sums of money given, shows in some respects an increase of interest. A better knowledge of the objects of the society and places of work has been circulated, much of which is owing to the reports in the Diocesan Chronicle. From this it is hoped to reap fruits in the future.

The monthly meetings, from October to May, inclusive, which have been held during the season, have also been a great aid in sustaining a continuous interest.

The appointment of a larger number of delegates has had good effect, and ensure a much better representation from the city parishes. The plans of work have been improved, and the whole outlook seems encouraging.

The sum of three hundred dollars asked by Miss Emery for the Education Fund, the Life Insurance Fund for Foreign Missionaries, and the support of a teacher to the Freedmen was pledged, almost at once, without difficulty by the following parishes:

The results of the past year seem to give ground for the hope that a growing knowledge of the objects, plans and modes of work of this society would insure its increase and encouragement in this Diocese, as well as in others where it is more flourishing.

It is not so much the large sums of money from a few parishes or individuals that will insure its welfare as the smaller regular, ever increasing gifts for the love of Christ. To these offered in the spirit of faith and love, who knows what fruits may be granted. It is earnestly to be hoped that the weak parishes, which, perhaps, feel that they have not enough beyond their need to be worth offering, will give gladly of that little, trusting that it will be heartily accepted in the spirit in which it is given, not only by a poor human society, but by one who saith, "Inasmuch as ye have done it unto one of the least of these, ye have done it unto me."
