REPORT OF THE WOMAN'S AUXILIARY.

To the Rt. Rev. Boyd Vincent, Ass't Bishop of the Diocese:

Fifteen years ago, the first annual convention of the Woman's Auxiliary of Southern Ohio met in St. Paul's Church, Chillicothe, at the call of Bishop Jaggar.

This was the first meeting of representative women of the Diocese in aid of the Church's work.

Since that time the organization has not been changed in any respect, the object and methods have remained the same, except so far as its natural growth has enabled us to reach farther, and enlarge our field of labor. With little or no red tape, the organization has shaped itself, relying upon the wise counsel received in its very beginning.

The success cannot only be seen in *figures*, but in the knowledge that one parish after another, here a mission and there a mission, oftentimes just a little band of women have organized for active work, 'till to-day we form throughout the Diocese a complete net work, women and children hand in hand, each one recognizing the obligation laid upon us in Baptism.

The Woman's Auxiliary of Southern Ohio, stands a monument of the wisdom and good judgement of the Bishop who organized, and brought the work into operation. The Almighty Father has knit our hearts and minds together in one communion and fellowship. On the retirement of Bishop Jaggar, and before the election of his successor, my resignation as Director of the Auxiliary was sent to the Ecclesiastical authority of the Diocese, that the new Bishop might feel no embarrassment in making any changes he thought fit in the conduct of the work. Bishop Vincent desired no change, and I was again appointed its Director.

It is gratifying to know that those who enlisted in this work have continued steadfast, and that many who were called together at that first meeting have again met in this church to celebrate their fifteenth anniversary, and find the same Rector continuing his work in the parish.

Some faithful to the end, have finished their work, and have laid their ripened sheaves at the Master's feet. The example of their zeal and constancy has been a stimulant to all who knew them.

Others have come in and filled the vacancies; the gain in numbers has been largely in excess of losses, and the work has steadily enlarged.

Anything that promotes co-operation among our parishes cannot fail to make the Church stronger. The impulse to work together is very powerful. For this reason especially, we are trying to encourage the children—boys as well as girls—to organize themselves for practical Church work. They are *ready*, all that is needed is some one to lead them.

Our love and loyalty to Bishop Kendrick took substantial form at our annual meeting, May, 1891. Each society making a pledge of money to aid him in his work in Arizona and New Mexico. This pledge to be paid annually for five years. The payment the past year was prompt and in excess of the pledges.

We number 63 societies, with an aggregate membership of 2083. We have twenty-four junior societies, three of which, *very* junior, were organized during the past month, and have already sent remittances for our Diocesan work.

The report of work accomplished during the past year will be incomplete, owing to my enforced absence from our annual meeting; several societies having unfortunately postponed until that time, to give me not only money, but value of boxes they have forwarded.

The Fifteenth Annual Meeting of the Woman's Auxiliary of Southern Ohio was held May 10th, 1892, in St. Paul's Church, Chillicothe, Ohio. Mrs. Rochester being unavoidably absent, by her urgent request, Mrs. Van Deman took the presiding chair, and Mrs. Perkins acted as Secretary.

Mrs. Van Deman read an affectionate letter from Mrs. Rochester to the Auxiliary, expressing regret for her detention and making suggestions regarding the Auxiliary work. The entire yearly salary of Miss Carter's teacher of lace work to Indian women, was completed by the addition of the offertory taken at the evening service, and the Auxiliary pledged \$100 toward the salary for the coming year.

Mrs. Rochester's letter reminded the Auxiliary of Bishop Vincent's urgent desire, that it should assume the responsibility for the salary of his Diocesan Missionary, \$1500. This was unanimously assented to, and its *quarterly* payment was promised.

The roll-call showed that many Auxiliary societies were not represented by attending delegates. The reports read from thirty-six Societies showed that one of the Auxiliaries of Christ Church, Cincinnati, had done the most work, but the Church of the Advent, with its many Societies, takes the lead as a Parish, in Missionary work.

A paper on "Church-work among the Deaf," was read, urging the special claim of this work on the Episcopal Church, inasmuch as through its liturgical service religious teaching may find them, which must otherwise be lost to the deaf.

Papers were read on "Girls' Schools in China," and on "New Mexico and Arizona," all of which are held by Mrs. Rochester, to be loaned to any Parish Auxiliaries that may desire them for reading at their Society meetings.

The Periodical Club and its efforts to supply remote western points with Church and general literature out of the superabundance here, and farther East, was set forth.

Mrs. Van Deman brought the subject of the Enrollment Fund before the Auxiliary. She spoke of Mrs. Rochester's wish to take \$1,000. from the S. O. Auxiliary to the meeting to be held in Baltimore next October, at the time of the General Convention, and urged that earnest work might be undertaken by the Parish Auxiliaries to accomplish this object.

Bishop Vincent's request that boxes be sent to the Missionaries of *our own* Diocese received the earnest attention of the Auxiliary, and a resolution was unanimously passed, asking that the Bishop supply Mrs. Rochester with a list of such Missionary families in his Diocese as would

find a box acceptable, and would keep the list constantly revised, that names and needs may be ascertained through her when any Society is ready to prepare a Missionary box.

The desirability of a more general attendance at the annual meeting from parish Auxiliaries was discussed. Each parish is entitled to four delegates, excepting where there are more than two auxiliary societies in the same parish, in which case each *Society* shall be entitled to two delegates. The following motion was adopted: "In view of the need of fuller representation at the Annual Meeting, each Society shall elect delegates and alternates—delegates unable to attend being authorized to obtain substitutes."
