TENTH ANNUAL REPORT
OF
THE WOMAN'S AUXILIARY

To the Board of Missions of Southern Ohio.

In the Autumn of 1871, practical steps were taken towards an organization which would utilize the services of the women of the Church for systematic mission work.

A lady was appointed as Secretary, who, acting under the directions of the General Secretaries at the Bible House, was authorized to unite in one organization all women who were ready to work in any way for Missions. This organization was called the "Woman's Auxiliary to the Board of Missions."

This work first began in Eastern cities, each society acting under the direction of the Secretary in New York.

As Parish societies multiplied, Diocesan branches were formed, in Massachusetts first, then Long Island, New York, and Pennsylvania. Central New York followed; and not long after, in the fall of 1876, Bishop Jaggar expressed a wish that a branch should be organized in this Diocese, and I was appointed to take charge. While I know it requires perseverance, and unceasing labor to direct all the societies in a Diocese, I am equally sure that cordial sympathy is

needed from every Rector, and earnest faithfulness on the part of every woman who joins the ranks. I cannot therefore say too much of the kindness I have received from the Rectors of our several churches, and the loving and ready help shown by every one of my co-workers. During the nine years of our labors, we have gone steadily on, without a single jar to disturb the unity among ourselves. With all other blessings, has come the blessing of peace. With pleasure, I present the report for the year ending May, 1886. We have attempted nothing new, deeming it wiser, in the absence of our Bishop, to complete thoroughly and well the work already undertaken.

Nine new societies have sprung up during the year, which bid fair to give additional life and energy to our Branch. Three are in Parishes where there have been no missionary organizations—Ascension Chapel, Dayton—Trinity Mission, London—and Grace Church, Berkshire.

The "Young Girls," of Trinity Church, Columbus; the "Hospital Aid Chapter," of St. Paul's Church, Cincinnati; the "Pin and Penny Guild," of Grace Church, Avondale; "St. Martin's Guild," Church of Our Saviour, Mt. Auburn; the "Juvenile Society," St. Paul's Church, Columbus; and the "Little Women," of Calvary Church, Clifton, are following the example of the older societies in these Parishes, and are consecrating their youthful energies to the Church's work. I gratefully acknowledge assistance in the preparation of Missionary boxes from the Parish societies of Trinity Church, Columbus; Grace Church, Avondale; and the "Working Band," of the Church of our Saviour, Mt. Auburn.

All our pledges have been paid, and when, last August, an earnest call came to us from the Bible House, for aid in the general work of the Church, we gathered from our scattered forces, in the short space of two weeks, the sum of \$327.68, and forwarded it to the general secretary.

The loving care of *all* our societies is the education of the little Chinese girl, Mai-le, who is in St. Mary's School, Shanghai. At the Epiphany season, each society contributes its mite towards this work, the aggregate amount being sufficient to support what is known to us all as the "Bishop Jaggar Scholarship." Seven of our societies contribute each a small sum towards a scholarship in Bishop Whitaker's school, in Reno, Nevada.

Trinity Church, Columbus, supports the "Frances Huntington" scholarship in an Indian school, the "Margaret Hubbard" scholarship in Japan, and the "Maitie Gray" scholarship in Utah.

Christ Church, Cincinnati, has the "Rev. I. N. Stanger" scholarship in Utah, and the "Rev. J. W. McCarty" scholarship in Africa.

St. Peter's Church, Delaware, supports the "Jennette Platt" scholarship in Africa.

Christ Church, Springfield, supports 2 scholarships in Utah; St. James' Church, Zanesville, the "Rev. Mr. Smallwood" scholarship in China; and Grace Church, Avondale, the "Walter Halsted" scholarship in Africa.
