The Report of the Woman's Auxiliary

FOR TWENTY-FOUR YEARS.

In the year 1876 the Rt. Rev. Thomas Augustus Jaggar appointed a Director to organize a Branch of the Woman's Auxiliary in Southern Ohio. During these twenty-four years the same person has held the position.

The first Society organized was in Trinity Church, Bellaire, the Rev. Jacob Rambo, Rector.

The first missionary box was sent from St. James' Church, Piqua, the Rev. Francis K. Brooke, Rector.

The first money received from any Society was for Diocesan Missions, and came from Grace Church, Pomeroy, the Rev. Carleton P. Maples, Rector.

The first annual meeting was held May, 1877, in St. Paul's Church, Chillicothe, the Rev. Charles L. Fischer, Rector. The *total* amount of money reported was \$205.65—\$175.45 being for Diocesan Missions.

In 1878, in answer to an appeal made by Bishop Elliott, a scholarship of \$100.00 was taken in a church school in Western Texas, and, at the suggestion of the Auxiliary, named the Mary H. Rochester scholarship. This is supported by gifts from the entire Diocesan Branch.

In 1879 a scholarship was taken in St. Mary's Hall, Shanghai, and named the Bishop Jaggar scholarship. This is supported by small sums given by each Society in the Diocese, that each may testify to the love and esteem they bear their Bishop. In 1889 two more scholarships were taken, and have been supported in the same way—

the Bishop Vincent scholarship in St. John's College, Shanghai, and the May Jaggar memorial in the High School, Cuttinton, Africa. There are numerous other scholarships supported by individual societies, but these four are known as our *Diocesan* work, the smallest and weakest society doing their share.

In May, 1881, hearing that Bishop Jaggar desired to appoint a Diocesan Missionary, and the sum of \$1,200 was needed, the Director boldly pledged the amount, feeling assured that the women of the Auxiliary would stand by her. One thousand two hundred and sixty-nine dollars and forty cents was the result.

The Rev. J. Mills Kendrick was appointed Diocesan Missionary, and held that position, beloved by the entire Diocese, until he was consecrated Bishop of New Mexico and Arizona.

Three years later the pledge for Diocesan Missions was increased to \$1,500, and in 1893, at an annual meeting held in St. James' Church, Piqua, a pledge of \$1,600 was made, the only deviation since that time being a tendency to *run over* that amount.

While the money for Diocesan Missions was on the increase, other fields were not forgotten, and at the triennial meetings of the Woman's Auxiliary, Southern Ohio became known as a Branch ready to respond to appeals at home and abroad.

In the year 1883 money was sent Bishop Boone not only to buy the land but to build a chapel near Shanghai. This was a loving memorial to the Rev. Charles H. Young, late Rector of St. John's Church, Worthington.

When the Church Missions House was built, Southern Ohio sent her mite towards furnishing the Woman's Auxiliary rooms, and shared also in the memorial altar placed in the chapel at the Church Missions House in loving remembrance of Dr. Langford.

In 1880 a Girls' Society was organized in the Church of the Advent, Walnut Hills, and during the following summer a still younger society was formed of boys and girls in the same parish. These two societies have continued their work to the present day. This was the *foundation* of our Junior Auxiliary.

A Babes Branch was started in Rochester, N. Y., in 1891, and two years later the work was organized in Southern Ohio, John Noble Yoakley being the first member.

The success of the Woman's Auxiliary in this Diocese is owing, under God, to the uniform courtesy and sympathy of the rectors, and the unfailing faithfulness of the women. During all these years the work has gone on steadily and smoothly—not one cloud, nor even a shadow of any unpleasantness.

There has never been a pledge unpaid, and when *new* work has been undertaken it has always been over and above what has already been begun. The result of the twenty-four years is as follows:

Report of Church Periodical Club.

The correspondent for Southern Ohio has not been able to make a complete report, owing to the failure of some of the librarians to send her their accounts, therefore can only give an approximate statement.

Amount of money spent in postage and freight on books, magazines, calendars and sheet music by correspondent and librarians (which does not include money spent for postage by donors, many of whom send reading matter at their own expense), \$30.92. Number of periodicals sent regularly (monthly), 584; number of odd magazines, books and papers, 987; number of papers sent weekly, 340.

If the full report could be given these numbers would be considerably increased. In addition, a good many odd numbers of standard magazines and papers (especially in the correspondent's own town of Springfield, where there are "Homes" and a colored branch of the Y. M. C. A.) have been sent to local institutions.
