THE REPORT OF THE THIRTY-THIRD ANNUAL MEETING OF THE WOMAN'S AUXILIARY

The thirty-third Annual Meeting of the Woman's Auxiliary to the Board of Missions of Western Michigan was held at Trinity Church, Niles, May 21st, 1913.

There were fourteen Branches represented, by twenty-one delegates, one Junior and five officers. We had the pleasure of having with us two Bishops and six of our clergy.

The meetings were preceded by the Celebration of the Holy Communion. The Rt. Rev. J. N. McCormick gave a very inspiring address, urging all to give, not what was expected, but to give of their life and means a full, over-flowing measure.

The meeting was called to order by the president, Mrs. Collins Johnson.

The year's work as reported by the different officers was very satisfactory. All of the pledges were paid in full but the Bishop's Trust Fund, and this was made up by the offering of the day.

The Treasurer reported as receiving \$1,540.33.

The Corresponding Secretary reported boxes being sent, valued at \$1,008.12.

It was decided to change the time of the Corporate Communion from January 25th to September 29th, and the group meetings will be held as follows:

Y., and Lake Geneva, Wis. Miss Sibley, president of the Girls' Friendly Society, gave a very pleasing talk of her work in the Philippines.

All felt as though the meetings had been very helpful.

The delegates from St. Marks, Grand Rapids, invited the Auxiliary to meet there for its next Annual Meeting.
