EXTRACTS FROM THE REPORT OF THE WOMAN'S AUXILIARY.

To the Rt. Rev. Robert A. Gibson, D. D., *President ex-officio*:

The Woman's Auxiliary in the Diocese of Virginia begs to present the following report:

During the past year twenty-four new branches have been added to our roll. Of these six are Woman's Auxiliary branches; five, Section B.; five, Junior; and eight, Little Helpers.

At the present time our organization is as follows:

Woman's Auxiliary, 85 branches.

Section B., 14 branches.

Junior Auxiliary, 55 branches.

Little Helpers, 34 branches.

Whole Number of branches, 188.

There are eight counties in the Diocese in which we are not organized; and we find that there are one hundred and eighteen churches and chapels in which we have no branch.

Our United Offering, which is made every three years, and is not included in annual reports, was presented during the Triennial meeting in St. Louis, and amounted to \$6,056.00.

Last summer our Silver Anniversary Rest Fund enabled us to send four missionary workers for vacations to the Summer Rest House in Albemarle county.

Following the example of the Auxiliary in the Valley Convocation, we have during the past year held Convocational Auxiliary Days in the Rappahannock and Piedmont Convocations. These meetings were largely attended, and their good effects are already apparent.

The observance of the Pilgrimage of Prayer has emphasized the spiritual side of our work; and we wish to thank the clergy of the Diocese for the assistance that they gave, both during our Pilgrimage week, and in our preparation for it.

When we plan for the work of the coming year and look around us at present conditions, we realize that we shall need the help of every woman and girl in the Diocese, if we are to make the advance that is now more than ever necessary.

In the death of our first President and Secretary, Miss Sallie Stuart, which occurred last August in Alexandria, we met a loss that cannot be measured with words. But those of us who come after her in the Auxiliary find her foundations so well and so wisely laid that in the present activities of the society we are reminded of one of the great blessings that come to those who die in the Lord: "Their works do follow them."

Piedmont Convocation.

The Auxiliary in the Piedmont Convocation, with all its record of good work in the Past, feels that it must go on to still better things. This Convocation embraces eight large counties, and is larger in geographical extent than any other in the Diocese. This makes it at once more difficult as well as more necessary to get together. The Auxiliary Day method so successfully used in the Valley Convocation has been adopted with gratifying results in Piedmont. Our first Auxiliary Convocation Day was held in St. Paul's Church, Alexandria, May 9th, with a registered attendance of seventy. Our Diocesan President presided over both sessions; and the Rev. J. A. Welbourn of Japan made an excellent address on the work in that country. We found that the spiritual help gained from this day's fellowship, with its corporate communion, the exchange of ideas and methods brought out in the branch reports and in the conference on summer work, were richly worth the time and effort in-

volved in getting to the meeting. Some of the branches report that they have already put into operation suggestions received at the conference. Our next Auxiliary Day will be held at Grace Church, Alexandria, at some early date in May.

REPORT OF EDUCATIONAL DEPARTMENT.

The work of this department is steadily growing. Reports from every quarter tell of increased interest. There were about sixty classes conducted last year. About one thousand people were reached through Study Classes alone. Many of these were men who were brought into touch with the work through the direct influence of this department. These also include many young people in Section B. "The New World," "Manana," and "Fosdick on Prayer," were used very generally as text books. Besides the regular Study Class, there were Reading Circles, Program Meetings, Lectures, Conferences, Institutes, and Missionary Plays.

The Educational Secretaries visited many branches and spoke on the work; and conducted normal classes for training leaders at Richmond, and Alexandria. Many new leaders have been added to our working force, and have contributed much valuable assistance.

Thus we show an increase over last year's report, but most gratifying is the number of new branches organized, whose work will only begin to tell next year.

It will be seen by the appended report that all pledges were paid, though in several instances, I took advantage of the right given me to make up those

pledges falling short, from those overpaid.

Some day we may have our own year book and have space to print the letters of thanks that come. Among them this year, was one from the Rev. Mr. Christian at Anvik, Alaska, in which he said ours was the first money his home diocese had contributed, to the work he and his wife represented, and that our definite interest in him was most encouraging.

I want to ask each Junior leader to look over my report and see if she is represented in the list of branches contributing to the work we have undertaken as a whole. If not, why not? If the Juniors at their annual meeting decide on certain work, when the list of pledges is sent out, each branch should do its part towards making up the whole.

May I lay special emphasis too, on the letters of Miss Hughes, in Our Diocesan Work? This paper is sent you every month to keep you in touch with Junior work, and reading her articles should be part of your program.

Also, send your United Offering in March and September direct to Miss Anna Purcell, Park Ave., Richmond. She is making every cent tell, by putting it out at interest and, therefore, we don't want to hold back our boxes.

A systematic effort is being made to organize Junior Branches in all the parishes of the Diocese. The Junior leaders will take the matter up with each rector; and in these days, when our Church girls are doing all they can towards war relief, there must also be steady development on Auxiliary lines. If we have only 56 branches in our Diocese, is it not possible that in the near future our Church will have reason to realize her lack of trained young women to take the places left vacant in the ranks of the Woman's Auxiliary? We leaders feel the responsibility should not rest on us.

Much of our work is continued from year to year. The candy and oranges given the Blue Ridge Missions of Mrs. Cowling and the Rev. Mr. Ellis, and the boxes sent to the mid west Indians, will be supplied as usual. Frazier School-house, the work largely of the Juniors, is nearing completion. Our little Choir Boy and Girl in China are entering on their fourth year of education. The United Offering, the Emergency Fund, and our Apportionments—nothing must suffer, and we shall want to take up the new appeals presented. The missions of the Church must have even larger portions to help them maintain themselves during the coming year of war conditions and high prices. With larger demands elsewhere, the Junior work must be bigger too. And because your response has never failed, I am asking that each Junior will feel it her privilege to build up her Branch by setting a higher standard than in other years; that she will help with the formation of new branches, and that she will sustain the united work of the branches as never before.

Let us enter on the new year's program with deep gratitude and thankfulness that so much lies within our power.
