### MINUTES.

The 24th annual meeting of the Woman's Auxiliary to the Board of Missions of the Diocese of Virginia was held in St. James Church, Leesburg, Virginia, and was called to order at 9:30 November 4th, 1914, by the President, Miss Sallie Stuart, and the delegates were welcomed to the Parish by Rev. Mr. Burkhardt. Miss Louisa T. Davis, Vice-President, welcomed them in the name of the Parish Branch, and Mrs. A. J. Smith, of Fredericksburg, responded.

The roll was called by Miss Lucy Gibson, showing 49 delegates and 20 Juniors present.

Mrs. Hugh Powell was appointed Secretary pro-tem.

The Junior Branch, Mrs. Robert Barton, Sec'y, retired into business session.

Bishop Gibson, formally introduced Bishop Co-adjutor William Cabell Brown.

Bishop Brown, responded with deep feeling and earnestness.

The minutes of the second day's meeting at Fredericksburg, in 1913 were read by Miss Louisa Davis.

The following appeals were then made: Deaconess Boyd in charge of the mission work at Morgan's Mill below Mt. Weather asked for assistance in providing teachers for church school. Miss Proffee for aid in equipping clothing bureau in mountain work at Brown's Cove. Miss Stuart asked for \$50 in pledges to complete water works in construction at Pocosan, Green Co., in the mountain mission work. Mrs. Ellis of Yancy Settlement House asked for assistance in obtaining pews for Mr. Ellis' new church, the Church of the Good Shepherd at Rocky Bar, also for money to pay a teacher's salary. The following pledges were made: \$59.80 to complete water works at Pocosan; \$44.00 for teacher's salary in Mr. Ellis school, and \$23.00 for pews in Church of Good Shepherd.

Telegrams of sympathy were voted to be sent to Mrs. French and Mrs. Howard.

Address by Bishop Gibson on Woman's work for Women.

Noonday prayer was conducted by Bishop co-adjutor Brown.

The President then appointed the following committees:

For resolutions on the tragic death of Rt. Rev. F. S. Spaulding: Chairman, Mrs. Eleanor S. W. Howard, Miss Davis, Mrs. Barton, Mrs. Rollins, Miss Lucy Davis, Miss Rebecca Norwood.

For resolutions of sympathy to Mrs. Angus Crawford, Chairman, Mrs. T. T. Slaughter, Mrs. H. C. Bowen, Miss Tillie Page, Miss Florence Shepherd, Mrs. N. F. Harrison, Miss Anne P. Thornton.

The meeting adjourned for lunch.

The afternoon session resumed at 2:30.

Deaconess Boyd was asked to give an additional brief account of her work among the mountain people near Mt. Weather, Va., and gave many interesting details of this work, answering many questions.

The Junior meeting was called to order by Rev. Mr. Burkhardt. Quiet hour at 7:45 was conducted by Bishop A. S. Lloyd.

Thursday—Meeting called to order 9:45, Minutes of Wednesday read and approved.

Talks on Mission Study Classes by Mrs. J. M. Johnson, Alexandria, Va., Mrs. Chichester, Leesburg; Mrs. Ashurst, Charlottesville, Mrs. Osgood, Educational secretary spoke on modern methods of mission study.

Meeting adjourned for lunch.

Afternoon session resumed at 2:30.

A motion to continue to print the Annual Report was carried.

Pledges to Mr. Lee's Insurance \$50, Miss Mann and Miss Barber's salary \$100 each, were renewed.

Deaconess Boyd spoke of her work among the mountain people.

A vote of thanks was given Miss Kibbee, of Washington for an offer to erect necessary buildings for the work of Deaconess Boyd, and for her help and sympathy for the mountain people of Virginia.

Mrs. E. L. Woodward was elected Secretary of Section B.

The old Officers re-elected.

Resolutions of thanks, offered by Miss Rebecca Norwood, of Richmond, for entertaining the Auxiliary were passed.

A resolution of sympathy was extended to Mrs. Powell, the secretary of the meeting, who had become suddenly ill.

Miss Davis, offered the following suggestions for work the coming year:

1st—Investigation of the County Alms Houses in the several parishes.

2nd—Work among criminals and inspection of jail conditions in the Parishes.

The President endorsed these suggestions.

Mrs. Morton extended an invitation for the next meeting at Christ Church, Alexandria, Va., Seconded by Mrs. Johnson, delegate from St. Paul's Church, Alexandria, Va. Invitation accepted.

On motion the meeting adjourned.

A missionary service was held in the evening with addresses by Bishop Co-adjutor Brown, the Rev. Dr. McGrew and Rev. E. L. Woodward.

#### REPORT OF THE JUNIOR AUXILIARY 1914-1915

The Juniors are submitting their last report as an undivided branch. For twenty five years we have worked together, each year seeing a steady advance, and it is with more than pleasure, that I report, in these days of war and diminished incomes, our highest attainment of \$3,040.30.

With the sending of the report in May, each branch, where it was deemed advisable, separated the older girls and sent them into

the woman's Auxiliary, in Section B. under Mrs. Woodward. The Juniors remain with me, and though our ranks are thinned and our financial report will be very different, we feel a distinct advance will have been made.

The Woman's Auxiliary will be enthused and strengthened by these well trained young women, who have been my right hand, and a very joy to work with. My younger Juniors can develop on their own lines, with leaders from section B and make themselves strong and reliable, meeting appeals and shouldering responsibilities, and year by year they will send other contingents into the older branch.

The Little Helpers will augment our ranks, and my desire now is to establish ourselves in every parish, not letting the Women's Auxiliary stand for the only body of mission workers in a church, but beginning with our babies, so train them, that when at seven years, they become Juniors, their missionary spirit and education will already be a determined factor in their lives, and so through the Juniors and Section B. they will not only be an enlightened body of workers in their own parishes by their enlarged vision of every mission field and sympathetic interest, but by God's help will be, some of them, doing work in those fields.

Our pledges have all been met, our united offering is increasing and bearing interest in the savings bank, while we have helped our Bishops through the Emergency Fund, and the appeal for funds for Woman Workers in the Diocese, and so with mixed feelings, indeed, of joy and sorrow, I submit our last report.

**REPORT OF THE LITTLE HELPERS TO THE VIRGINIA  
WOMAN'S AUXILIARY TO BOARD  
OF MISSIONS.**

The work of the Little Helpers varies little with the years. Some of the branches, always faithful and prompt, others seeming to forget that those at the front need food, clothes and shelter, too. Those men and women went out trusting that we would not forget them. How is it in Virginia? Have we done our work all along the line if we have failed to gather the little children together, and teach them to do their part? They must have leaders, and when the story is told, dear women of the Virginia Auxiliary, the work of the children depends on you in your various parishes. I come before you again to plead for the little children. No one could make me believe that the women in the nearly one hundred branches in Virginia, have wilfully neglected the precious privilege of teaching the children of the Church

to have a share in this work of Christ. You dear members of the Auxiliary, who have never looked into this part of parish work, will you not when you go home gather the children together whether they be many or few and see that they understand the meaning of Christ's call, "Let the little ones come unto me." I have it from the pen of Bishop Tucker, of Japan, that "Kindergartens are one of the very most important factors of the work in the interior, where the people are shy about coming to church. Many a door is opened through the little child, and what follows? Friendships formed, confidence won—then the heart is opened to receive Christ's message of love, 'Bring ye the tithes into the storehouse, and prove Me, saith the Lord of Hosts, if I will not open the windows of Heaven and pour you out a blessing that there shall not be room to receive it.'"

The smaller branches should not underrate their responsibility.

Even if the membership be small and the contributions less than those of the larger branches. Their earnest endeavors, their keen interest and their prayers will have a great and lasting influence, not only on their own individual parishes, but on all with whom they come in contact.

#### REPORT OF EDUCATIONAL SECRETARY ON MISSION STUDY FROM MAY, 1914, TO MAY, 1915.

The mission study work for the year has been most encouraging. The four new leaders appointed last fall to advance the work in their respective convocations have created a great deal of new interest and enthusiasm and organized many new classes.

The leader for the Valley Convocation reports four classes. This is only the result in numbers. The interest she has created in the work far exceeds the number of classes.

Rappahannock reports five classes and fifty-three members enrolled. The educational secretary helped to organize four classes in this convocation, which have sent in no reports to either the secretary or convocation leader. This would make a total of nine classes for Rappahannock.

Albemarle had five classes. Twenty-four members were enrolled in three classes.

Piedmont, seventeen classes. Seventy-two members were enrolled in five classes.

Richmond had ten classes. Only two classes reported the number of members enrolled. These had forty.

The total number of classes in the diocese, 41; leaders, 29; eleven classes reported 189 members. This is fourteen classes more than we had last year and six new leaders.

### **Rappahannock Convocation.**

When the Woman's Auxiliary met in Leesburg in its annual meeting in November, 1914, I was appointed educational secretary of the Rappahannock Convocation. I at once applied to the dean of the convocation for a list of churches and their rectors that I might get in communication with them. But it was January before I could get this list, making our working year very short. I wrote or talked with them all, but only succeeded in persuading three women to undertake the work, many answering that the roads were so bad it was impossible to get a class together, others that they had no rector and could not do more at that time, and some not feeling prepared to undertake

teaching a class. This year I propose to have a normal class in Fredericksburg lasting three days, that the women in the surrounding country may be trained for the work.

The following classes were formed: St. George's, Fredericksburg, led by Mrs. W. D. Carter. St. John's, Tappahannock, led by Mrs. Knight, Tappahannock. St. George's Chapel, Spotsylvania, led by Miss Etches, R. F. D. No. 1, Fredericksburg. Christ Church, Spotsylvania Court House, led by Mrs. C. L. Rutter, Sunlight, Va. An interdenominational class, led by me in my own home. In these classes there were about fifty people taking part. I talked at three meetings on the subject of study classes. The textbook used in all these classes was "The Child in the Midst." This year we will use "The Conquest of the Continent" as a textbook. If we could arouse in the women of this convocation an interest in this mission study, it would prove of endless aid to the Woman's Auxiliary, for where you find lack of interest in missions, you will always find lack of information. Many of the finest women in the auxiliary are the product of mission study classes. Once more I appeal to the women of this convocation, and beg you not to draw back from this work for the Master
